Established in 1965, The International School of Kuala Lumpur (ISKL) is a co-educational, private, not-for-profit school responsible for the learning journey of over 1,800 students aged 3-18 years representing more than 70 nationalities at its campus in the heart of Kuala Lumpur.

ISKL is accredited internationally through the Council of International Schools (CIS), and in the United States through the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). There is a strong focus on service and sustainability across its divisions, and ISKL is a member of the Eco-Schools organization and the Green Schools Alliance.



SPECIAL PROGRAMS AT ISKL



International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (Grade 11-12)

- ISKL has been authorized to run the IBDP since 1989; longest-running IB World School in Malaysia
- Non-selective program, which is open to all students
- Over 80% of students pursue the full IBDP annually
- Language support for bilingual IBDP with taught Language and Literature courses in Chinese, English, Korean, and Spanish, and School-supported Self-taught Literature in additional languages

PRAXIS

PRAXIS (Grade 9)

- Integrated, project-based learning program reimagining the traditional school experience
- Focus on real-world challenges using design thinking
- Encourages creative exploration, collaboration, and problem-solving
- Differentiated, flexible environment promoting student agency, empathy, and impact



ISKL Pursuits (Grade 11-12)


- Two-year program for targeted study or career exploration
- Customizable program combining IB, AP, and High School Diploma courses
- Opportunity for in-depth study in specific fields
- Emphasis on applying learning in real-world settings outside the classroom



Global Action Program (Grade 9-11)

- Mandatory service component of High School curriculum
- Week-long trips across Asia, engaging in community partnerships related to UN Sustainable Development Goals
- Activities include service, social entrepreneurship, cultural immersion, and outdoor adventure
- Participation is required for graduation, emphasizing the program's importance




