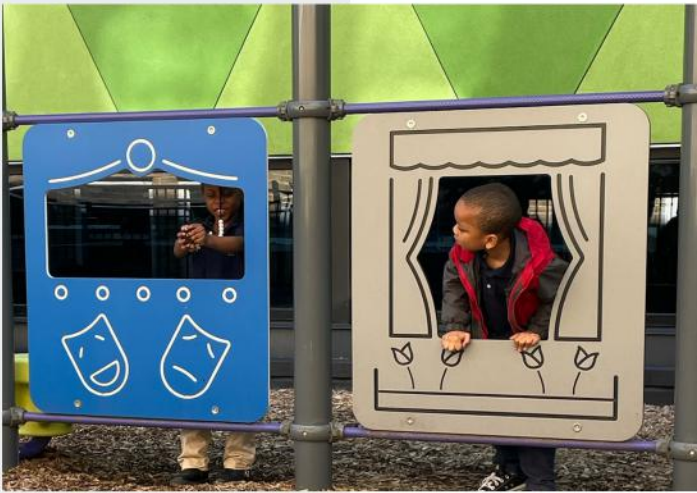

FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

In 2024–2025, our theme was “to infinity and beyond.” For our children and families, that meant creating an environment where brilliance is nurtured and circumstances never define potential.

Inside our classrooms, growth was everywhere. Every teacher received Orton-Gillingham training, and staff deepened skills in literacy, math, restorative practices, and trauma-informed care. With daily coaching from our new principal and assistant principal, instruction became more precise and impactful. As Bentley, a 3rd grader, proudly shared: “Ms. DJ & Ms. Mary taught me how to read, so I need to give them these Valentine’s Day gifts from my heart.”

Beyond academics, our families received critical care. We expanded our social services team, supported 63 families, and increased therapy participation to 79% of students — thanks to university and community partners. Parents, too, began healing. One mother reflected: “I never knew how much I needed therapy. Now I see how much it’s helping my family improve.”

The year was also full of joy. We celebrated with Comcast’s Olympic field day, a vibrant Trunk or Treat, and an Ansley & the Arts fundraiser where students debuted their original song “Work of Art” with Chad Price. We honored Black History Month with Dr. Terence Lester, partnered with the Atlanta Hawks and YMCA, and gained visibility on the Amplify Science of Reading podcast.

Our Signature Gala broke records, drawing 460 guests and raising over \$1 million to fund tuition, meals, therapy, and family support for 90 students. The evening honored Founding Board Member, Ann Kimsey, featured testimonies of resilience, and ended with student and teacher performances that reminded us all why Ansley matters.

Through 65+ partnerships across Atlanta, we proved that when we create the right environment, children and families flourish.

In launching our first-ever 6th-grade class in 2025–2026, one truth remains: we cannot do this without you. Your generosity makes the impossible possible — and is infinitely appreciated.

OUR PROGRAM

At The Boyce L. Ansley School, we believe every child deserves the chance to learn, grow, and dream beyond their circumstances. As the only tuition-free private school in the southeast created specifically for children who have experienced homelessness, we exist to provide stability, opportunity, and hope for families who need it most. **Our guiding belief, “Beyond Circumstance,” reminds us that a child’s present situation does not define their future.**

Our program is grounded in the core values of excellence, community, and resilience. We hold ourselves to the highest standards of academic and social-emotional support, knowing that excellence opens doors for every student. We cultivate a strong sense of community where children and families are embraced, uplifted, and encouraged. Ultimately, we nurture resilience, helping students and parents develop the confidence and strength to overcome challenges and pursue a brighter future.

Offering a unique model that pairs excellent academic instruction with wraparound services addresses the full scope of challenges our students and families face. **From free tuition, uniforms, and school supplies to daily meals, transportation assistance, and intensive family support programs, every element of our approach is centered on removing barriers to learning.** With a full-time, licensed therapist, we place equal emphasis on healing and emotional wellbeing as we do on academic achievement, creating a trauma-sensitive environment where students feel safe, valued, and supported.

Homelessness often brings instability and stress that can interrupt a child’s ability to thrive in school. At Ansley, we meet these challenges head-on with early interventions and an environment that prioritizes both the student and their family. By walking alongside parents and caregivers, we connect families to resources that lead to self-sufficiency, breaking down cycles of generational poverty and building a stronger foundation for the future. The Ansley School is more than a place of learning—it is a community of resilience, hope, and transformation. We envision a future where children are not defined by what they’ve endured, but by their abilities and the endless possibilities that lie ahead.

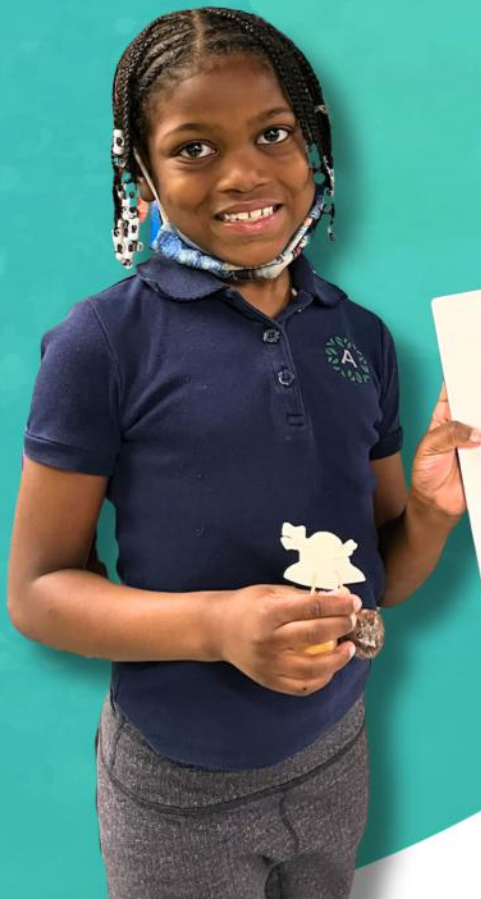
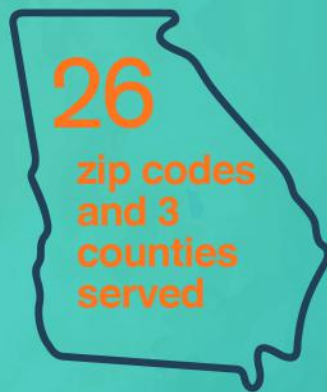

We had the honor of being selected as a Leadership Atlanta project. Their first visit included a guided tour of the school and a powerful homelessness simulation designed to give participants a glimpse into the daily challenges many of our families face. With the support of Ansley parents Tessa, Demarco, Tameka, and Tiffany, this experience provided a meaningful and eye-opening perspective for the cohort.

As program partners, Leadership Atlanta worked with our Social Services department to develop a comprehensive whole-family assessment, planning, and management system. This initiative focused on measuring stability and success across four critical areas: housing, education, healthcare & mental health, and employment. By identifying and prioritizing family needs, this system aims to build a sustainable model that empowers families and ensures students are able to thrive both in and beyond the classroom.

Georgia Private School Tax Credit 2025

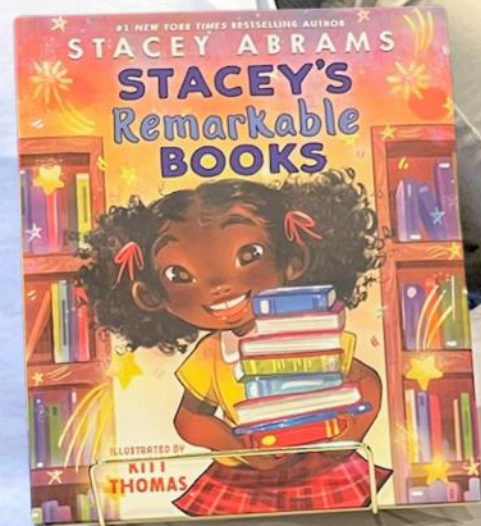

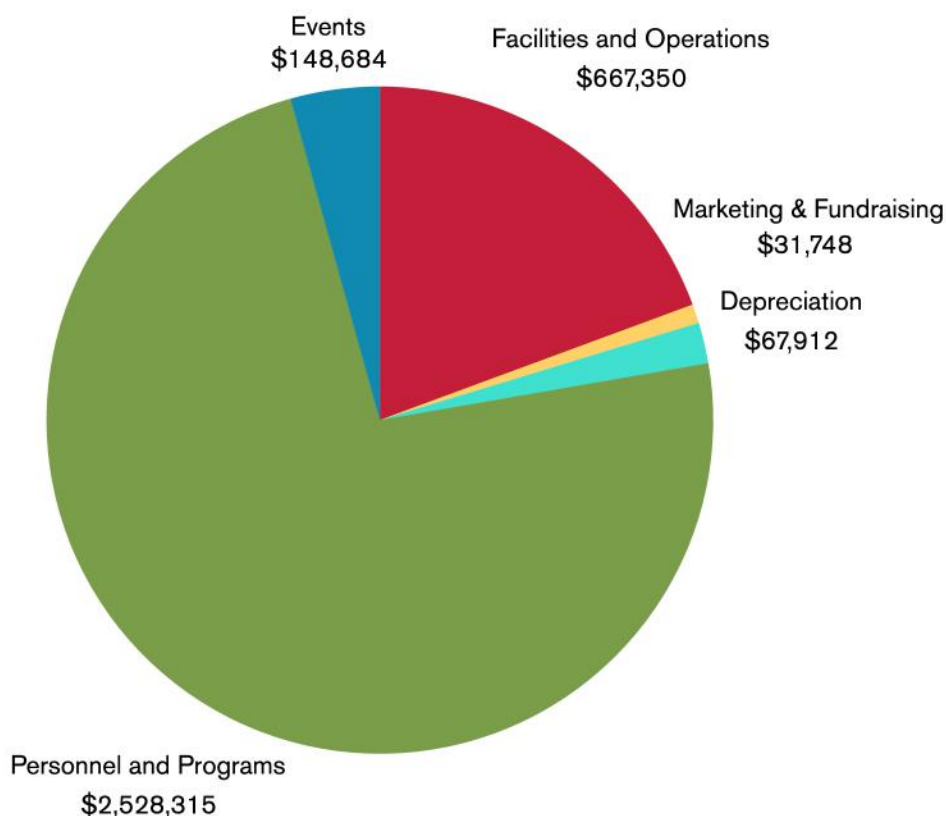
2024-25 FINANCIALS
