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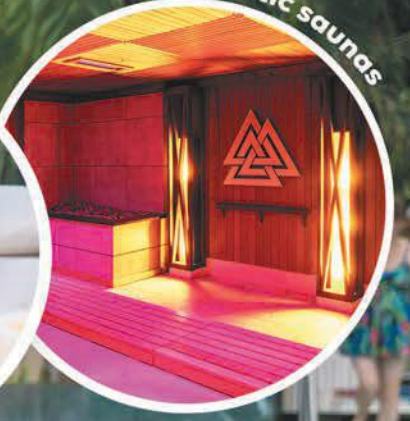

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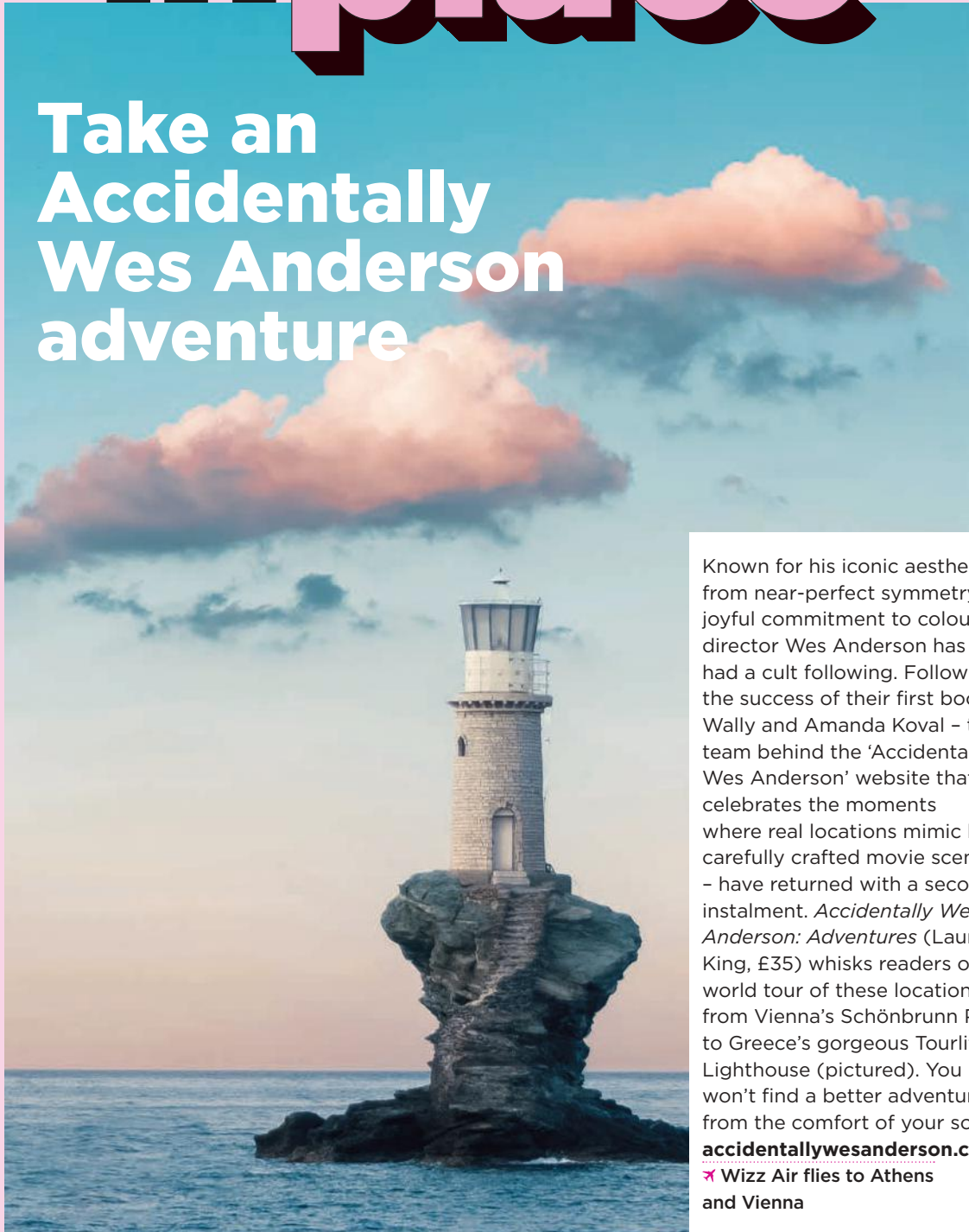
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
Take an Accidentally Wes Anderson adventure

More than 1,000 artisans and craftspeople have been involved in bringing the Cathedral back to life.

“Skateboarding is not a trend”



In Cairo, a growing scene is catching fire – all thanks to the brains behind Amulet Skate Shop

Although it is a city home to more than 10 million people, Cairo doesn't make it easy to skateboard. There are precious few skateparks, but an underground scene has been growing for almost 50 years. And now, a group of skaters is committed to shining a spotlight on this subculture, hoping to turn it into a phenomenon on the world stage.

Yehia O, 37, started skateboarding in the late 1990s and is one of the self-described "OGs" of Cairo skateboarding. When he began there was no infrastructure for people who wanted to skate. "We never really had the support we needed," he says.

Yehia's friend and business partner, Hani Talat, 35, remembers that when he began in 2007 he and his friends would skate in front of the arrivals terminal at Cairo airport. There was an innocence to this loose collection of street skaters but, with no real investment, bubbles of enthusiasm would burst soon after they'd taken flight. "Lots of skaters lose their motivation to skate," he says. "It spikes up then it dips down."

Yehia is a painter and former dentist, and Hani makes films - between 2008 and 2010 he filmed a 42-minute documentary about the scene called *Cairo's Comeback*. "I wanted to document that there are skaters in Cairo," he says. Hani thinks that the film helped skateboarders get back into the game. In April 2022, he got some of the OG skaters together and proposed a new venture: Amulet Skate Shop. Yehia joined him and the pair began to proactively champion the community they love.

"What we initially wanted to do is to create a skate shop here in Egypt that serves the Egyptian skaters as well as gives them an international-standard skate shop," says Hani. They can't provide skateparks

- these cost millions to build. "But we can provide brands, experience and history that kids need to know," adds Hani. In April 2024, Amulet organised a photo exhibition showcasing skateboarding's history in Cairo, proving "that this sport is not a trend". Their hope was to motivate kids who might be thinking about hopping on a board.

Amulet's main focus is as an online shop, and recently they were announced as a retailer for Carhartt in Egypt. Even more importantly, however, in May they released their very own deck. Made in Canada and called Rebirth, its underside - designed by Yehia himself - is a hooded figure looking up at an enormous fluffy cloud against a blue sky.

One proud owner of the board is Hanan Gamal. At 21, she's one of the capital's few female skaters. She is also one of eight skaters Amulet 'sponsors' by providing discounts and championing them publicly. "We're extremely proud of endorsing and empowering female skateboarders," says Yehia. Hanan thinks that there are only three

in Cairo; the other two, also in Amulet’s team, are both called Malak.

Being a female skateboarder in Cairo isn’t easy. Hanan skates once a week – on a Friday, when she’s not at university – but says she skates alone “because if we are more than two people we get kicked out”. She skates near a mosque at Madinaty, in eastern Cairo. Skateboarding still has an anti-social reputation in this relatively conservative country. “People stare at me like there’s something wrong with me,” she says, “but there’s a small percent that love what they see, and they encourage me.”

Hanan would love to go professional one day. Although skateboarding became an Olympic sport in 2021, Egypt didn’t field an athlete, and realistically, it will be a while before the country produces professional skateboarders. But Amulet’s support is invaluable. Hani and Yehia organise informal get-togethers where skateboarders can skate and socialise. “We want to give back to our community,” says Yehia.

Also invaluable are skateparks. “Skateboarding is a street sport but skateparks give you confidence and the ability to polish your skills, so you can get better,” says Hani. He says that Cairo only has one – Egy Skatepark – which costs 120 Egyptian pounds for the day. “Kids can’t afford that every day,” he says. So there is still work to do – a struggle that Yehia is honest about. “There are so many obstacles in the way, but we’re hopeful.” He looks to Morocco for inspiration, where the comparatively large skateboarding scene was achieved through skaters heading abroad and making a name for themselves – a form of missionary work on skateboards.

Whatever their future, Amulet’s investment in the community bodes well. “Skateboarding is slowly being more accepted by our community,” says Yehia. For a sport that has always been an underdog, it’s a pretty good start.

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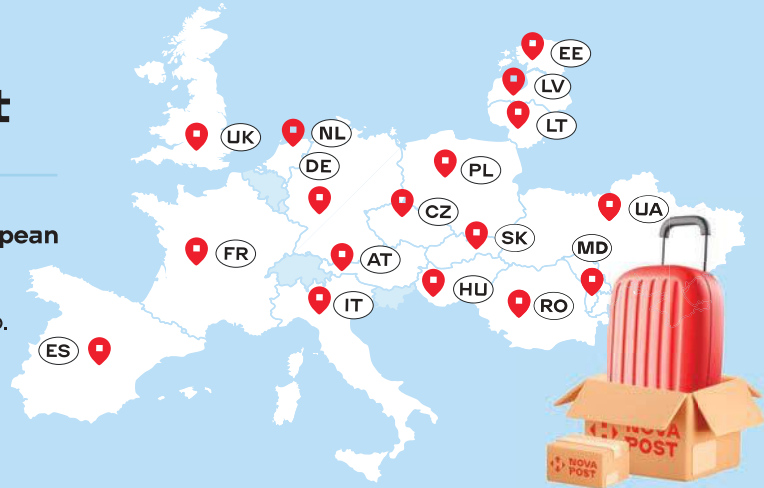
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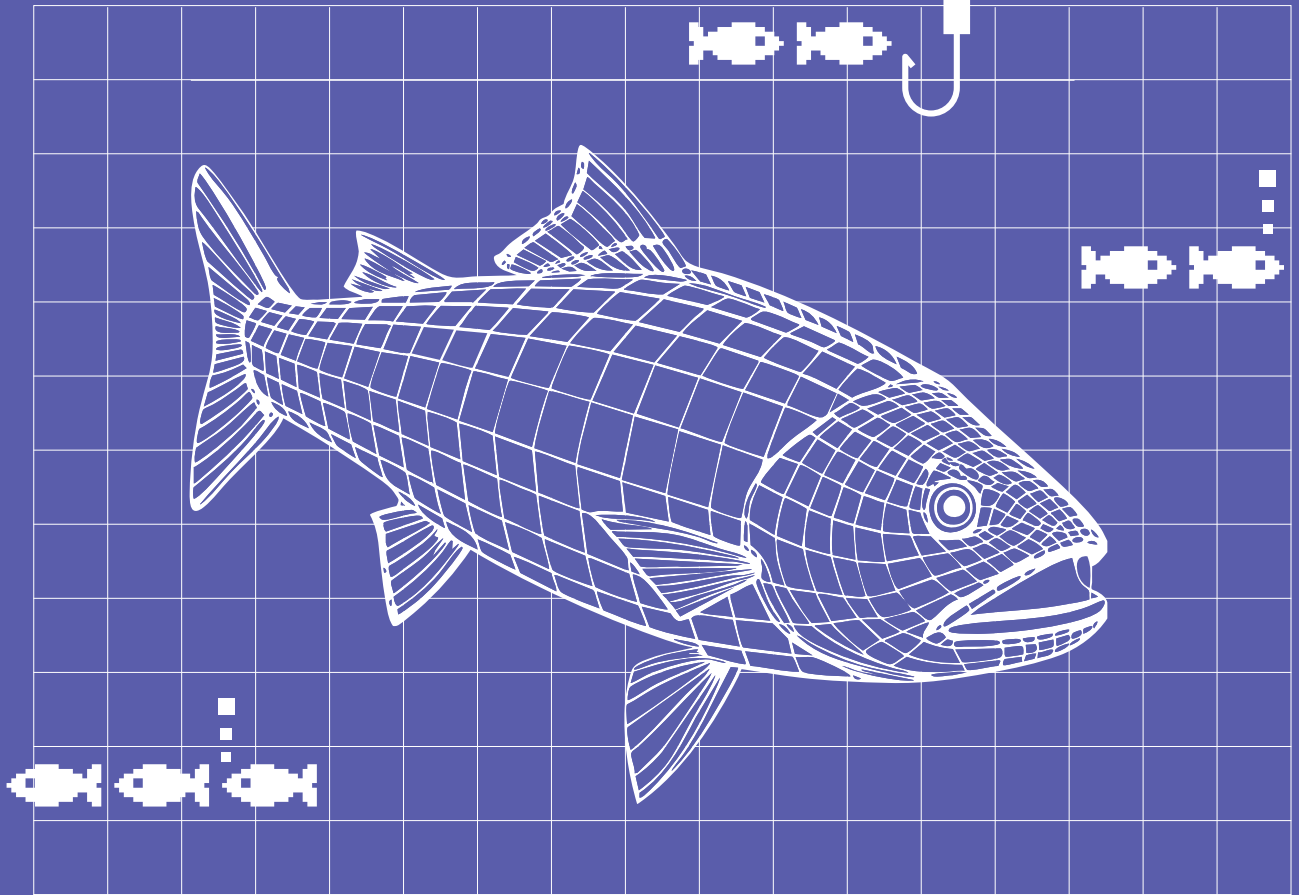

We catch up with the Lisbon-based scientists whose lab-grown sea bass fillets are set to transform conservation efforts and the culinary scene worldwide

When you're looking for seafood in Lisbon, artsy Alameda is not the first neighbourhood that springs to mind. Yet, it's here where arguably the most important fish dish in the city's history was created. Those who prepared it didn't wear chef whites, but lab coats. And the cooking method? A 3D printer.

In August, researchers at Técnico Lisboa unveiled the world's first 3D-bioprinted sea bass. The fillets have the texture of fish as well as its aroma due to the use of microalgae-based bioinks. The breakthrough promises to have a huge impact on conservation efforts and the culinary scene worldwide.

"When we saw the prototype, it was amazing," says Diana Marques, a bioengineering PhD student who has been the driving force behind the cultivated sea bass. "After all the work we had done it was finally real, and we were really proud of what we had achieved, especially the colour."

The idea to 3D print seafood came to Diana in 2019 when she was doing her Masters. "I'm a vegetarian so wanted to see more innovation when it comes to

food," she says. "That led to the idea of creating lab-grown fish and to start with sushi."

Diana ran her proposal past Frederico Ferreira, the professor in charge of her course and a researcher at the Institute for Bioengineering and Biosciences (iBB). He recalls with glee how Diana and her team drummed up support for their project.

"They entered a science competition and served up real sushi to people. Once it was consumed, they would reveal the materials that had accumulated in the fish, like metals and plastic. People had already eaten the sushi and there was nothing they could do about it."

Frederico was so impressed with Diana's plans to combine veganism and sustainability with tissue engineering and bioprinting that he supported her plans to do a Masters thesis at the iBB, with research swapping to sea bass. The team involved in the project has grown to 10 scientists in what has been a group effort to get the texture, smell and taste right.

The process starts with stem cells humanely sourced from fish. Next, scientists focus on cell

differentiation to produce muscle and fat and then create large biomass to form simple products like nuggets. For something more structured, 3D bioprinting is used, with doctoral student Afonso Gusmão adapting a microplastics 3D printer.

Meanwhile, Diana has developed bioinks containing sea bass cells to meet parameters like viscosity and suitability for human consumption – a step that has a rather pungent side effect. “From the very beginning of our research, we had the idea of bringing to the bioink the microalgae that give fish Omega-3, but in some cases, the smell and flavour of fish,” says Frederico. “So, when they are preparing the bioinks there is this sea breeze aroma in the laboratory. People ask us if we are running a fish market in there.”

Afonso has also developed bioreactors that use small electric shocks to stimulate the production of fish cells to help improve the texture of the fillet. But with so much going on in the laboratory, there’s been the occasional hiccup.

“We crashed all the electricity in the lab,” says Frederico. “We were doing our experimental set-ups and it short-circuited and everything was gone. There are challenges when you try to do things in a very innovative way.”

The next big hurdle for the team is getting the taste spot on, with tests being carried out at the Portuguese Institute for Sea and Atmosphere (IPMA), before regulatory bodies have their say over when the public can tuck in. While that may take some time, it will be worth the wait given the enormous, potential benefits.

“It’s important when it comes to animal welfare,” says Diana. “It would be incredible to see this technology where you can supply a large quantity of food and reduce what’s happening in meat factories.”

Then there’s the impact the lab-grown fish could have on food safety and the environment. “There is the problem with the use of antibiotics in aquaculture and the accumulation of metals and microplastics in fish,” says assistant researcher Carlos Rodrigues. “You also have the impact the massive production of fish can have on the environment with lot of pollution being released. Cultivated sea bass can really help mitigate that.”

Ensuring food security at a time when fish stocks are being depleted is another a positive highlighted by Frederico, before he turns to a factor people might be overlooking. “Imagine you go to a restaurant one day and there is a bioprinter in front of you,” he says. “You could choose a design and create a meal. Food should be fun, and 3D-bioprinting fish is just that.”

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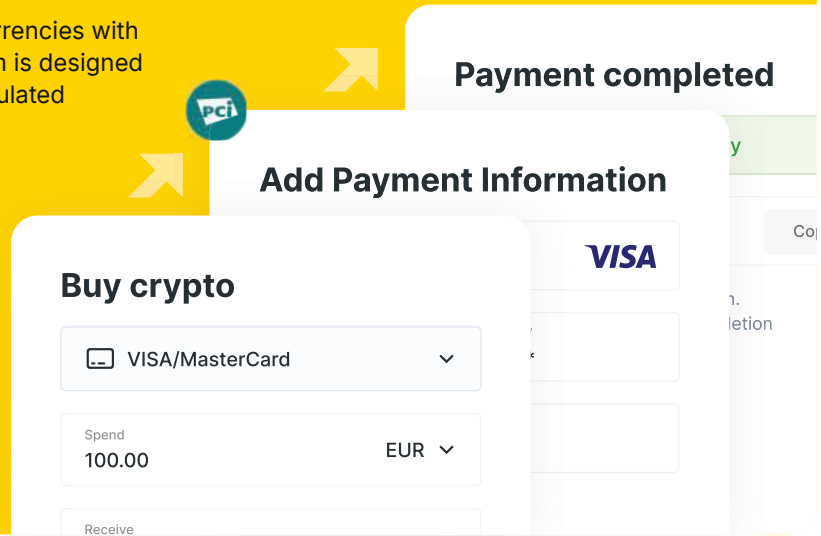
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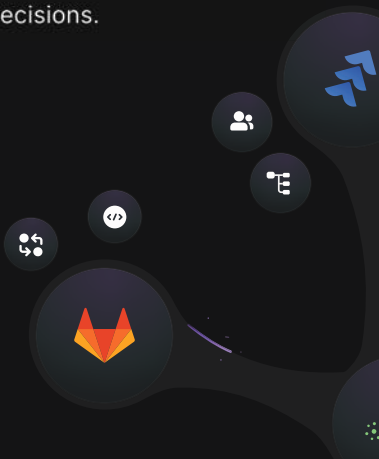

In 2019, one of the greatest ski racers of all time shocked the sporting world when he announced his retirement. But guess what? Marcel Hirscher is back

It's not often you can witness a legend of a sport back on form after they've retired. But on the last Sunday in October, one of the world's greatest-ever Alpine skiers launched from the start gates for the first time in five years, signalling his return to ski racing after half a decade off the slopes.

The fact that Marcel Hirscher – once the undisputed king of slalom – didn't finish on the podium this time seemed inconsequential. An icon in his own lifetime, he seems determined to compete on his terms in his second coming.

Born near Salzburg to a Dutch mother and an Austrian father who met on a ski holiday, Marcel was predestined to take to the slopes. "My parents ran a ski school, so what else could they have done but put me on skis?" he laughs.

It was a childhood well spent: Marcel quickly rose to stardom after making his

debut on the World Cup circuit in 2007, winning a record eight consecutive overall World Cup titles (and 67 races) as well as 11 Alpine Skiing World Championships medals, silver at the 2014 Sochi Winter Olympics and two golds in PyeongChang in 2018. That year, he became the most successful Austrian skier ever on the World Cup circuit – and many of his peers still consider him the best skier of all time. But with success came tremendous pressure and exhaustion.

"[There were] legendary moments but they had a price," he says. "I didn't stop racing because my love for it had cooled, I stopped because the time between two race seasons just wasn't enough to recharge my batteries. Once that happens, it doesn't get any better."

So, in September 2019, at the age of 30 and at the very peak of his career, Marcel



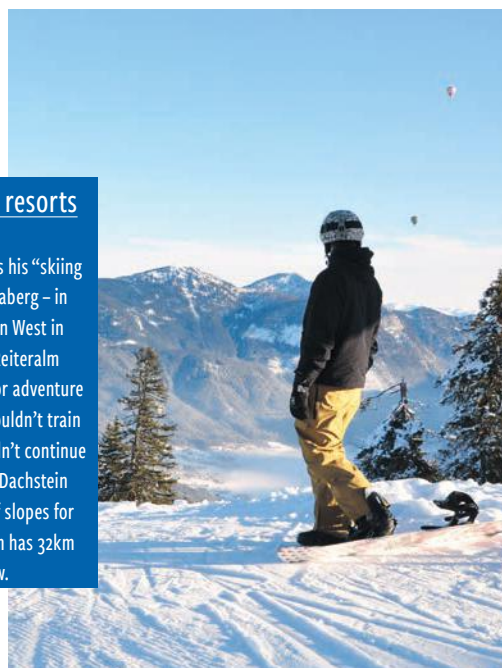

Marcel's favourite ski resorts

Dachstein West, Austria

Regarded by Marcel Hirscher as his “skiing living room”, the slopes in Annaberg – in his home ski resort of Dachstein West in the Salzburg region – and the Reiteralm near Schladming are an outdoor adventure playground for families. “If I couldn’t train here to a high standard, I couldn’t continue in the sport,” Marcel says. The Dachstein West ski resort offers 160km of slopes for all abilities, while the Reiteralm has 32km of slopes with guaranteed snow.



shocked the ski world by announcing his retirement. He left the race circuit with no plans to return. “Back then, I closed that chapter with no regrets,” he says.

However, he now admits the abrupt change to his life was much too fast. “The ‘normal life project’ took some getting used to at first,” he says. “When you’ve barely experienced having time to yourself until you’re 30, you first have to create a new daily routine.”

While that routine didn’t involve racing, he continued to ski. “In that first free winter, I was rarely on pistes and mainly went ski touring. There was a time in my retirement when I did practically no sport at all, and during that phase I realised how important it is to me: sports are an elixir of life for me.”

Realising top-level sport and the pressures it brought were not the healthiest way of life (“I hardly looked left or right”), Marcel said his focus over the past five years has been recovery, improving his health and his family. He has done this slowly, spending time with his two children in the countryside surrounding Salzburg. “My priorities have changed,” he says.

Marcel also channelled his energy into founding two companies, The Mountain Studio, a label for sustainable outdoor wear, and VAN DEER-Red Bull Sports,





a ski and sports equipment company. “I always dreamt of what it must be like to be a ski racer with your own equipment and your own outfits,” he said. “And now it’s happened, it’s even better than in a dream.”

He says that his environment is also a big source of inspiration. “Living in Salzburg is a unique privilege in terms of the quality of life it offers – you can hardly find this richness anywhere else,” he says. “The Dachstein West region and the Reiteralm offer the perfect terrain with perfect conditions – I can train at a high level while also fitting it into my tight schedule.”

And rather than return to skiing for the Austrian Ski Association, Marcel has decided to ski under the Dutch flag.

“The Dutch have wonderful fans, and now we’ve decided to go down this path together – the ski associations, my partners, my team and I are already thinking about how we can use this together to create momentum,” he enthuses. But most importantly, the once undisputed slalom king says he can now compete without pressure, and on his own terms.

“I feel younger than when I stopped in 2019,” he says. “I live a completely different life now.”

Alta Badia, Italy

Located in Italy’s Sella Ronda, Alta Badia is “pure dolce vita for every skier, on and off the slopes” according to Marcel. The resort hosts an annual World Cup event, with the men’s giant slalom taking place on the Gran Risa – the most legendary GS slope in the World Cup where greats including Alberto Tomba triumphed. For the everyday skier, there are around 130km of slopes, most of which are gentle, often wooded, and with captivating scenery – the Dolomites are a UNESCO World Heritage Site and glow pink at sunrise and sunset.



Schladming, Austria

Just over an hour from Salzburg, Schladming is home to the Planai and is where Marcel recorded some of his greatest career moments. “I had the first overall World Cup victory here in 2012, the first World Championship title in 2013 and the last World Cup victory at the Night Race in 2019,” he says. For leisure skiers, there are four mountains dotted with cosy mountain huts offering exceptional food. There are 125km of slopes, and with a ‘Ski Amadé’ lift pass that also covers the nearby Sportwelt, Hochkönig and the Gastein Valley.



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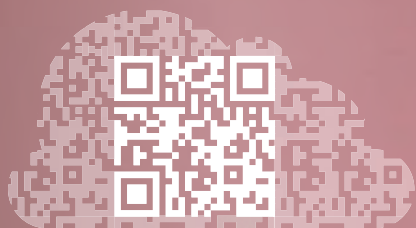

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In a galaxy far

At Iceland's new Saber Academy, *Star Wars* fans can learn to swing a lightsaber like a Jedi. Our writer ventures into their dojo in Reykjavík to give it a try

ar, far away...

People told me I'd see unusual things in Iceland, but I wasn't expecting this. Steaming volcanoes? Yes. Elves? Sure. But a gaggle of grown-ups swinging lightsabers in the basement of a football stadium? It wasn't in the guidebooks.

"We call this move the 'Obi-Ani'," explains Steinar Smári Hrólfsson (aka Stoney), engulfed in a neon blue glow from the saber he's twirling effortlessly around his waist. "It's from *Star Wars: Episode III*, when Obi-Wan and Anakin duel in the control room. It's awesome." Everyone murmurs in agreement.

I'm at Reykjavík's new Saber Academy, where twice a week, lightsaber enthusiasts gather under the Laugardalsvöllur stadium for lessons. For the uninitiated, there are two main styles of lightsabering: full contact combat (think fencing) and a performance-based version, which is what's taught here. A mix of martial arts and dance, participants work together to choreograph and practise routines until they're slick enough to perform or film. The ultimate aim? "To look cool," Stoney grins.

It was this 25-year-old Iclander who set up the academy last year with his girlfriend and fellow lightsaber expert Anna Reneau. The couple had long been obsessed with the craft separately but came together – both romantically and professionally – to

create a dojo where they can share their passion with Iceland's aspiring Jedi.

You'd be hard-pressed to find anyone more qualified. Anna, a 27-year-old originally from Kentucky, USA, has been wielding a saber since she was 16 and knows all there is to know about the seven different combat forms, from Makashi (best for one-on-one duels) to Soresu (most associated with Obi-Wan Kenobi). Until he met Anna, Stoney was more of a solo swinger but has had an affinity for lightsabers since the age of three. "My dad put on the *Star Wars* movies instead of Saturday morning cartoons. I distinctly remember being blown away by the fight scenes from *Episode V* and *Episode I*. After seeing those, I begged for a lightsaber and I've never put it down."

Stoney now has around 60 sabers, including one he designed himself with AzSabers. "This one's mine," he says, pulling a sleek silver-and-blue hilt from a golf bag (the most practical saber case they've found). "I designed it for twirling – the emitter's angled for grip, and the pommel's weighted for

counterbalance. Yeah, a lot of thought went into this,” he laughs. His reviews and saber-twirling skills have even earned him a YouTube following of over 12,000 subscribers, under the handle Stoney Magnum.

With my own saber in hand, class begins. Today, we’re concentrating on Form I: Shii-Cho. In *Star Wars* lore, it’s the oldest and most basic form taught to new Jedi, thus the perfect starting point. Stoney stands across from me and we try out a simple six-move sequence. As the attacker, I swing at his right shoulder, loop the blade around my head, and strike his left. The blows continue toward his head, neck, and legs – each time he blocks them with ease. We move forward and back, trading roles as we repeat the drill. It starts to feel smoother, almost rhythmic – we’re dancing. “This is when you can add some performance into it,” explains Stoney. “Really sell it.” That’s the simplest part for me – I don’t need to feign fear when a huge blade is swinging at my face.

Stoney and Anna follow a framework set out by Saber Academy International. They completed teacher training at the headquarters in Germany last year, before bringing the syllabus back to Iceland. It’s the perfect place for it, considering the Nordic country’s existing links with the iconic films. Any *Star Wars* fan worth their weight in Imperial Credits knows that key scenes in the saga were filmed here: the Eyjafjallajökull glacier in the north, for example, played the ice-encrusted planet Hoth in *The Force Awakens*, while the Krafla Volcano mimicked the mountainous planet Eadu in *Rogue One*.

Perhaps the most recognisable spots, though, are the otherworldly Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach and Hjørleifshöfði, both used to represent planet Lah'mu in *Rogue One's* opening scenes. There's no need for CGI here. Wandering across desolate stretches of obsidian sand, occasionally punctuated by hulking clusters of hexagonal basalt columns, I truly feel like I'm on another planet. A stormtrooper or two wouldn't feel out of place. And yet we're just a couple of hours from a capital city.

“Hollywood filmmakers searching for an alien planet or fantasy realm love Iceland for the uniqueness and variety of our terrain – and how accessible it is,” says Davíð Geir Jónasson, an Icelandic SFX artist who worked on both *The Force Awakens* and *Rogue One*. He also runs adventure tour company Vik Expeditions and is always keen to point out shooting locations for any film buffs on his excursions. “The landscape goes from one extreme to another very quickly. One minute you'll be driving through bleak but beautiful desert and the next you're surrounded by stunning green mountains bursting with life, or on a sprawling glacier, or getting soaked in the spray of a gigantic

waterfall. One of these things alone is great; all of them squeezed together? A filmmaker's dream."

Armed with some basic moves, it's time to take things to the next level. Stoney stands next to me in a stance similar to a Warrior 2 yoga pose. I follow suit, my lightsaber pointing outwards at a 90-degree angle. "Now we add the fun stuff," he says, smoothly twisting his wrist so the saber spins in what's called a 'basic flourish'. Easy, I think, until my wrist rebels, refusing to execute the elegant twirl. Stoney smiles patiently. "Don't worry, it takes practice. Once you get it, you can throw it in between moves to add an extra element of cool."

Although the school's focus is on visual performance, it was founded on something deeper. "What got me into lightsabering in the States was the community. When I was with my group, I felt like I could be totally myself; it was home," says Anna. "I want to create that for people here, especially because Iceland - for all its progressiveness - doesn't fully embrace nerd culture."

Looking around, it's clear she has already succeeded. Kids from the earlier junior session have stuck around to hang out; students swap jokes between sequences; I hear several people

talking about a *Dungeons & Dragons* game happening the following afternoon. And even though I’m the newcomer, I feel immediately included.

The form itself encourages this. Towards the end of the class, we’re paired off and told to create a short sequence with our partners. I’m with Smari Thor Baldursson, a kindly computer scientist who joined the club for his love of *Star Wars* and stayed for the community “where you can be as nerdy as you like and no one judges you for it”. We trade moves and spins, gradually building our own unique routine, like excited children making up a secret handshake in the playground. It feels fun and freeing. “Now we go over it as many times as it takes to get it perfect,” he says.

Finally, it’s time to perform for the class – and the camera. I grip my hilt, try to remember everything I’ve learned, and breathe deeply. The first few moves go well, until I lose my balance on a spin and end up facing the wrong way. Embarrassed, I glance around but no one laughs. My fellow padawans are willing me to do well. As Smari smiles encouragingly, I hear the wise words of Master Yoda himself ring in my ears. “Do or do not. There is no try.” I nod at my partner, ground my feet and lift my lightsaber once more. Action.

UNDERGROUND

Beneath the streets of Brussels there's a wealth of art, history, innovation and unusual sensory experiences. We take a peek below the surface



T

here is no escaping the smell. It rushes at you the moment you open the door of the elegant portico-fronted pavilion, leaving no room for doubt: you're in close proximity to an active sewer system. It's a robust welcome to the Musée des Égouts - the Sewer Museum - in Brussels. Why would anyone want to spend time underground in a sewer, you're possibly wondering. The answer is because it holds the secret to an unusual city planning decision.

It rains in Brussels on more than half of the days of the year. And while that makes underground museums like this the ideal year-round activity, all that water must find its way to the sea. Most cities honour their rivers: London has the Thames; Paris, the Seine. Major landmarks in Budapest, Vienna, Bratislava and Belgrade are framed against the silky waters of the Danube. But in Brussels, city officials banished their river, the Senne, in the mid-19th century by covering it in concrete.

It was once instrumental in the city's growth, but by the 19th century, the river

had become an open sewer, with waste and industrial run-off seeping into it and spawning diseases. Building over the river was a novel approach to this problem, as was building a better sewage system. So today, the only way to see the Senne is to buy a €10 ticket to the Sewer Museum, which explores the importance of efficient water management, and illustrates how the Senne was covered between 1867 and 1871. But the real draw is the self-guided sewer tour.

The smell of sewage is not something you can really get used to, but it's almost worth it for the remarkable sounds - the clamour of voices from somewhere above, or a cacophonous roar, perhaps of a van driving over a manhole. Then there's the gurgle as waste from a tributary pipe plops into the sewer, while echoes of your own footsteps on the metal flooring rattle through the pipes until you emerge beside the Senne. By the time you finish, you'll undoubtedly have a deeper appreciation for the goings-on beneath the city's streets.

Down to earth

Back in the fresh air above, the museum's exit is via a different portico-fronted 19th-century pavilion, identical to the museum's entrance. These two Neoclassical structures were originally toll gates, where taxes on goods entering Brussels were collected. Many of those goods ended up in the cellars of vast warehouses, such as the elegant brick, glass and steel Royal Depot, until the latter half of the 20th century. "This place was empty for 20 years," says Victoria Maertens of PermaFungi, as she leads me through the labyrinth of low-lit hallways on one of the company's hour-long mushroom farm tours (€12.50).

PermaFungi is a forward-thinking cooperative that uses these cellars to grow mushrooms with used coffee grounds from the city's cafés. As we head down, an earthy fug fills the air, lightly spiced with chocolate and cinnamon. PermaFungi combines the grounds, which would ordinarily end up in a landfill, with straw, creating the perfect balance for growing mushrooms.

We wander into a cellar where rows of bulky sacks hang from the ceiling like punching bags at a gym. From some, billowy oyster mushrooms bulge out. "It's so nice to think that mushrooms are growing here, and after they're harvested they are in local shops or restaurants," says Victoria.

In the next room, she shows me the company's latest innovation. It looks like a hexagonal flowerpot, only made from fungi.





“They’re lampshades for a hotel,” explains Victoria. They’re known as mycomaterials – mushrooms grown compactly in a mould. Once they dry out, they can be put to use as light, odourless and completely biodegradable packaging, in place of Styrofoam, or even for sustainable interior art or design projects like these.

Arts and drafts

Another set of subterranean spaces where art and design come together are the city’s underground stations. A chill floods Belgica metro station, followed by the whoosh of an approaching train as I head down the escalators. Although the network’s web of tunnels is plastered with graffiti, the stations are quite the opposite, thanks to a decades-long policy by the Brussels Intercommunal Transport Company (STIB) of employing artists to transform them with ambitious art installations. Statues, mosaics and other artworks enliven ticket halls and platforms at no fewer than 69 Metro stations around Brussels, including futuristic red skylights at Pannenhuis, and a dedication to Belgian cartoonist Hergé at Stockel.

Thierry Verbeeck is one of the artists involved. He created one of the Polar

Frescoes lining the walls of Belgica station, partnering up with Cedric Bourgaux, who created the one opposite. “On my first visit to the station, I remember thinking that it was cold and sombre,” he says. An apt starting point, then, for creating a fresco about Antarctica. “Belgica is the name of the ship of the first Belgian explorer in the Antarctic,” he explains. The artwork is a timeline, featuring imagery of the original Belgica, then winding through wintry landscapes to the modern Belgian research base in Antarctica, Princess Elizabeth Station. Thierry’s artwork was commissioned to commemorate its opening in 2009.

Despite the cold climates it depicts, the artwork is imbued with warm tones – deep oranges, lemon yellow and turquoise –

which act as relief against the cold station, but also signals a subtle warning about global warming. “Since I made this, the situation has become catastrophic. I feel as though we need to change the text on the art to add some degrees of global warming,” Thierry says.

Much of Thierry’s work is designed to be thought-provoking, tackling issues such as climate change and the impact the digital world has on our lives. He normally does this with transgressive installations in public places, where people are forced to pay attention as they navigate the city.

But Thierry seems surprised at the lack of graffiti. The fresco still looks fresh. “In the public space, you don’t have any rules. Anybody can vandalise or respond to your work. It’s the game. It’s the life of the place.”

Perhaps the message in the art is too important to damage, or perhaps even graffiti artists have respect for the creativity on display in Brussels’ underground spaces – after all, it beats getting caught in the rain.

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The Afro- Swedes



Thanks to African and Caribbean influences, Stockholm has become a mix of bold flavours and compelling art. We meet the Afro-Swedes shaping the cultural landscape

In Stockholm's historic Haga Park, I find myself dancing at Boulebar Haga, a 1960s bus terminal that's been converted into a bar. In the basement, people are playing boules, tumblers of beer in hand. On the top floor, I'm swaying to Afrobeats as part of the pop-up 30+ club, Dirty Thirty. The atmosphere is soulful and refreshing on a dark Nordic night.

As a naturalised Afro-Swede, this modern duality is what I live everyday alongside Sweden's long revered image of blondes, Volvos, and Midsummer celebrations. Travellers to the picturesque city may not know that Afro-Swedes have long called Sweden home since the 18th century; probably much longer because of not being documented in the official population register before then.

To fully enjoy Stockholm is to experience its cultural intersections. The Afro experience here is deeply sensory - from pairing spices from the continent with Nordic ingredients and colourful twists on the Swedish tradition of *fika*. It's about curating exhibition spaces and festivals where people can connect with Afro-Nordic artists, or simply dance to rhythms that move you both limb and soul. Here we meet the next generation of Swedes who are leaving their legacy on Stockholm's cultural scene.

Duane Shepherd

“I told myself, if I’m going to live here for the rest of my life, I need to make sure that I have Caribbean food to eat,” Duane Shepherd laughs as we sit in his Afro-Caribbean restaurant, Cane Rum Society, which he co-founded four years ago.

Born in Trinidad, Duane moved to London as a teenager, where he met his Swedish wife before moving to Sweden in 2013. “It was a struggle to find good Caribbean food here, so I made it my mission to open a restaurant,” he says. With over 40 years’ experience in the hospitality business, including

owning several restaurants and businesses in London as an expert on rum, it’s no surprise the Cane Rum Society has over 2,000 varieties to choose from.

“I also wanted to create a meeting point for people of African and Caribbean heritage,” he says. “A place where they could come, feel welcome and meet people from their country.” When he first moved to Sweden, he met only two Trinidadians. “Now I know close to 60, who come from all over the country for our jerk chicken, curry goat and grilled coconut shrimp.” canerumsociety.com

Coumba Badin

No daily ritual is more revered than the Swedish institution of fika – breaking for coffee and buns – and Coumba Badin knows all about it. Residents flock to Petit Plaisir, her café, for decadent white chocolate-dipped Madeleine sponge cakes, macarons, petit choux and chocolate éclairs.

“While my roots in West Africa influence my approach to flavours and hospitality, Sweden has provided the backdrop for my entrepreneurial journey,” says Senegalese-French Coumba. “I feel connected to both cultures. That fusion is reflected in the warmth and creativity that Petit Plaisir brings to every cake and pastry.”

Founded in 2020, what started out as Coumba’s personal passion for French pastries has morphed into the hottest patisserie in town, with an enviable list of clients including Netflix, Spotify, L’Oreal and Lancôme to name a few. “One of my highlights was partnering with the Swedish Royal Opera on a large-scale cake design,” she says. “It was a challenging yet fulfilling

experience that pushed the boundaries of my creativity.”

Coumba hopes Petit Plaisir grows into a well-known name across Sweden. “I want to introduce more flavours I grew up with in Senegal while staying true to the French techniques I love,” she says. “Ultimately, I want Petit Plaisir to become a place that brings people together over delicious pastries, memorable cakes and meaningful moments.”

“We’ve just received permission from the Swedish government to return 39 artworks,” says Michael Barrett. We’re standing in the exhibition hall marvelling at statues and artefacts from the Benin Kingdom of Nigeria. Michael, who is of Jamaican and Swedish descent, is also the curator of the African collections at the National Museums of World Culture (NMWC), based at the Museum of Ethnography (Etnografiska) in Stockholm. He considers himself Black, Afro-Caribbean and Afro-Swedish.

“The Benin exhibition is important because it confirms Sweden’s and the museum’s role in extractive colonialism, a legacy which we are still dealing with today in terms of racism and global political and economic inequalities,” explains Michael. “The artworks shown are part of the more than 5,000 pieces that the British looted from Benin City in 1897.”

According to Michael, the 39-artwork update to the exhibition shows how the museum is addressing this shameful legacy. “Since the collection is deemed to be Swedish state property, the museum had to ask for government permission to return them. Now we are talking to our Nigerian partners at the National Commission for Museums and Monuments about a timeline for the physical return of the artworks.”

The NMWC may be able to retain some of the artworks as long-term loans as part of the Swedish National Museum’s Ongoing Africa project. They aim to share different perspectives, spotlight the long connection between Sweden and Africa, and unearth the stories of people of African descent who lived in Sweden centuries ago. In essence, finally recognising Afro-Swedes. etnografiskamuseet.se

Yemisi Wilson

Sculptor Yemisi Wilson guides me through her exquisite carvings made of granite and alabaster while we discuss her fascinating background. Her dad hails from Nigeria, while her mother is Swedish and left the country for the UK at 19 years old. Yemisi’s own artistic journey spans Italy, Spain, India and Sweden. “That’s also why I think I have a strong character too,” she says. “I come from a family of strong women. And to work with material such as stone, you need to be stubborn.”

The world-renowned sculptor’s ongoing exhibitions pay homage to her grandmothers, Ebunola and Anna, and they deeply explore her Nigerian-Swedish heritage, reflecting on family history, roots and identity using materials such as alabaster, marble and black granite. Her latest show is at the Southnord art gallery in Stockholm, where Zimbabwean-Swedish artistic director, Marcia Harvey Isaksson, ensures that

there is always space set aside for Black and Afro-Nordic artists.

For Yemisi, picking a favourite medium is like having a current boyfriend. You’re in love with it right at this moment – whether it’s marble or alabaster – until a new love comes along: Indian granite.

Stones can date back billions of years and according to Yemisi, “a sculptor can never give up. It takes so much time, patience, and physicality with hammers, saws and chisels, but you need to be eager to see what’s around the corner. When you open it up, it’s the first time that that surface hits the air. So it’s a material of memory. It’s made of memory because it’s billions of years old.”

This is also why we immortalise people and cultures in stone, she notes. “Historically, when there’s war, we melt metal down to make weapons. We burn wood to make fires, but stone is timeless. It gives me a safe ground for my feet being part of the diaspora – I belong to Sweden, I belong to Nigeria, I belong to Italy. I belong to women who raised their child alone. There are so many groups that I belong to. Working with stone grounds me.”

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Katarina Chintoh

For Swedes, minimalism means paring down to the functional essentials you need while investing in high quality so those essentials last. Those three tenets – functionality, quality, and aesthetics – are the foundations of Swedish design. A World of Craft brings together Scandinavian aesthetics and crafts from Africa, Asia and Latin America.

“One of my favourite items is the Bolga basket from Ghana,” says Ghanaian-Swede Katarina

Chintoh, one of A World of Craft’s co-founders. “They are very useful and have beautiful patterns.”

Walking into the store feels like being transported into a vibrant bazaar filled with textiles, handwoven baskets, Ankara print outfits and wooden masks, among other interior decor items.

First established in 1967 as Afroart, the iconic arts and crafts store in Stockholm was bought by six textile designers in 2003 and A World of Craft was born. Katarina says their goal is to support fair trade practices and create new job opportunities in regions where craftsmanship plays a crucial role in the livelihoods of local people.

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
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This year is set to be bigger and better than ever for the world's most famous supercar brand. We take a pilgrimage to Bologna - the home of Ferrari - to uncover the secrets of the prancing horse

FAST LANE

If the Ferrari Museum in Maranello is a temple to the world's most famous sports car brand, then the "Victory Room" is its inner sanctum. Shelves groan with well-polished trophies, displayed like sacred relics. On a banked curve reminiscent of a racetrack are eight Formula 1 cars, their dart-like noses angled down towards the *tifosi*, or fans, who stand so close they could touch them. Among these is the model Kimi Räikkönen drove to win Ferrari's most recent championship, in 2008, and two of Michael Schumacher's championship-winning cars.

On the wall opposite, illuminated by halos of light, are portraits of this pair – as well as the seven other brave souls who have driven the famous prancing horse logo to an overall title. Two of them, Alberto Ascari and Mike Hawthorn, died tragically young –

martyrs to the pursuit of ever-greater speed and the lax safety standards of the 1950s. But along with Juan Manuel Fangio, Niki Lauda, John Surtees, Jody Scheckter and Phil Hill, their names have passed into legend.

Soon, it's hoped, there will be another addition to this roll of honour, completing a holy trinity of British drivers, alongside Hawthorn and Surtees, to win the World Championship for the Italian brand. "Any driver that comes to Ferrari is expected to win," says Michele Pignatti Morano, the museum's director, "but Lewis Hamilton is a seven-times world champion, so everybody is really looking forward to having him."

When Hamilton announced his move to Ferrari for the 2025 season – a team that had previously been home to some of his fiercest rivals – it took most of the



motor racing world by surprise. But for Michele, the decision made complete sense. "I think all drivers, at some point, want to come to Ferrari, they want that on their CV," he says. The company's F1 team is not just the oldest in the sport, it's by far the most successful, having won 16 Constructors' Championships, 15 drivers' titles and 248 Grands Prix – 60 more than its nearest rival, McLaren. Winning a Championship for Ferrari carries a different weight, Michele believes. "With the others, yes, you are a world champion, but you don't pass into history in the same way."

Of course, driving for the Scuderia, or stable, as the company's racing division is known, comes with a unique set of pressures too. "This feels like a national team, even though it's a private company," explains Felipe Vergara, my guide to the museum. "It's not the

same as if you're driving for Mercedes. If you win with Ferrari, the President of Italy will say something, and you have 60 million Italians supporting you – as well as fans from everywhere else around the world."

As we wander through the hallowed halls of the Maranello site, we pass French language tours, and families speaking Mandarin. I stop and chat to Suri Aramant, a tech entrepreneur and *Top Gear* fan from Kerala, as well as Jacqueline Sly and Matt Heisie, a couple who both studied engineering in LA. And this is just one of two museums that Michele and his team oversee. Between this space, dedicated to the nearby factory and the F1 team, and their second site, at founder Enzo Ferrari's birthplace in Modena, the Ferrari Museums attracted more than 700,000 people last year.



To understand how a private car company became so globally popular, and such an integral part of Italy's sporting identity, it helps to understand something of Enzo Ferrari himself. Ironically, Michele says: "Enzo Ferrari was actually against museums. He always said, 'my cars belong on the road, or on the racetrack,' and he was all about progress, progress, progress."

His objection to looking backwards is perhaps best summed up in a quote now emblazoned above the reception desk at the Maranello site: "The best Ferrari ever built is the next one." Ferrari, who worked right up until his death aged 90, never lost his focus on staying ahead of the competition. Neither of the museums were opened during his lifetime, Michele explains, and although they are now both managed by the brand, they were actually first set up by local municipal authorities in Maranello and Modena who needed somewhere to send visiting fans.

Today, out of deference to Enzo's tastes, the museums make sure they change exhibits every year, usually on 18 February, his birthday. "We like to say the best Ferrari exhibition is the next one," Michele says, and the vast majority of the cars they put on

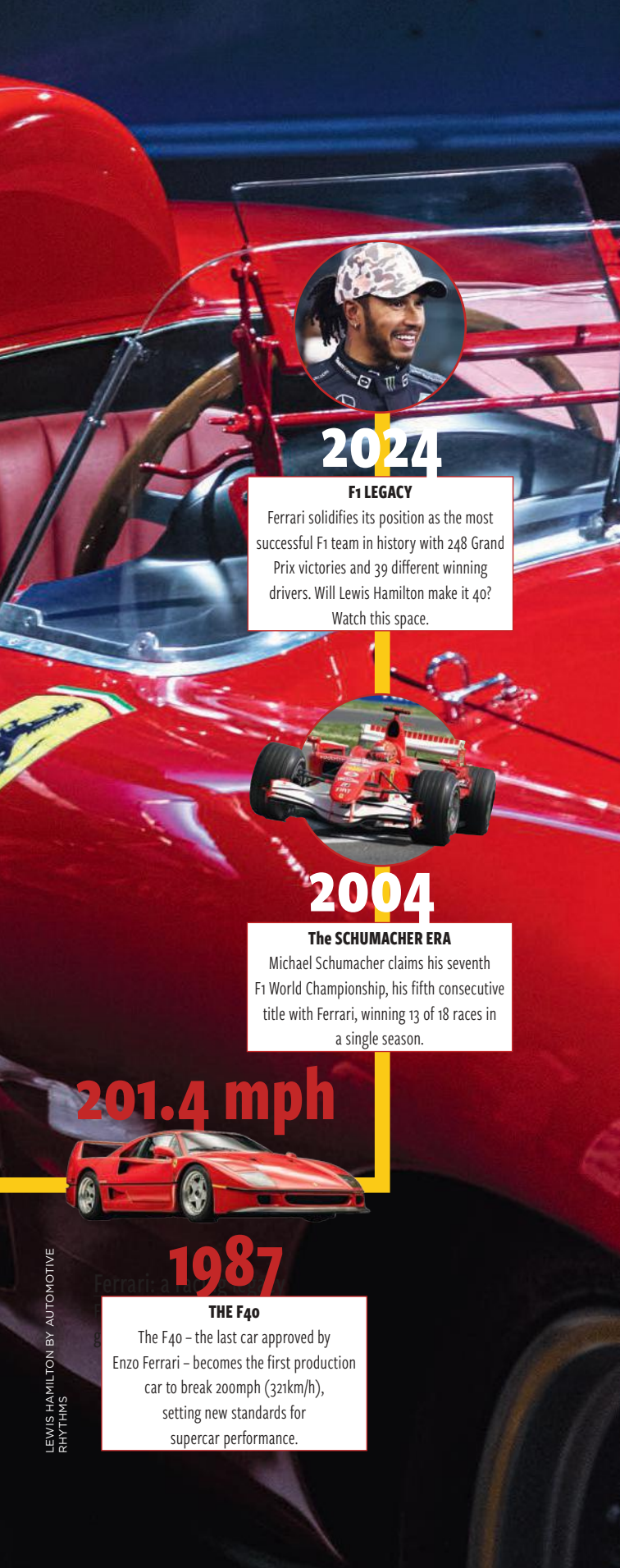

was eventually shot down and killed, but his mother believed the horse had brought him luck, and 'gave' it to Enzo as a racing emblem when they met in 1923. I also learn that while most automakers raced to market their road cars, for Ferrari it was always the other way round - he sold road cars to fund his racing team.

It helps that Felipe Vergara, who comes from the Modena area and started giving tours as a summer job at 16, is a brilliantly informative guide. He was recently given the honour of showing Pénélope Cruz, co-star of the 2023 biopic *Ferrari*, around the museum, along with her husband, Javier Bardem, and their kids. Felipe talks eloquently about the pride Ferrari's presence brings to this region. "There's this guy from Modena, which is a small town, and he's competing against Ford, against Rolls Royce, against the biggest brands in the world, and he's making cars that win." And he also shares a wealth of

display - almost all borrowed from collectors - are working models. "You could still drive them out on the road," Michele says.

Around these central exhibits, Michele and his team weave the story of Enzo himself, starting with his humble beginnings in Modena, his service in WWI, and his successful career as a racing driver for Alfa Romeo in the 20s or 30s. They tell how in 1929, he founded the Scuderia, a stable initially made up of wealthy gentlemen amateurs, which helped pay for his own racing. And how it wasn't until 1947 that he started building cars himself.

There are fascinating details, like the story of the prancing horse, which was first used by Italy's greatest WWI fighter ace, Count Francesco Baracca, on his biplane. Baracca





insider info – including the fun fact that Ferrari has an entire department dedicated solely to evaluating engine noise.

I get to hear their handiwork up close later that afternoon, at the Aerautodromo di Modena, where I've signed up to test drive a Ferrari 488 Challenge on the track. It's often described as a low, guttural roar, but I can hear higher notes in the mix – as if an entire orchestra of lions were tuning up. The sound is incredible, but it does nothing to calm my nerves.

Thankfully, I am in excellent hands. Francesco Baroni, my instructor, used to race professionally in Formula 2. We start with a demonstration lap, where he calmly explains the paddle shift gears as I hold on in the passenger seat. Later, he'll tell me that he sees his job as “part driver, part psychologist,” and says a significant number of his first-time clients back out at this point. While there's no danger of that, I can't shake the feeling, when we switch seats, that I'm being handed a loaded gun.

“It's a little wet today, so we will try to keep the speed to 200km/h, instead of 230km/h,” Baroni had said, in our safety briefing. In the end, my caution through the corners means I only reach 180 on the straights, but it's more than enough to get a sense of the machine's awesome power. When my laps are up, I'm left wanting more, and get out of the car reluctantly, with a huge grin on my face.

Back at Ferrari's birthplace in Modena, Felipe Vergara told me: “Enzo used to say that he himself wasn't the best at anything,





except knowing who was the best at everything, and bringing those people – the best drivers, engineers, designers and so on – together.” Despite the founders’ objections to them, the Ferrari museums have a similarly unifying effect on his fans.

When I suggest this to Michele Pignatti Morano, he smiles. “We always say, the museum is for everybody,” he says. This is why they keep historic loan cars worth millions of pounds out on open display, he explains. Because although Ferrari’s customers are by nature, an exclusive, self-selecting group, the brand would be nothing without the passion of its fans. “You will see the welcome that the tifosi give to Hamilton,” he says. “The atmosphere will be incredible.”

If he wins a record eighth title for himself, and a 17th for Ferrari, it’s hard to see where they’d fit the trophies, I say. But Michele is already preparing for that. “I always tell the drivers when they come, ‘yes we are a small museum, but don’t worry about space’. If you win, we’ll find the space.”

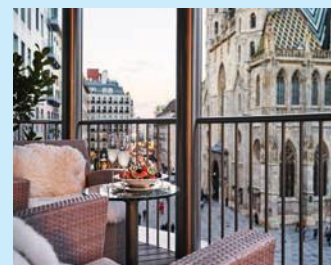


Hótel VON

We're back in Chisinau

Wizz Air announces the reopening of its Chisinau base from 16 December, strengthening its presence in the Moldovan market.

The airline will restore seven key routes from Chisinau to Berlin, Bologna, Brussels Charleroi, Dortmund, Memmingen, Paris Beauvais and Verona, while introducing a new service to Nuremberg. Combined with existing flights to Abu Dhabi, Budapest, Milan, Venice, Vienna,

Rome, London Luton and Warsaw, this expansion creates a network of 16 routes across nine countries from the Moldovan capital.

In addition to offering Moldovans expanded connectivity, these routes will offer passengers from Europe and beyond the chance to explore Chisinau's attractions, from the stunning 19th-century Metropolitan Cathedral of Christ's Nativity to the serene Valea Morilor Park with its lake and forest trails.

Fueling sustainability

Wizz Air and Airbus will trial operations with the use of Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) on key routes from Barcelona to Budapest, and from Brussels to Budapest. The initiative helps WIZZ prepare for the EU's upcoming RefuelEU regulations, which aim to increase SAF use starting in 2025. The trial will use SAF supplied by Moeve (formerly known as Cepsa) and distributed by World Fuel Services, a World Kinect company.

“To provide high-quality training, we need a high-quality training centre”

Meet the expert team behind the opening of Wizz Air’s new, cutting-edge training centre in Rome

One of the pillars that makes Wizz Air an exceptional airline is teamwork – the ability for everyone across the company to pull together to get the job done. Nowhere is that more apparent than at the new Wizz Air training centre at Rome Fiumicino Airport, which opened in October. A state-of-the-art, 2,500+ m² facility near Terminal 1 with briefing rooms, training and dining areas and a simulator hall, its planning and construction was a remarkable two-year mission.

“The new training centre is a multidisciplinary project, involving, internally alone, more than 20 different stakeholders,” says Project Manager Julio Cruz. “Keeping everyone on track and synchronised was the most important thing – and they did a great job.”

Training Centre Operations Manager Nikoletta Zima smiles as she recalls how different departments worked together. “We were taking care of each other, doing our own job but also keeping an eye on the project as a whole. It was extraordinary,” she says.

The journey started in October 2022 with the search for the ideal city to act as the location for Wizz Air’s second training centre – the first facility having opened in Budapest in 2018. A huge mathematical model was built in order to define the best location, based on strategic network connections, future company growth plans and cost-effective logistics. The Eternal City proved to be the perfect fit.

“Rome’s strategic position in our network provides connectivity and its well-established air, rail and road networks facilitate seamless travel for our employees,” Julio points out. “Also, Rome’s dynamic business environment, coupled with its thriving aviation industry, positions Wizz Air for sustained growth, while rigorous cost analysis revealed the city offers the most favourable logistics-related expenses.”

Aligning with Wizz Air’s culture of being agile and fast-growing, it took just nine months for the training centre to be built. One of the biggest logistical challenges was shipping and installing two full flight simulators weighing 18 tonnes each from Canada.



“You try to make a truck fit where it barely fits, you try to hold up traffic so a forklift can pass and you sweat nervously when different pieces of machinery hang in the air,” says Group Facility Manager Zalan Boda, recalling the arrival of the simulators, which run up to 20 hours a day and train up to 135 pilots a month. “Once the pieces of the simulators arrived at the training centre, specialist companies craned it inside and an adult-complexity LEGO-ing started, involving tonnes of heavy parts and high voltage.”

Key to the success of establishing the facility was the experience senior Wizz Air staff like Nikoletta had in successfully opening the Budapest training centre.

“I’m fully aware of the fine-tuning and issues we needed to pay attention to,” she says. “We learned a lot from the first

training centre in Budapest and used all that knowledge to build an amazing new facility. In addition to the simulators, we have three classrooms in Rome for pilot recruitment and cabin crew training. And we have a team of trainers we are very proud of. To provide high-quality training, we need a high-quality training centre.”

As important as providing the best training possible is the fact that those who enter the training centre feel right at home. “When you walk through the door you feel you are part of the Wizz Air family,” says Nikoletta. “After all the hard work everyone has put in, to see this second training centre and how the company is growing makes me so proud.”

Safe handling of hand luggage

Ensure that your larger hand luggage remains safely stowed in the locker and the smaller ones are under the seat in front of you for take-off, landing and whenever instructed by the crew. Passengers seated in the emergency rows and first row must store their cabin bags in the overhead lockers. Take care when opening lockers, as falling items may injure fellow passengers. **In case of evacuation, all baggage must be left on board, and the instructions of the cabin crew must be strictly followed.**



Safety equipment

It is an offence to tamper with or remove safety equipment, including adult and infant life vests, infant safety belts or extension belts. You are not allowed to remove or damage any onboard informative placards.



Sharp items

To dispose of sharp items (e.g. hypodermic needles), contact a cabin crew member. Do not leave it behind.



Turbulence management

Turbulence can occur unexpectedly. Whenever seatbelt signs are switched on, remain seated, keep seatbelts fastened and stow away large electronic devices. For your safety, we recommend that you keep your seatbelts visibly fastened at all times when seated.



Safety of infants on board

Wizz Air has a clear procedure for infant (a child under two) restraint systems. You can only use the single hook infant seatbelt - vests/slings cannot be used with the infant seatbelt. Wizz Air only accepts aft-facing car seats when an extra seat is purchased. **However, during take-off, landing and whenever the seatbelt sign is switched on, infants should sit on an adult's lap with the seatbelt fastened.** Life vests for infants are available and are provided whenever flying over water. All lavatories are equipped with a changing table. Do not leave children unattended in the cabin.



Lithium batteries

Portable electronic devices (PED) such as phones, laptops and tablets can contain lithium batteries. When damaged, faulty or overheated, these batteries can catch fire and explode. **If you recognise any issues with your device, inform the cabin crew immediately.**



Charging electronic devices on board using a portable battery charger is forbidden.

Electronic devices

Some electronic devices can be used during the flight with **WLAN/Wi-Fi/Bluetooth turned off.**

Larger electronic devices that cannot be held comfortably in one hand, exceed ca. 1kg in weight and do not qualify as handheld devices (e.g. laptops, notebooks etc.) must be stowed in the overhead stowage compartments for takeoff, landing and whenever required by the cabin crew. **If in doubt, please ask your cabin crew.**

Inflight health tips

Read these tips on how to stay fit when travelling.



Before your air travel

Consult your doctor before travelling if you have any medical concerns. Pregnant women and those with heart or respiratory problems, blood diseases or ear, nose and sinus infections should seek medical advice before flying. **Crew members are entitled to call for medical assistance pre-flight if they deem it necessary and are in doubt about your fitness for the flight.**

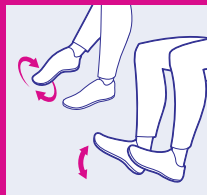
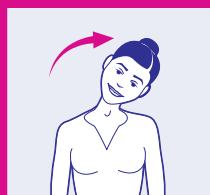
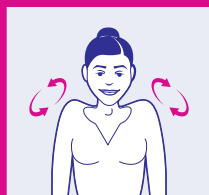
Keep any medication you may need in your hand luggage and in its original packaging. **Inform cabin crew of allergies or illnesses.** If you are seriously ill or travelling post-surgery, you will need a medical certificate confirming that you are fit to fly. If you have limited mobility, are hearing- or sight-impaired, pregnant, or unable to understand/react to safety instructions, you will be unable to sit in the emergency exit rows or the front row. **If you start to feel unwell during the flight, do not hesitate to talk to the cabin crew.**



Nut allergy

During our WIZZ Café service we offer peanuts and some snacks containing peanuts/nuts traces. **If you have any allergies we strongly encourage you to take all necessary medical precautions before flying, and to inform the cabin crew during boarding about your allergy.**

Why smoking is banned on flights

Airlines started banning smoking in the late 1980s and by 2000 it was made illegal across the world. Here are the reasons why

Secondhand smoke: Secondhand smoke contains over 7,000 chemicals, including at least 70 known carcinogens. Breathing these harmful chemicals in the confined space of an aircraft poses serious health risks.

It impacts air quality:

Cigarette smoke can circulate in the confined air and lead to unpleasant odours. It impairs the air quality and jeopardises how the cabin pressure system functions, which can result in a lack of oxygen at high altitude.

It's a fire hazard: A lit cigarette can ignite flammable materials, potentially leading to a catastrophic fire in the cabin. Extinguishing fires mid-flight is challenging.

Electronic cigarettes/vapes/IQOS can cause concern:

Therefore they are also not allowed on in the cabin. While e-cigarettes produce vapour rather than smoke, the visible vapour can be mistaken for traditional cigarette smoke, causing confusion and potential alarm among passengers.

Dry air conditions: The dry air in the aircraft cabin can make fuel more flammable.

Smoke detectors: The smoke detector in the toilets is linked to a warning system. When triggered,



the smoke detector notifies cabin crew through a control panel in the cockpit and triggers an audible alarm throughout the aircraft cabin. This system helps cabin crew swiftly address emergency situations related to smoke on board.

Overheating batteries: Vaping, IQOS and e-cigarettes work with lithium-ion batteries that are more likely to overheat or explode while being used.

SMOKING ON A PLANE COULD LEAD TO:

- Fines of up to €3,000
- A ban from flying with that airline for life
- As per the applicable law, smokers on board may face prosecution.

Remember, lighting up during a flight is not only illegal but also jeopardises the wellbeing and safety of everyone on board. The ashtrays in the passenger cabin and restrooms are not an optional design element and not an invitation to smoke. Cabin crew members are trained to extinguish smoke and fire and eliminate any potential danger.

Not tolerated on board...

- Smoking on board (including classic cigarettes or e-cigarettes, pipes, vapes), might result in a fine of up to €3,000 or prosecution. Additionally all existing Wizz Air flight bookings will be cancelled



- Consuming alcohol that was not purchased on board. Alcohol is served at the crew's discretion to passengers of legal drinking age. The crew reserves the right to stop serving alcohol to any passenger who is, or appears to be, intoxicated
- Being under the influence of drugs or substances that may affect your behaviour or self-control



- Damaging the aircraft or onboard equipment
- Wasting, polluting or contaminating the cabin
- Endangering the safety of the flight by any means
- Breaching, or refusing to follow, crew instructions



- Harassing fellow passengers and/or crew members in any way (including sexual harassment)
- Threatening or being aggressive towards fellow passengers and/or crew members
- Being violent or behave in a hostile, erratic manner



- Filming or photographing the cabin crew without their permission

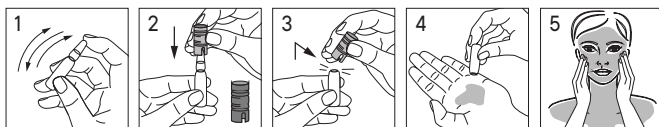
