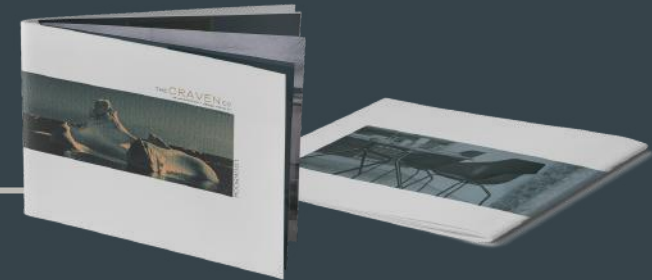

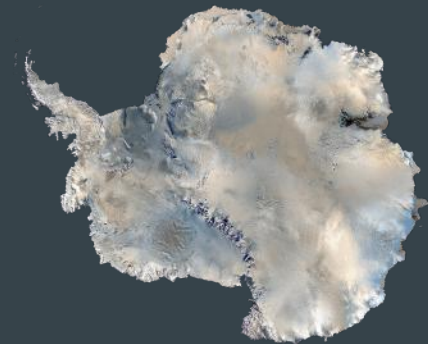
Just before launching The CRAVEN Co., I had the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to visit Antarctica.

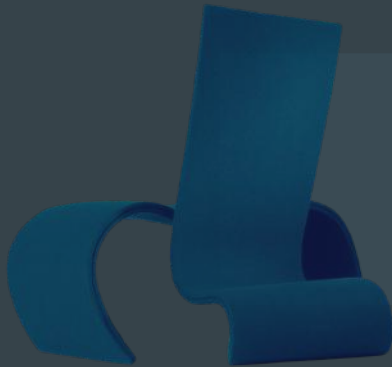
Designers seeking to integrate natural elements into their built environments have a rich palette in Antarctica.

It features a twisting form, defined negative space and a side profile that resembles a swan.

"A beautiful quote I heard is that it looks like a suspended piece of fettuccini, mid-twist," says Kontouris. "It looks like a different chair from each view."

RESILIENCY

When the New York Times announced "The Coolest Architecture on Earth is in Antarctica," worldwide attention was drawn to the continent's masterworks of resilient design.

The structures that make up the laboratories and housing in Antarctica must be resilient since the health and safety of the occupants hangs in the balance. They are more like space capsules than traditional buildings, purposely designed to be efficient and flexible in the inhospitable landscape.

Consider Britain's Halley VI. Built on a floating ice shelf in the Weddell Sea, the station's modular design offers the flexibility critical to working in an ever-changing climate.
