JAMES WALDRON, MSU DEMMER CENTER SPARTANS - MICHIGAN S3DA

"I had been hunting with no luck and got offered to take part in a hunt where they run dogs. It was a very exciting, but wet morning. I have never been on a hunt where they ran dogs and I had no idea what to expect. The dogs got on the scent of a bear and successfully got the bear in a tree. The bear exited the first two trees as fast as he went up them. The third tree I was able to execute a shot. This is my first Michigan black bear, which weighed in at 200 pounds."

CODY STIDHEM, NAMPA BOW CHIEFS S3DA - IDAHO S3DA

"This was a very special hunt for me for many reasons. You see, my dad and I had gone out the year before, for pronghorn, and I had many shot opportunities, but I just could not seal the deal. Each time I had a chance for a shot, I would get super excited, start to shake, and something would go wrong. I learned a lot last season and with perserverance was able to find success."



BENJAMIN KNAPP, GATEWAY SHARPSHOOTERS - MISSOURI S3DA

"I was picked for a managed youth duck hunt put on by the Missouri Dept. of Conservation. This allowed me the opportunity to learn about duck hunting in the classroom as well as a hunt in a flooded marsh. I was able to harvest a mallard drake and hen pair. This was my first ever duck hunt, so it was a brand new experience."

ALIVIA SLUSSER, READING ARCHERY CLUB - PENNSYLVANIA S3DA

"I went hunting with my dad. After sitting for several hours, this buck stepped out at forty yards and started walking away. After a couple of lite grunts, the buck stopped and started coming back, giving me a twenty-three yard shot. After a perfect shot, and a very short track job, we were able to locate the buck roughly sixty yards away."



RAYNA SCHNOPP, ANCHOR POINT ARCHERY TEAM - WEST VIRGINIA S3DA

"I was in my tree stand when I saw seven does walk out. I let them go and waited to see if a buck would come. About five minutes later, a 4-point comes in and starts eating the block we left out. I stood up and started to draw back when he was at the perfect position. From about 25 yards, I took the shot, and he went about 50 yards into a creek. I called my dad and we started to look. I found him and I was in shock. Definitely a memorable evening."

ANNABELL JACKSON, OWENSBORO ARCHERY CLUB - KENTUCKY S3DA

"This was my first time in the tree this year. I passed on some deer the previous two years, because I really wanted my first harvest to be a nice buck. My dad and I were in the tree no more than ten minutes when we spotted this 8-point buck. He headed directly uphill to us and stopped broadside at 12 yards, giving me the perfect shot opportunity. I released and knew I had made a good shot. This is my first deer and I was so excited. My whole family was there to help tote him out."

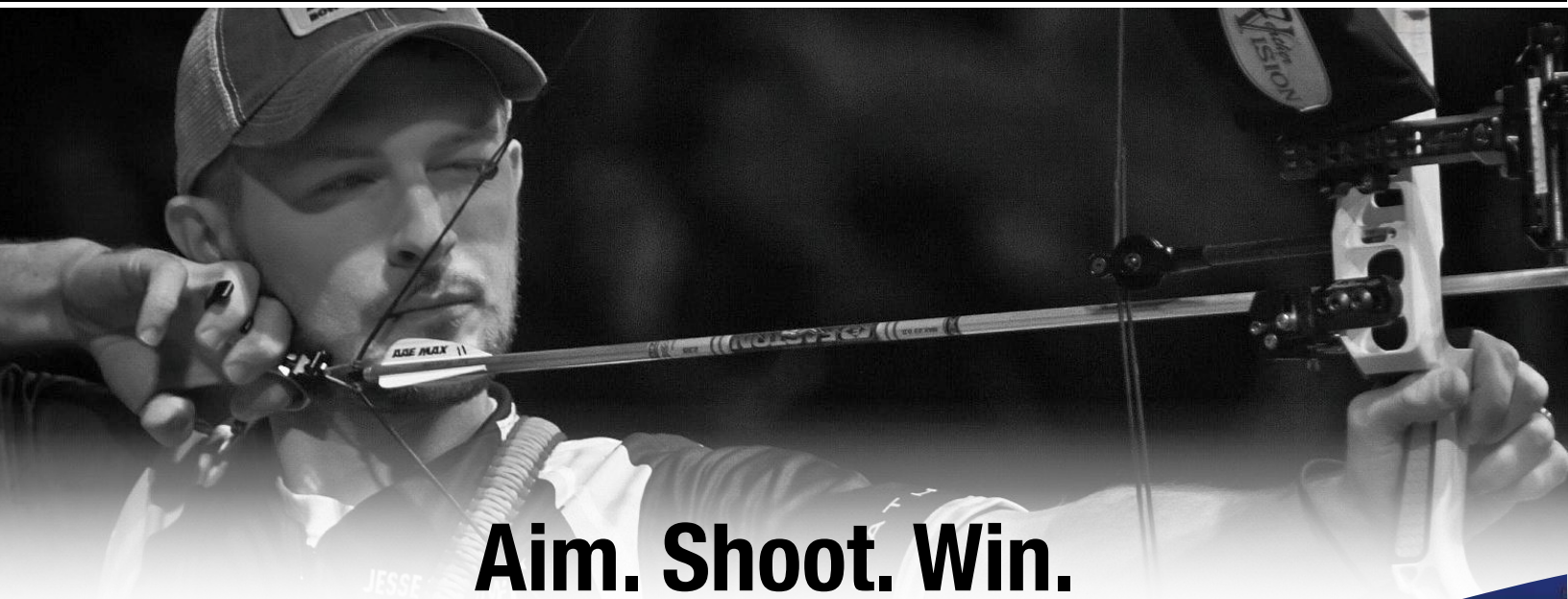
