



# The philanthropic initiatives of KSUC No Child of a Lesser God

Community service has always been at the heart of KSUC's activities. Along with celebrating our cultural traditions, we remain committed to giving back to society in meaningful ways. Each year, we dedicate part of our efforts and resources to initiatives that support education, child welfare, and social well-being. This year too, we are glad to carry that tradition forward.

Like in earlier years, we were able to raise funds for social welfare work.



With the Committee's decision, we set out to support three local Anganwadi centers in neighbourhood. These centers are part of the Government of India's Integrated Child Development Services program. They play a vital role in providing early learning, care, and nutrition to young children, especially those from families where parents are daily wage earners or often without steady iobs.

The children (aged 3–6 years) come from poor and underprivileged families, where scarcity is a daily reality. Their deprivation is hard to miss, and harder still to ignore. We felt it was time to take a small step to bring them some joy and support.

We plan to provide the children with school bags, notebooks, pencils, pencil boxes, and water bottles. In addition, we will support the Anganwadi centers with chairs, floor mats, and a few educational toys to enhance the learning environment.

To ensure the contributions are meaningful, our team visited the centers in person. Through our conversations with the staff and teachers, we prepared a practical list of items that would best serve their needs.

Through this small initiative, we hope to bring joy to the little ones and contribute to their early growth and development.







A culminating brouhaha of petrichor is raised, Monsoon diary invokes again the muses of nostalgic days.


A cup of streaming capachino brewing some favourite symphony on lips



# Kedarnath Yatra: Each step is a narrative, and every breath is a blessing

There are journeys that begin with a plan, and then there are those that begin with a calling. The Kedarnath Yatra belongs to the latter. Nestled in the lap of the Garhwal Himalayas, Kedarnath is not just a destination—it is a pilgrimage for the soul, a walk into silence, and a moment of surrender to the almighty.

This travelogue is a humble attempt to capture the essence of a two-day journey to one of India's most revered shrines. From the bustling ghats of Haridwar to the serene heights of Kedarnath, every step was a blend of challenge and grace. The trek tested endurance, the temple offered peace, and the mountains whispered timeless wisdom.


#### Day 1: Haridwar to Sonprayag

**6:00 AM:** The day began with the chants of "Har Har Mahadev" echoing through the ghats of Haridwar. We took the cab and started our journey towards Sonprayag, a village in the Rudraprayag district of Uttarakhand. The drive was long—almost 8-10 hours—but the changing landscapes kept us mesmerized. We took the route through **Haridwar** – **Rishikesh** – **Devprayag** – **Srinagar** – **Rudraprayag** – **Guptkashi** – **Sonprayag**.

On the way in Devprayag, we witnessed the **holy confluence where the Alaknanda and Bhagirathi rivers join to form the Ganga**. The entire journey was accompanied by breathtaking views and roar of the rivers.

After having lunch we continued our journey and reached Triyuginarayan temple, the ancient temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu. Legends say that the sacred wedding of Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati took place here. At the temple, it is believed that the eternal flame or Akhanda Dhuni was lit during their wedding and has been burning continuously since then.

After taking the blessing there, we reached Sonprayag in the evening.



#### Sonprayag to Gaurikund

From Sonprayag, a short jeep ride took us to Gaurikund. This was unique as only specific vehicles were permitted to ride through these roads. Gaurikund, the base camp for the trek to Kedarnath.

The temperature was around 3-4 degrees. The sacred hot water spring in that low temperature added to our astonishment. We also visited the Gaurikund temple dedicated to Goddess Parvati.

Its time to take some rest and get ready for the trek next day.

#### Day 2: Trek To Kedarnath

Good morning, its 3:30AM! We are ready to start the trek. A 22 km hike one way. We packed all essentials and started on foot. Soon enough we were among the scores of people towards the same destination. Whether on foot or on the back of a pony or at the back of "pithu" or palki – everyone had the same dream – to have a darshan of baba Bholenath. After walking for sometime, we got the first glimpse of majestic Himalaya which was shining like a tip of a diamond from otherwise dark surroundings.

On the way, there were small shops offering tea, coffee, snacks – basically enough places to take a pause and recharge for the next round. The Mandakini River flows alongside for much of the route, its sound a constant companion. There was another sound constantly over our heads – the ferrying helicopters – from various starting points to Kedarnath.





We stopped at few places for a break with maggi and chai, watching clouds roll over the valley. After more than 9 hours of climbing, the first glimpse of the Kedarnath Temple, standing tall against the backdrop of Mount Kedarnath – part of Gangotri range of western Himalayas, filed us with enormous energy. The temple complex, surrounded by mountains makes every step of the trek worthwhile. This is was the first day of temple opening since October 2024.

We went to our guest house for some rest. In the evening, we came to the temple complex and was spellbound the sight of the temple amidst the mountain background. Probably that was an ideal view for pro-painters. We witnessed the huge queue of people waiting for the darshan. Something that we already anticipated for the next day.

#### Day 3: Jai baba Bholenath

We came to the queue at 4:00 AM. Temperature – zero degree, first time ever in my life. Already there were quite a lot of people waiting before us.

As the time kept ticking, the beauty of sunrise on the mountains unfolded before our eyes. That was something magnificent. The temple, decorated with flowers – was shining in the bright sun light.

As the day progressed, some people were getting innovative to bypass the queue. But all their efforts were crushed by the fellow good samaritans. By the time we could enter main temple, it was almost 10:00 AM. With the blessing of the almighty, we could perform the puja and offer our prayer in very satisfying manner. Even though the temple inside was bustling with scores of people.





After that we went to visit the "Bheem Shila", the massive boulder which miraculously halted the fury of the 2013 flood water to make any impact to the temple. We also visited the "Sheer Bhairavnath Mandir". Shree Bhairavnath is believed to be the protector of the Kedarnath valley.

## The return journey back

At around 12:30PM we started our journey back. By that time the sky was filled with rain clouds, and it was a consistent rain pouring down. So, we had to put our rain gear and started the trek back cautiously. The descent was quicker but equally scenic. Navigating through the incoming crowd and persistent rain and wind – that was some challenging experience. Endurance and knee reflexes were at full testing mode. But, with the blessing of Lord Shiva, we completed the journey back in almost 5 hours and returned to Gaurikund and then Sonprayag on the same day.


#### Some travel trips

- Start Early: Begin your trek from Gaurikund as early as you can to avoid afternoon weather changes and ensure you reach Kedarnath before dark.
- Fitness Matters: The 22 km trek is steep and demanding. Prepare with cardio and leg workouts at least 4 weeks prior.
- Weather Watch: Carry rain gear and check the weather forecast. Sudden are very common.
- Stay Options: Book your stay in Kedarnath in advance. Accommodation is basic but sufficient.
- Altitude Awareness: Drink water regularly and rest if you feel dizzy.
- Mobile Network: Limited connectivity. BSNL and Jio work best near the temple. 5G
  has better connectivity.
- Cash is King: ATMs are rare. Carry enough cash for food, lodging, and emergencies.
- Respect the Environment: Carry your trash back. Kedarnath is sacred and ecologically sensitive.

### **Essentials to carry**

- Valid ID proof (mandatory for registration)
- Trekking shoes with good grip, Trekking poles or a stick.
- Backpack (30–40L)
- Raincoat or poncho
- Warm jacket (temperatures drop below 5°C), Woolen cap, gloves, and socks
- Sunglasses and sunscreen
- Water bottle (preferably insulated)
- Power bank
- Basic medicines (paracetamol, ORS)
- Snacks (dry fruits, energy bars, glucose). Avoid eating heavy food during the trek.


