Set in a leafy residential area close to Inverness city centre, Cameron House provides a supportive, caring and loving environment.


At Cameron House, we promote dignity, respect and independence. Our staff team will work closely with you, to help you live your life to the fullest.



Our skilled and caring staff are on hand 24 hours a day to provide the care and support you need.

Every day residents enjoy nutritious and delicious food prepared by our catering team, who will work with you to tailor menus to your preference.

The Friends of Cameron House are an active group who support us with fundraising and musical evenings such as Burns night and St. Andrew's Day.

Cameron House is built around a charming courtyard garden, which provides a safe and peaceful place for residents to stroll, relax and socialise. Further garden space is enclosed with raised flower beds, a swing and access to the conservatory.



There are several light and spacious lounges and seating areas where you can relax, listen to music and socialise with other residents. We use the lounge spaces for most of our group activities and entertainment.



Within our specialist staff team we have dedicated Dementia Ambassadors, who also have enhanced skills and knowledge in dementia care. Their role is to promote best practice, assist colleagues and provide a point of contact for families and carers.

We also host a monthly dementia clinic at Cameron House. These are facilitated by our specialist dementia development team who are on hand to offer advice to staff, answer questions and provide support for families.

All care staff are registered with the Scottish Social Services Council and undertake regular training with a specific focus on dementia.






All 30 bedrooms have en-suite facilities. When you come to live at Cameron House, we invite you to personalise your room to help it feel as much like home as possible.
