
Ateneo de Manila is truly Filipino, devotedly Catholic, and uniquely Jesuit.

And it is a Filipino institution, proud of its rich heritage and significant role in nation-building, its daughters and sons contributing to its social, cultural, economic, and political life.







4. LEADERSHIP: Engaging and Transforming the World



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FORMATION AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

The Integrated Ateneo Formation (InAF) program aims towards the formation of persons-for-and-with-others who will contribute meaningfully to the transformation of Philippine society as servant-leaders in various fields.

In line with the Jesuit aim to form the whole person, and within the curricular framework of Ateneo College, InAF seeks to provide All undergraduate students with opportunities that help develop and integrate their personal, academic, physical, socio-cultural, and spiritual dimensions.

INTRODUCTION TO ATENEO CULTURE AND TRADITIONS (INTACT): FIRST YEAR

The Introduction to Ateneo Culture and Traditions (InTACT) Program is a year-long formation program that supports first-year students as they transition into college life. This also includes the Binhi Program, a wholeday immersion in marginalized communities or institutional advocacy sites, encouraging encounters beyond their usual social circles.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Students are required to take four Physical Education (PE) classes to help students understand and appreciate in depth the importance of physical activity in sustaining or improving their level of fitness which further contributes to the overall development of their health and wellness.

SOPHOMORE FORMATION PROGRAM: SECOND YEAR

In partnership with the Theology of the Catholic Social Vision course (THEO 12), sophomores undergo an area engagement experience through the National Service Training Program 11 (NSTP 11) or Punla Program. The area engagement experience will allow them to have direct personal contact with individuals and communities living on the margins of Philippine society.

JUNIOR FORMATION PROGRAM: THIRD YEAR

In partnership with the Social Sciences core course in the third year and particular major subjects in various academic disciplines, students undertake service-learning initiatives as part of the National Service Training Program 12 (NSTP 12). Students participate in an organized service activity to gain further understanding of course content, a broader appreciation of the discipline, and an enhanced sense of civic responsibility.

SENIOR INTEGRATION PROGRAM (SIP): FOURTH YEAR






Have a critical understanding of complex and interrelated societal issues through immersion with faithformation and sectorbased organizations.

The program is seen as a way to increase the number of trained men and women in theater practices, and to provide a venue for the development of theater artists who intend to apply their knowledge of the theater craft for further studies and/or for work in professional theater, film, radio, or television, or in other fields where its processes and skills are valued. AB Humanities is designed for students who are interested in combining tracks in the Fine Arts (Art Management, Creative Writing, Information Design, Theater Arts); Foreign Language and Culture (Chinese, French, German, Spanish, Japanese or Korean Studies); History; Philosophy; Literature (in English or in Filipino); Music Literature; and Education.

The program's interdisciplinary approach to teaching gives students a better understanding of Chinese culture, its people, and language. Depending on their personal interests and career choices, students are afforded opportunities to deepen their understanding of China's history, foreign relations, economy, policies, and the nuances of its business culture. The pursuit of a double major, combining AB Chinese Studies with other courses such as Management, Fine Arts, and History, among others, is also a very viable and practical study choice for a globally competitive graduate.

The AB Communication program forms communicators ready to lead in today's dynamic media environment. Courses are taught by seasoned professionals and scholars with industry experience and academic depth. Students engage in hands-on work through class projects, media productions, and community-based initiatives. This degree is ideal for students who wish to use the power of communication to inform, influence, and inspire positive change. The program culminates in a summer internship and a two-semester thesis, which may take the form of a research study, communication campaign, or creative media project. These are supported by the Eugenio Lopez Jr Center for Multimedia Communication, a facility with digital broadcast studios and editing suites that serve as a production and learning lab.

AB Development Studies is designed for students who want to make a positive difference in society by addressing social problems like poverty, public health, climate change, disaster, and exclusion. Students are exposed to different perspectives and practical interventions to understand and confront the complex challenges of social transformation.

The program is multidisciplinary, harnessing insights from economics, political science, and sociology. Students also acquire skills in social research and management to design, manage, and evaluate development interventions.





The dual orientation is the strength of the program as recent events have shown that business survival depends on both sound internal management and a solid understanding of economic forces. In their senior year, students will undergo practicum in an accredited host training establishment.

In addition to this, students pursue a strategic business project in which they are expected to apply not just management skills but also integrate concepts in economics. AB Political Science provides its students with a solid background in international relations, comparative politics, political theory, public management, and public law. The program is designed to train students in critical and analytical thinking and leadership required for studies in law and careers in government and development.

AB Political Science is enhanced by internship opportunities, the Junior Term Abroad program, and service learning programs. BS Applied Mathematics - Master in Data Science is Ateneo's response to the complex challenges of the 21st century, where the need to harness the abundance and power of data has become increasingly crucial. Students are equipped with strong mathematical, computational, and critical thinking skills to use data to conduct scientific analyses, draw meaningful conclusions, and make informed decisions that create a positive impact.

Students obtain their BS Applied Mathematics (with Specialization in Data Science) degree after four years, and subject to academic requirements of the program, may proceed to the Master in Data Science program in the fifth year.

BS Applied Physics - BS Materials Science and Engineering Program is a 4.5-year doubledegree program that prepares students for new technologies. It provides a strong foundation on the physics of materials with courses on the fundamental laws involving the structure of matter, and radiation, with specialized electives on materials.

BS Biology is a 4-year honors program that provides excellent training in the biological disciplines and preparation for research graduate programs and medical education here and abroad. Students choose from among four areas of specialization, namely: Biomedical Science, Cell and Molecular Biology, Ecology and Systematics, and Microbiology.

Students are given rigorous training through innovative lecture and laboratory courses that are in line with the Department of Biology's research thrusts, and through the undergraduate Thesis and Practicum.



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

The 4.5-year BS Electronics Engineering program aims to train engineers who have a competent grasp of both the science and technology of modern electronics and telecommunications. 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
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

BS Health Sciences is a 4-year honors program that seamlessly prepares students for further training in the Ateneo School of Medicine and Public Health and in other institutions offering medical and public health education.

To provide holistic orientation to health, the 163-unit curriculum is an integration of the Ignatian thrust in education and the fundamental, scientific, and technical background necessary for entry in the health sciences as well as of the disciplines that intrinsically influence the health sector.

BS Life Sciences is a 4-year honors program that provides an exciting, dynamic, and highly interdisciplinary application-based approach to the life sciences. Students are trained rigorously in fundamental biology courses and take essential courses under any of the two tracks.



BS/M Applied Mathematics with Specialization in Mathematical Finance aims to equip graduates with a rigorous foundation in the mathematics of financial markets combined with keen knowledge of business practices and data-driven techniques, giving them a competitive edge working in financial institutions and in other industries.

Students will graduate with a Bachelor of Science degree after four years. Those who meet the academic requirements may proceed to the master's program in the fifth year.



BS Mathematics is a four-year honors program designed to provide students with a strong foundation in pure mathematics along with an extensive exposure to applications and allied fields such as actuarial science, operations research, statistics, and mathematical modeling.





ADMISSIONS OVERVIEW

Admission to Ateneo de Manila University is open to qualified young individuals, regardless of nationality, creed, gender, residence, or financial capability.

Admission to Ateneo's college programs is determined by the applicant's fitness and preparation for undergraduate study; ability to contribute toward the enrichment of Ateneo's academic community; and potential to be of service to others.

The members of each first-year batch are selected by the Committee on Admission and Aid, which bases decisions on the Ateneo College Entrance Test (ACET), past academic performance, recommendations of teachers, and information written down on the application form.

For the incoming batch of first-year and transfer students for the 1st Semester of School Year 2026-2027, all applications will be submitted online.

Your Path to Admission

STEP 1 Preparation

WHO CAN APPLY?

Depending on your school and graduation status, you will belong to a particular applicant type. This applicant type will determine your particular application pathway.

- You are considered a first year college applicant
 - You are still in the last year of secondary education or;
 - You have graduated from secondary education and have not enrolled in a college / university or taken any college / university units / courses before and / or during the application and confirmation period
- You are considered a **transfer applicant** if you have enrolled in a college/university and / or have already taken units / courses in college / university.

Your pathway will also depend on where you are studying.

- You are considered a **local applicant** if you are studying in, or graduated from, a school within the Philippines
- You are considered a foreign applicant if you are studying in, or graduated from, a school abroad

WHO CAN APPLY?

The Committee on Admission and Aid is responsible for selecting new students. It bases its decisions on the applicant's past academic performance, the recommendations of teachers, their personal essay, and the information written down on the application form.

STEP 2

Application and Testing

Take your time in filling out the application, including your Scholarship/Financial Aid Questionnaire. Carefully select your degree program choices. We encourage you to submit way ahead of the deadline, to avoid stress.

ATENEO COLLEGE ENTRANCE TEST (ACET)

The Ateneo College Entrance Test (ACET) is a test requirement for admission.

The schedule varies depending on the application period calendar. Examinees can take the exam at Ateneo de Manila's main campus in Loyola Heights, Quezon City, or at testing centers outside Metro Manila.

STEP 3

Processing and Review

Admission to Ateneo de Manila University's college degree programs is determined by the applicant's fitness and preparation for college, ability to contribute toward the enrichment of the undergraduate school community, and potential to be of service to others within the context of national development.

The Committee on Admission and Aid is responsible for selecting the new members of the student body. It bases its decisions principally on the applicant's past academic performance, ACET test scores, the recommendations of teachers, essay, and on information written down on the application form.

STEP 4 Admission

Results will be released directly to your registered email. You will get one of three decisions: accepted, waitlisted, or not accepted. Once you are offered a place in the incoming first year batch, you will be asked to confirm your slot. You will become an official student once you enroll for the first semester.

TUITION & FEES

Tuition and fees are charged on a semestral basis. For the School Year 2026-2027, you may find the estimate tuition and fees charged per semester, in Philippine Pesos, below:

Tuition 117,000Basic Fees 18,437Other Fees 8,074

Additional fees are charged for laboratory use, or for overload fees, depending on the student's program of study.

Tuition and Fees may be paid through online payment facilities of major banks or over-the-counter transactions. Students may pay in two or four installments. Payment methods and schedules are made available during enrollment.

Kindly note that the fees indicated above may vary depending on the degree program that the applicant plans to pursue. The fees for the degree programs under the School of Science and Engineering are slightly higher compared to other degree programs because of their laboratory fees.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

An Ateneo education is an investment in your future at an understandably hefty cost. Finances could be a major barrier for many young and talented individuals who would want to pursue this kind of life-changing education and formation. However, we believe that everyone has the right to receive quality education and Ateneo is here to help.

There are several categories of scholarships available: merit, academic, athletic, financial aid, and government and private.

MERIT AND DIRECTOR'S LIST **SCHOLARSHIPS ATENEO FRESHMAN MERIT SCHOLARSHIP (AFMS)** The very best applicants to Ateneo de Manila University are awarded the Ateneo Freshman Merit Scholarship. This is based on their performance in the Ateneo College Entrance Test (ACET), and their individual rank and leadership roles in their respective senior high schools. The recipients of the Ateneo Freshman Merit Scholarship (AFMS) are identified as the top 50 applicants from local private, science, or public high schools, and from senior high schools abroad. The Ateneo Freshman Merit Scholars can choose any degree program of their choice. They are awarded a 100% tuition and fees scholarship and a Php 50,000 annual allowance. The University recognizes great promise in these students and a vast potential to contribute and enrich the University community and the Philippines. And through them, Ateneo hopes to continue its tradition of excellence in academics and service to God and nation. **DIRECTOR'S LIST SCHOLARSHIP** Of the thousands who apply to the University every year, a select few clearly stand out. These are students who have done very well in the Ateneo College Entrance Test (ACET) and have distinguished themselves academically as well as in co-curricular activities in their respective senior high schools. The Director's List Scholarship is awarded to the 150 outstanding applicants of Ateneo who will enjoy an annual Php 100,000 scholarship grant for any undergraduate degree of their choice.

FR THOMAS B STEINBUGLER SJ ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is awarded to the Valedictorians and Salutatorians of Jesuit senior high schools who are accepted to Ateneo, with excellent ACET results, in any degree program. Upon presentation of a certification from the high school principal, a Valedictorian receives a 100% Tuition and Fees Scholarship, while a Salutatorian receives a 50% Tuition and Fees Scholarship.

JOSE P RIZAL ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

This grant is awarded to Valedictorians and Salutatorians of Public senior high schools who are accepted to Ateneo with excellent ACET results. FINANCIAL AID GRANTS

For six decades now, the Ateneo College Scholarship Program continues to thrive for deserving but financially challenged students. Financial Aid scholarships are awarded to students in all degree programs of the University. This may be a combination of:

- ▶ 100%/75%/50%/25% in tuition and fees
- ▶ Book allowance
- ▶ Transportation allowance
- ▶ Food allowance
- Dormitory assistance

With limited slots each year, financial aid grantees are selected on the basis of the following general criteria:

Applicants, therefore, should not wait for the decision on their application for admission before submitting their Financial Aid Application. 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MAGIS SCHOLARSHIP

Deserving Financial Aid applicants who are within the most financially-constrained circumstances may be selected for the Magis Scholarship. This all-expenses-paid scholarship is part of the University's commitment to make Ateneo de Manila University's world-class, holistic college education and formation accessible to more students without the economic means to do so. The benefits of this scholarship include:

- ▶ 100% tuition and fees for any 4 or 5-year course
- ▶ Food and living allowance
- ▶ Books, supplies, and printing allowance
- On-campus dormitory scholarship or transportation allowance
- Miscellaneous allowance for other needs
- ▶ Round-trip airfare every semester, as applicable
- ▶ Cellphone and laptop provision

The scholarship is open to all incoming college students who have demonstrated excellence in academic and non-academic endeavors, and have the potential to become the servant-leaders our future truly needs.

Only those who will be awarded a Financial Aid Scholarship will be considered as potential Magis Scholars, one each from the National Capital Region, Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.



ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Athletic Scholarships are awarded to student-athletes who have excelled in sports and academics. Applicants who wish to enter Ateneo de Manila University with an Athletic Scholarship must coordinate with the University Athletics Office (UAO).

Aside from being financially challenged, applicants must have outstanding athletic ability, and must be a recipient of awards in their specific sport.

LIVING IN METRO MANILA

FOR STUDENTS FROM OUTSIDE METRO MANILA

Most Ateneo students who come from outside Metro Manila stay in the vicinity of the Loyola Heights campus, either in on-campus residences, off-campus housing, condominiums, or rental houses, either on their own, with friends. Many also live with family or relatives, which significantly lowers the cost of living.

The cost of living will depend on your housing situation and your lifestyle. Your budget should take into account housing and utilities (electricity, water, and communications); food; clothing; transportation; daily educational expenses such as purchase school supplies and printing; and other expenses, such as entertainment and leisure.
