Capella Choir, and continuing her passion for music by studying music technology and music business at university. She wants to thank her family, friends, and the choir program for their support!!!

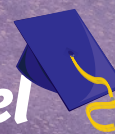
Jenny Cotton

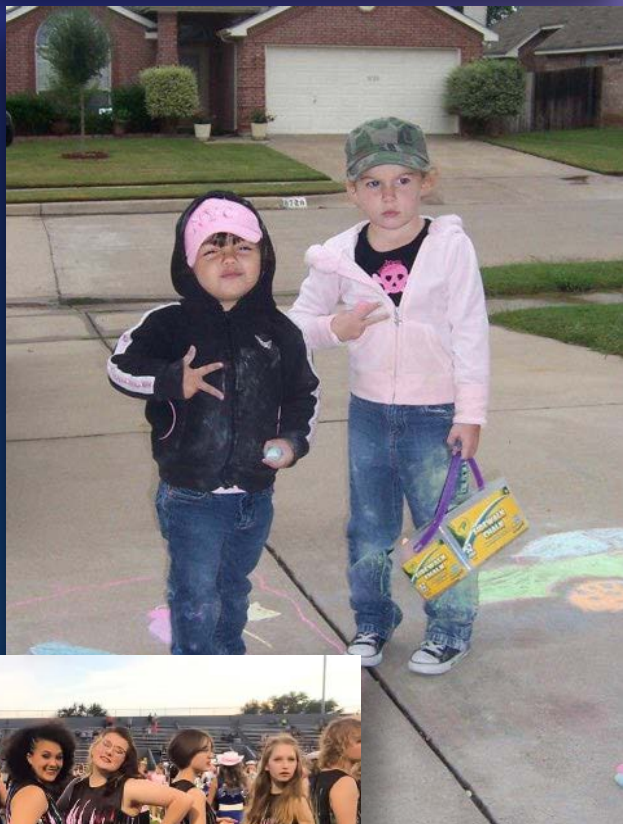
Ashley Kimbrough, Choreographer.

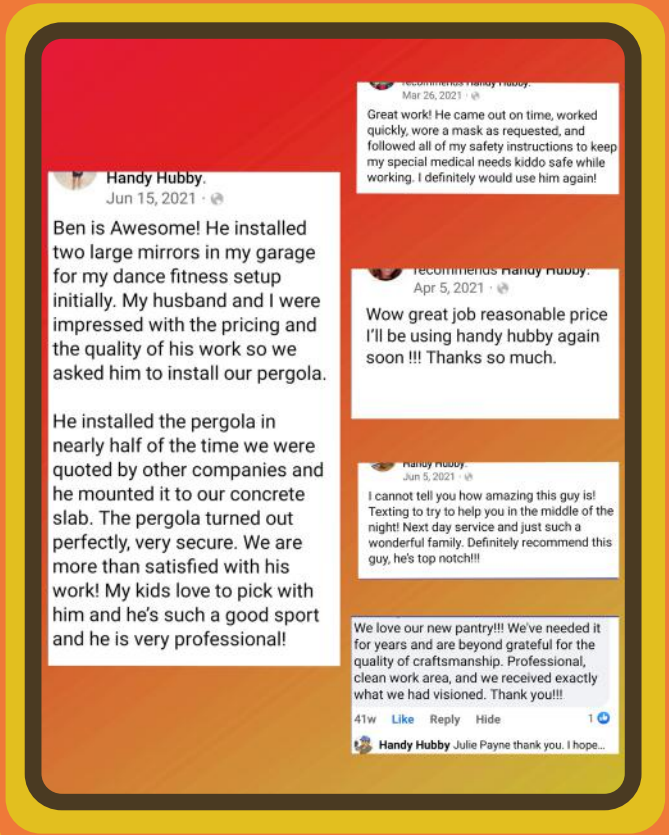
