This 11-day epic safari provides unparalleled access to the reserves and national parks of The Big Five, home to the endangered black rhino, leopard, elephant, buffalo, lion, and a plethora of other wildlife.

In Nairobi, you'll explore the Samburu National Reserve, famous for its diverse and abundant wildlife. Next, experience Lake Nakuru National Park, described as the greatest ornithological spectacle in the world. Travel along the Great Rift Valley's western rim into the Maasai Mara National Reserve, where approximately 95 species of mammals, amphibians, and reptiles have been recorded along with over 400 species of birds.

Trek aboard 4x4 safari vehicles through the savanna plains during legendary game drives with expert guides. Enjoy visits to conservation organizations that play pivotal roles in rescuing and rehabilitating at-risk wildlife, protecting endangered species, and preserving the ecosystems and biodiversity of the region. During community visits, engage with locals for a deeper understanding of their rich cultures and vibrant traditions.

In partnership with local guides and experts, our tour will be led by Dan L. Perlman, professor of biology at Brandeis, who will enrich and inform the journey with his deep knowledge of animal behavior, conservation biology, environmental studies, and ecology.

After exhilarating days of exploration, relax and unwind at luxurious lodges and tented camps in the evenings, each offering exceptional hospitality and superior amenities.

Faculty Leader: Dan L. Perlman is professor of biology at Brandeis, where he has taught a wide range of courses, including ecology, conservation biology, animal behavior, and introductory Environmental Studies. During his tenure, he has served as associate provost of innovation in education and director of the Center for Teaching and Learning. Professor Perlman has co-authored three textbooks on conservation biology and ecology: "Conserving Earth's Biodiversity: With E.O. Wilson," "Practical Ecology for Planners, Developers, and Citizens," and "Biodiversity: Exploring Values and Priorities in Conservation." He developed the website EcoLibrary.org, where he freely distributes his teaching materials for ecology and environmental studies.





Kenya Safari: The Big 5 | Itinerary and Highlights (subject to change)

Locations selected for this safari promise excellent viewing of wildlife, however, spotting specific wildlife cannot be guaranteed. Some activities are dependent on weather and seasonal conditions.

Day 1: EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

Day 2: ARRIVE IN NAIROBI, KENYA After an evening arrival to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with group transfers to the hotel. Settle into your five-star accommodations.

Overnight: Fairmont The Norfolk

Day 3: NAIROBI Following breakfast and a welcome briefing by your Orbridge Expedition Leader, depart for Sheldrick Wildlife Trust—considered the most successful orphaned elephant and rhino rescue and rehabilitation program in the world. Next visit the home of the Rothschild Giraffe at the African Fund for Endangered Wildlife Giraffe Centre, whose mission is to educate Kenyan youth about their country's wildlife and environment. Afterward take a short drive to the foot of the Ngong Hills to see Karen Blixen's farm house.

Overnight: Fairmont The Norfolk (B,L,D)

Day 4: NAIROBI I SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE
Considered among the best wildlife
reserves in Africa, Samburu is famous for its
diverse and abundant wildlife. Set out on an
immersive game drive with expert guides.
Overnight: Soroi Samburu Lodge (B,L,D)

Day 5: SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE Prepare for an enriching full day exploring more areas within the reserve during morning and afternoon game drives.

Overnight: Soroi Samburu Lodge (B,L,D)

Day 6: SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE I

Depart for Lake Nakuru National Park—a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Head out on a guided game drive and learn about the park's preservation initiatives.

Overnight: Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge (B.L.D)

Day 7: LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK I
MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

Travel along the Rift Valley's western rim into the Maasai Mara National Reserve. Later get a front-row seat to the drama of the African wilderness during an exciting game drive.

Overnight: Mara Engai Lodge (B,L,D)

Days 8-9: MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE
Immerse yourself in the vast plains
of the reserve during two full days of
wildlife viewing. On the final evening
gather together for a festive bush
dinner.

Overnight: Mara Engai Lodge (B,L,D daily)

Day 10: MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE I FLIGHT TO NAIROBI I DEPART FOR U.S. After breakfast return to Nairobi where you'll have access to a day room at the hotel until transfering to the

airport for evening flights home.

Day Room: Crowne Plaza Nairobi

Maasai Mara Sunrise Safari

While in Maasai Mara National Reserve (days 8-9), take a once-in-a-lifetime sunrise safari by hot air balloon. During this optional excursion, ascend above the reserve at dawn for an exclusive birds-eye view of wildlife roaming the expansive landscape.

This excursion must be purchased from Orbridge Guest Services in advance to guarantee availability. Purchase is non-refundable inside 90 days from departure.



What's Included

- 8 nights accommodations at deluxe lodges and tented camps—all carefully selected to emphasize wildlife viewing and amenities—plus a day room on departure day
- 8 breakfasts, 8 lunches and 7 dinners including a special farewell dinner
- Expert naturalist guides throughout
- Daily game drives in open-air vehicles with filtered water provided
- Maasai Mara National Reserve visitation fees, which are paid directly to the Narok County Government in support of tourism and conservation efforts of the Maasai Mara ecosystem and wildlife
- Internal airfare from Maasai Mara to Nairobi
- All main program gratuities, as well as taxes, service charges and park fees
- Temporary membership in AMREF Flying Doctors air ambulance service
- Airport transfers for guests arriving and departing during the suggested times



Activity Level: This safari program requires an ability to walk safely over uneven and slippery ground without assistance, transport luggage a short distance, get in and out of a 4x4 vehicle, and physically tolerate vehicle motion on sometimes bumpy roads. Highest elevation: 5,500 feet.

The property offers an inviting outdoor infinity pool, plus a lounge, bar and dining room, each featuring extensive outdoor sheltered terraces—ideal for spotting an incredible variety of wildlife, including white and black rhinos and the rare Rothschild giraffes.







MARA ENGAI LODGE

Stunning views, spectacular wildlife, sumptuous food, and a cheerful staff combine for a fantastic stay at the Mara Engai Lodge. Relax in large, luxurious tented suites with waterfall showers and private verandas at this unique property nestled within the forest and overlooking the amazing Maasai Mara National Reserve.









Day 10: FLIGHT FROM MAASAI MARA TO AMBOSELI Arrive to Amboseli in time for lunch, then set off on an afternoon game drive. Return to the lodge

on an afternoon game drive. Return to the lodge where the remainder of the day is yours to explore the grounds and take advantage of the property's amenities.

Overnight: Ol Tukai Lodge (L,D)

Day 11: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK Today includes two game drives through Amboseli National Park to spot for African wildlife. At little more than 150 square miles, Amboseli is relatively small, but its high concentration of wildlife makes for excellent viewing opportunities. In addition to its many elephants, the park is also home to Cape buffaloes, impalas, cheetahs, spotted hyenas, Maasai giraffes, Grant's zebras, blue wildebeest, more than 100 lions and more than 400 bird species.

Overnight: Ol Tukai Lodge (B,L,D)

Day 12: AMBOSELI I TRANSFER TO NAIROBI I DEPART FOR U.S. After breakfast, return to Nairobi where you'll have access to a day room at the hotel to rest until transferring to the airport for evening flights home.

Day Room: Crowne Plaza Nairobi Airport (B,L)

Day 13: EN ROUTE | ARRIVE IN U.S.

Activity Level: This post-tour requires an ability to walk over uneven, sometimes slippery ground and get in and out of a 4 X 4 vehicle.

- Internal airfare from Maasai Mara to Amboseli
- 2 nights at Ol Tukai Lodge (or similar) plus a day room on departure day
- 2 breakfasts, 3 lunches and 2 dinners
- Admission to Amboseli National Park
