



For this article, however, I would like to reference an advertisement I found on a trip to the ARBA museum over the summer. Unfortunately, I don't have a scan of the advert but rather a picture. The advertisement was for a Jersey Wooly show in 1988! At the time, mail-in entries for the show were \$4.00 a rabbit and phone entries (as-in, phone-in entries if it wasn't clear) would instead be \$6.00 per rabbit. The show occurred during the ARBA convention in Madison, Wisconsin and was at a separate location. The club stated that they would provide maps and rides for those who need them, also including the fact it was a carry cage show. At the time of the article, Jersey Woolies weren't an official breed yet. In fact, it would be that convention in which woolies would be accepted! The advertisement credits the popularity of the breed to the small size, demeanor, and the easy-to-work with coat. The article even contains many of the sayings surrounding Jersey Woolies. For example, "Wild and Wooly" (featuring a Jersey Wooly with an adorable cowboy hat), or "Wuv the Wooly, the Fluff of the Fancy." While the article is from about 40 years ago, I think we can see how there is the same love and excitement of the breed! While it might just seem like some old advertisement, I think it's nice to see and have perspective to how much the breed has grown and the art of showing has changed from 1988 to 2026.



The Club

The National Jersey Wooly Rabbit Club was founded to support the Jersey Wooly breed, bring breeders and potential breeders together, share information on rabbit raising, and pursue a broader understanding of rabbit genetics to help improve the Wooly and all rabbit breeds.

The Club has been in existence for five years and has over 200 members. The Club's Newsletter is published approximately three times a year.

Back issues, which will give an idea of the Club's enthusiasm, participation and direction, are available at the Jersey Wooly Booth or from the address below.

The Jersey Wooly

The Jersey Wooly is a new breed which has been accepted twice by the ARBA Standards Committee. The first official showing of the Jersey Wooly at a national ARBA Convention was in 1984 in Orlando, Florida. The second official showing was at the Ohio Convention two years later. Woolies will be presented again this year in Wisconsin in anticipation of their third and final accepted showing.

There are presently about 300 breeders producing Woolies across the country. Many of the breeders have show-quality animals available for sale.

The Wooly's popularity can be credited to a number of things. It is a small rabbit whose average senior weight of three pounds enables breeders with limited space to keep a large enough number to work with. The wool coat adds beauty, and the type of wool requires very little grooming. Its round, appealing face and its quiet, gentle personality make it an especially winning breed.

Three Defining Characteristics of the Jersey Wooly



Three characteristics differentiate the Jersey Wooly from other breeds: A bold, blocky head; the distinctive rise; and wool texture.

Bold, blocky head

Many breeds call for a bold head; the same is true of the Jersey Wooly. In the Jersey Wooly, we want a head that is indeed bold; it should appear “blocky,” that is, wide and even in width from crown through eye and lower muzzle. It should not display any sign of a wedged or snipey muzzle. The Jersey Wooly head should be nearly square in profile, with its depth nearly equal to its width. We like to call this a “mug head.” Certainly, there is some curvature to the skull, but the blocky appearance will be exaggerated by a wool cap that consists of longer and denser wool from between the ears to above the eyes, as well as by the cheek furnishings, which should not stand out straight, but rather have enough length to blend into the chest and shoulder wool.

Rise

The rise in a Jersey Wooly is not the same as the rise in a New Zealand, nor any other breed. It starts behind the head, which should be mounted fairly high, but not on top of the shoulder. This allows for a slight dip at the neck, then it rises smoothly up and over the high point and down to the table in a smooth, full arc that is not undercut. The high point should be situated above the stifle (or knee) joint.

Texture

The wool coat in a Jersey Wooly is different from any other wool breed. We value texture above all else, as evidenced by the largest number of points given in this category. No other wool breed gives prominence to texture. Texture is displayed in a preponderance of guard hairs, which should be longer and thicker than the dense undercoat. That thickness in the guard hair will make it coarse; we call for a coarse coat, not a soft one, as compared to the other wool breeds. A guard hair that is shorter or thinner will create a softer, silkier coat, which is not what we are looking for. It is within this context that we want as much density as possible. A coat that carries too much density will be soft, cottony, and will stand erect. The Jersey Wooly coat should have enough density to stand up when fluffed, but enough texture to immediately drape down a bit, giving that flowing coat you'll often see. The Jersey Wooly should have an easy-care coat; it is the texture that gives this quality.

This article is a short synopsis of three defining characteristics of our breed. In future articles, each of these areas will be explored in more detail.





Rabbit Care in the cold

Care of Rabbits in the Cold

Rabbits are naturally equipped to handle cooler temperatures, but cold weather still requires thoughtful care to keep them healthy, comfortable, and safe. Whether rabbits are housed outdoors, in barns, or indoors with exposure to drafts, winter conditions introduce risks that owners should actively manage.

How Cold Is Too Cold?

Rabbits tolerate cold far better than heat. Healthy adult rabbits can usually handle temperatures down to about **32°F (0°C)** if they are dry, out of the wind, and well-fed. Problems arise when cold is combined with **dampness, drafts, or inadequate shelter**. Young kits, elderly rabbits, and those with illnesses need extra protection and should be kept in warmer environments.

Shelter and Housing

Proper housing is the single most important factor in winter rabbit care. For outdoor hutches or enclosures:

- **Wind protection:** Hutches or enclosures should be shielded from wind. Solid walls on at least three sides are ideal.
- **Dry conditions:** Moisture increases heat loss dramatically. Roofs should not leak, and floors should remain dry.
- **Insulation:** Straw (not hay) is excellent insulation for bedding. Thick layers allow rabbits to burrow and retain body heat.
- **Elevated flooring:** Raising hutches off the ground helps prevent cold from seeping up and reduces dampness.
- **Ventilation without drafts:** Fresh air is important, but direct drafts should be avoided.

For indoor rabbits, ensure enclosures are not placed near doors, windows, or unheated areas where cold drafts may occur.

Bedding and Nesting

Provide **deep, clean straw bedding**, refreshed regularly. Straw traps air and retains warmth better than shavings or hay. Rabbits will naturally create warm pockets within the bedding. For breeding does, additional nesting material is essential to protect kits from chilling.

Nutrition in Cold Weather

Rabbits burn more calories in cold temperatures to maintain body heat.

- **Increase hay intake:** Unlimited high-quality grass hay is critical. Digestion generates internal warmth.
- **Fresh water:** Water bottles and crocks can freeze quickly. Check multiple times daily and replace with warm (not hot) water as needed.
- **Balanced diet:** Maintain regular pellets, but may need to increase calories during extreme temperatures.

breeder's SPOTLIGHT

Barb Sherlock of Barbie's Bunnies

As many rabbit exhibitors have done, my interest in Jersey Woolies began at the 2015 Albion Area Fair. I saw a smoke pearl and a Siamese Sable buck for sale and fell in love. No stranger to the show ring, I raised and showed Collies in my younger years, American Quarter Horses in my midyears, Yorkshire Terriers in my older years, and Jersey Woolies in my oldest years. So, a few weeks later, I decided to go to an ARBA show in Painesville, Ohio. There, I was immediately greeted enthusiastically by Jersey exhibitors Julie Aversa, Gail More, April Sefcik, and Judy Collins. You know these girls and what great mentors they are to anyone who shows an interest in this breed. Learning that my Jerseys were not show quality, Gail, April, and Judy offered me a starter group to begin with, and Barbie's Bunnies was born.

That day, April had a little Siamese sable buck, Hopewell's Victor. He was small, but gorgeous, and I had to wait a year for him to mature before he did any winning. He produced my first winning Jerseys, including BB47 Barbie's Victoria, 24 legs, and she won my first BIS and RIS. He also sired a very significant producer for me, BB264 Barbie's Smokin Gun, whose offspring include BB316 Barbie's Shasta, 28 legs, BB364 Barbie's Salty Salina, 10 legs, BB323 Barbie's Pippa, 3 legs, who produced BB487 Barbie's Patrick, 3 legs, who went on to win in the youth arena and BB474 Barbie's Smokin Jo, 13 legs.

In 2016, I bought a Rew Doe, Lyle Creek's Qwin, from Joni Moore, whom I bred to April Sefcik's Buck bred by April Stigall, ZA Qhuinn. One surviving black doe was raised by syringing goat milk. Her name was BB7 Barbie's Ebony, and I bred her to Elise's Sunny, a show buck whom my wonderful husband Jim bought for me as a surprise from Gail More. She had one of my most significant litters of five kits. I kept four; three showed well, but all were great producers and became the basis of my self-program. BB83 Barbie's Sunlit, a REW doe, bred to Barbie's Smokin Gun, produced BB316 Barbie's Shasta, 28 legs, the 2022-2023 9th Open Rabbit of the Year. She produced five other winners, including BB80 Barbie's Eclipse, 4 legs, a black buck, has had six offspring so far, (yes, 8 years old and still going strong). One, BB556 Barbie's Paula 24 legs, is the 2024-2025th Open Rabbit of the Year. BB82 Barbie's Sunbeam, 11 legs, A Rew doe, produced nine winners, including BB267 Barbie's Playboy, 6 legs, and





BB466 Barbie's Sweet Dream, 5 legs, who were themselves producers.

When Lyle Creek's Qwin was bred to Hopewell's Kiss The Girls, another buck purchased from April, she produced BB Barbie's Snow White, 7 legs, who had five offspring. All went on to produce Jerseys that improved my herd. One, BB136 Barbie's Sonnet, 26 legs, was the 2019-20 4th Open Rabbit of the Year.

I am proud of my success, which includes being in the top 10 Open Sweepstakes since 2017 and in the top 5 since 2021. At the 2025 ARBA Convention, BB582 Barbie's Classy Chic, 28 legs, was 2nd in Open Senior Shaded Does, BB735 Barbie's Daphne was 7th, and BB536 Barbie's Paula was 8th in Open Senior Self Does.

Staying competitive takes a lot of hard work, as anyone with a woolly breed knows. Taking care of 100 plus Jerseys is a job in itself. And, in winter, it is even harder. Thank goodness for my husband, who helps me every day. Since I live in the winter lands of the snow belt in the northwest of Pennsylvania, I travel 2-4 hours to shows in PA, Ohio, and NY. Those hours on the road by myself are getting old. Thank you to Gail More, who takes me in hand on distant trips, along with fellow traveler Judy Collins. We meet up with April Sefcik and her husband Joe, who always finds us great places to eat.

YOUTH *breeder's* **SPOTLIGHT**

John Harris Anderson of JoBre's Rabbitry

Number of Holes: 68

Location: Spring, Texas



Why did you choose Jersey Woolies as the breed to raise? When I was in 6th grade, my older brother, Owen, decided to join his high school's FFA program, and he wanted to raise rabbits. He researched the breeds and narrowed down his choices, and when he was deciding between breeds, his top two were Jersey Woolies and Flemish Giants. I got very interested in the rabbits, well, and I liked the Jersey Woolies the best due to their temperament, and I thought they were really cute. My brother ended up getting one Flemish Giant and two Jersey Woolies to show, and my parents let me get one Jersey Wooly, a little Chestnut doe that I named Sprout. She was my first show rabbit, and she is still in my barn.

What are your biggest challenges in caring for Jersey Woolies? Probably the fact that I live in an urban area in a neighborhood where space is very limited. My father renovated our garage for the Woolies, and we work hard to keep that space clean and well-ventilated. The other challenge would be the weather in Texas. It gets very hot and humid in the Houston area, and we must run AC units in the garage almost year-round, and it gets pretty expensive.

What are your biggest challenges in showing Jersey Woolies? I am in my Junior year of high school and am active in FFA, marching band (I play percussion), and am taking advanced academics, so time is probably my biggest challenge. I enjoy showing, but having to balance band obligations, schoolwork, and just being a teenager with friends can be a challenge. I cannot show as many as a lot of youth exhibitors, so I definitely have to make choices about what shows I can attend and which ones I have to skip.

What are your goals in your rabbitry? I am really focused on breeding and showing homegrown Woolies and staying within the size of my rabbitry. Right now, I only want to purchase a rabbit if I really need to add something to my herd or to fix an issue that requires an outside line; otherwise, I am focusing on breeding and building a homegrown herd. I have to be very intentional about my breeding plans, since I am so limited on space. I got some really great advice from Kathy Hillery when my brother and I first started showing Woolies, and that was to focus on one or two groups and work to breed show quality in those groups before expanding to the other color groups. Initially, I focused on Agouti and Tan. I then expanded to Self and Broken. Now I am focused on breeding and improving my AOV (Oranges) and Shaded.

What are you most proud of in your breeding accomplishments? This year at Convention (Indy 2025), I took almost all homegrown, and they placed really well. I was very happy with the comments I received from Judge Misti Polasik, and my homegrown Sr Broken Buck, JoBre's Armstrong, won the Broken Group. This was my first Best of Group win at Convention, as in my previous two Conventions, I had won Best Opposite Groups but not Best of Group. In addition, I won Best Display, which really surprised me since I did not have a Breed win.

Do you raise any other breeds? No. I am a one-rabbit breed guy. I only raise Jersey Woolies.

What is your favorite part of the hobby? I think currently my favorite part of the hobby is helping new youth with their rabbits. My high school FFA program has several new students raising rabbits, and I am kind of known as the rabbit kid in FFA, so I enjoy answering questions and helping them at FFA shows and jackpot shows.

Do you have any special projects in the barn? I am definitely working on oranges and trying to improve the density of their coats. I have also been trying to get some nice broken oranges, but have yet to get one (I tend to get broken torts rather than broken oranges)!

Favorite Rabbit Memory: I have two favorite memories, a specific one and a more general one. Specifically, a favorite memory is the very first time I had a “big win” of Reserve in Show with my homegrown Sr Self buck, JoBre's Billy Idol. That win was such a surprise; my dad wasn’t even in the showroom as he was packing the car. I remember I was so excited that I ran off to tell my dad and forgot to get a picture with the judge. And in general, a favorite memory is how much my family, especially my Grandma and Granddad, have loved the rabbits. Our first Christmas after we got the Woolies was so fun as my grandparents, aunt, and cousins all gathered and took turns holding and petting the Woolies. It was a lot of fun.




