COMMITTEES

HCC's committees are one of the best ways to get involved and make a meaningful impact. Committees bring together members who share an interest in specific areas of the A/E/C industry—providing a space to collaborate, exchange ideas, and help shape HCC's programs and initiatives. Serving on a committee allows members to build relationships, grow their visibility, and contribute their expertise to the broader A/E/C community.

As an HCC member, you can participate as a committee member or take on a leadership role as a chair or co-chair. No matter your level of involvement, committee work is an excellent opportunity to deepen your engagement, influence the direction of the organization, and strengthen your professional network. Aviation

Second Tuesday, 9 – 10 am

The Aviation Committee's purpose is to connect HCC construction entrepreneurs to DEN and other airports within the state to identify current and future business opportunities. Through connectivity and outreach, the Aviation Committee helps navigate, train and foster a program for disadvantaged and underutilized businesses and entrepreneurs to successfully deliver projects statewide.

Infrastructure

First Wednesday, 11 am – 12:30 pm

In conjunction with the Black Construction Group, this committee's purpose is to identify outgoing and future expansion project opportunities with public agencies, such as the City and County of Denver, Colorado Department of Transportation, Denver Water, RTD and others. Through connectivity and outreach, the committee navigates, instructs and fosters a program for disadvantage businesses to do business with these agencies.

Events & Programs

First Tuesday, 11 am – 1 pm

This committee helps with the recruitment and retention of members through special events, membership drive and other direct outreach efforts. It is also responsible for programming HCC's general membership dinners. The committee offers the benefit of direct contact with clients and potential clients through requests for speakers and program planning, as well as the opportunity to drive the industry knowledge that is presented for the A/E/C representatives that attend HCC events.

Hispanic Legacy

As needed

This committee's purpose is to ensure

that "Hispanic" remains at the forefront of HCC membership, with the intent to remember the foundation in which HCC was started by including and developing small, Hispanic-owned businesses in Colorado. HCC is a supporter of the Latino Leadership Institute's Fellowship Program and accepted participants can apply for a scholarship through HCC to help offset the cost of the program.

Small Business Roundtable

Third Thursday, 9 – 10:30 am

The purpose of this roundtable is to build a broader interconnected business network that embraces all businesses—with a focus on small businesses—and encourages collaboration with a diverse group of individuals. The committee does this by continually developing strong relationships within our community—both internally and externally to the construction industry—and in its members' personal networks to advance business for everyone.

Women in Leadership (WIL)

First Friday, 8:30 – 10 am

Women in Leadership's purpose is to advocate for women in construction and to provide leadership trainings, networking and awareness for members. The committee champions an inclusive environment to attract, develop, support and retain women in the architecture, engineering and construction industries.

Governance

Fourth Friday, 10 – 11 am (by invite only)

The mission of the Governance Committee is to provide leadership and support to HCC in terms of assisting in the areas of HR/staffing, including hiring, job descriptions, benefits, etc.

The committee also helps with the identification of future board members as well as identifying and making recommendations on other actions as needed.

Legislative Policy Committee for State & Local Affairs (by election only)

Fourth Thursday, 11:30 am – 1 pm

The Legislative Policy Committee's purpose is to advocate and educate on behalf of diverse and certified firms on the local and state level to ensure that any legislative and purgatory initiatives affecting construction-related companies can be addressed in factual legal and beneficial manner. The group monitors and executes the strategy and tracks the results and return on investment and continually communicates with the executive committee, board of directors and HCC membership to ensure communication to relevant audiences.
