Welcome To Our Time of Fasting 2025

This year's fast promises to be life-changing at best! Pastor Adolph has authored a new book entitled *Help Me Handle This!* This book is designed to work in conjunction with you each day of your fast. To gain the most from the 2025 Fast, consider getting a copy of the book for your daily devotional readings. Please know that you do not have to purchase the book to do the fast. However, the book enhances each day with readings, prayers, precepts, and practices from the Pastor's heart.

WHAT IS FASTING?

Fasting is a spiritual discipline that is taught in the Bible. Jesus expected His followers to fast, saying that God rewards fasting. According to the Bible, fasting means voluntarily reducing or eliminating your food intake for a specific time and purpose. It is intentionally denying pleasure to the flesh to gain a spiritual result. It is a sacrificial lifestyle that indicates one who lays aside food for a time so that the believer may know God for a more profound experience. Scripture teaches us that fasting is not a requirement but a choice.

"When you give up eating, don't put on a sad face like the hypocrites. They make their faces look sad to show people they are giving up eating. I tell you the truth: those hypocrites already have their full reward. So when you give up eating, comb your hair and wash your face. Then people will not know that you are giving up eating, but your Father, whom you cannot see, will see you. Your Father sees what is done in secret and will reward you." Matthew 6:16-18 (NCV)

WHY FAST?

There are many good reasons, and even health benefits, for fasting. However, as we enter into 14 days of corporate fasting and prayer, our heart desires to unselfishly pray in accordance with Matthew 6:10, "Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven". We will use

this scripture as the foundation for our 2023 thematic thrust of Maximum Impact as we seek God to lead us in fulfilling the vision and core values of the Antioch Church. As ambassadors of the Kingdom, we collectively agree and individually acknowledge the following as reasons to enter into 14 days of fasting and prayer:

- 1. Fasting gives us more time for prayer. The time typically spent eating can be used as time in prayer for what God wants to do among us. We will pray for our pastor, leaders, staff, and five ministry arms of the church (Exhortation, Evangelism, Equipping, Edification, and Encouragement).
- 2. Fasting demonstrates the depth of our desire when praying for something. God honors deep desire and praying in faith. Our commitment to fasting shows that we are serious enough about our prayer request to pay a personal price. We will pray concerning the three core values of our church: The Great Commission, The Great Commandment, and The Great Calling.
- 3. Fasting releases God's supernatural power. It is a tool we can use when there is opposition to God's will. Satan would like nothing better than to cause division, discouragement, defeat, depression, and doubt among us. In the year 2025, believers who have enough crazy faith will ask God to take their faith fellowship HIGHER THAN THE TOP!

THE IMPORTANCE OF FASTING

In the Bible, God's people often fasted immediately before a major victory, miracle, or answer to prayer. It prepared them for a blessing!

Moses fasted before he received the Ten Commandments.

"Moses was there with the Lord forty days and forty nights without eating bread or drinking water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant--the Ten Commandments." Exodus 34:28 (NIV)

• The Israelites fasted before a miraculous victory.

"Some men came and told Jehoshaphat, "A vast army is coming against you from Edom, from the other side of the Sea. It is already in Hazazon Tamar" (that is, En Gedi). Alarmed, Jehoshaphat resolved to inquire of the Lord, and he proclaimed a fast for all Judah." 2 Chronicles 20:2-3 (NIV)

• Daniel fasted in order to receive guidance from God.

"So I turned to the Lord God and pleaded with him in prayer and petition, in fasting, and in sackcloth and ashes." Daniel 9:3 (NIV) "While I was still in prayer, Gabriel, the man I had seen

in the earlier vision, came to me in swift flight about the time of the evening sacrifice. He instructed me and said to me, 'Daniel, I have now come to give you insight and understanding.'" Daniel 9:21-22 (NIV)

• Nehemiah fasted before beginning a significant building project.

"When I heard these things, I sat down and wept. For some days I mourned and fasted and prayed before the God of heaven." Nehemiah 1:4 (NIV)

Jesus fasted during His victory over temptation.

"For forty wilderness days and nights he was tested by the Devil. He ate nothing during those days, and when the time was up he was hungry." Luke 4:2 (Msg)

• The first Christians fasted during decision-making times.

"While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, 'Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.' So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off." Acts 13:2-3 (NIV)

TYPE OF FASTS

There are many types of fasts. The option you choose depends upon your health, the desired length of your fast, and your preference:

- 1. Absolute Fast (Full Fast) Abstinence from all solid foods. It is a LIQUIDS ONLY fast.
- 2. Selective Fast (Daniel Fast) Remove certain elements from your diet. An example is the Daniel Fast, where meats, sweets, bread, and juice are removed and replaced with water, vegetables, and nuts.
- 3. Partial Fast A limited fast that consists of abstaining from certain foods for a prolonged period or abstinence from all foods for a portion of the day.
- 4. Soul Fast (Entertainment Fast) Eliminating something other than food from your life for a period of time. For example, you may stop using Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, or other social media platforms, watch television, use unnecessary phones, or go to movies. This is an excellent option for children, students, or people with medical issues who cannot abstain from foods for prolonged periods of time.

FASTING GUIDELINES

- Explain to your family and friends IN ADVANCE what you are doing.
- Request privacy from those who want to find out what you are doing.
- · Never complain or brag about your fast, and avoid talking about it.
- Establish an accountability partner for prayer and encouragement.
- Stay away from negativity, including people, situations, or things.
- Reserve more time to pray, meditate on God's truths, and study His Word.

- Open your heart and spend as much time as possible alone in prayer and meditation
- Acknowledge that your flesh cannot be trained but must be crucified
- Journal as you pray and meet with the Lord and keep track of all miracles in your life

FASTING PREPARATION

- 1. Prepare your heart Be willing and open to hear what the Lord will speak to your heart during the fast and change it. Do everything you can to forsake sin during this time for a purging of all that is unrighteous. Surrender yourself to God and dedicate your ways, thoughts, talents, and resources to Him.
- 2. Prepare your motives God desires to give you good gifts. Perhaps He wishes to bestow wisdom, anointing, prayer power, healing power, teaching power, joy, or encouragement upon you. Allow your motives to be purified during your fast.
- 3. Prepare your body If you decide to eat only fruits and vegetables, you will experience a cleansing. You may even feel sick while your body detoxes itself of sugars and other matter, but YOU WILL MAKE IT. Some may ask, what does not eating have to do with my relationship with God? A Pastor once answered this question: "Stop eating and find out." Get ready!
- 4. Prepare your schedule Be intentional about your time with God. Decide where you will meet Him, what and when you will eat, and how you will spend time drawing nearer. Create a plan and commit to spending more time with the Lord.
- 5. Prepare your journal Chronicle all your prayers, expectations, conversations, oppositions, dreams, revelations, healings, answered prayers, guidance, and miracles that God will manifest during your consecration.

FOODS TO EAT WHOLE GRAINS: Brown Rice, Oats, Barley

LEGUMES: Dried Beans, Pinto Beans, Split Peas, Lentils, Black Eyed Peas

FRUITS: Apples, Apricots, Bananas, Blackberries, Blueberries, Boysenberries, Cantaloupe, Cherries, Cranberries, Figs, Grapefruit, Grapes, Guava, Honeydew Melon, Kiwi, Lemons, Limes, Mangoes, Nectarines, Papayas, Peaches, Pears, Pineapples, Plums, Prunes, Raisins, Raspberries, Strawberries, Tangelos, Tangerines, Watermelon

VEGETABLES: Artichokes, Asparagus, Beets, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Carrots, Cauliflower, Celery, Chili Peppers, Corn, Cucumbers, Eggplant, Garlic, Ginger Root, Kale, Leeks, Lettuce, Mushrooms, Mustard Greens, Okra, Onions, Parsley, Potatoes, Radishes, Rutabagas, Scallions, Spinach, Sprouts, Squashes, Sweet Potatoes, Tomatoes, Turnips, Watercress, Yams, Zucchini, Seeds, Nuts, Sprouts

LIQUIDS: Water (as much as possible), Unsweetened Soy Milk, Herbal (caffeine free) Tea, Natural Fruit Juice (no added sugar)

OILS: Extra-virgin olive Oil (small quantities), Honey

MEAT: Turkey, Chicken, Fish

FOODS TO AVOID: White Rice, Fried Foods, Caffeine, Coffee, Tea (including decaf), Carbonated Beverages, Foods Containing Preservatives or Additives

When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost. Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten. Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world. '(John 6:1-14 KJV)

God's Word For You Today: LITTLE BECOMES MUCH WHEN USED THE RIGHT WAY!

Give me the faith and obedience, to begin with, including you with my tithe, and look carefully at all of my other expenses that are primary first. 

What is your story?

I began the Free Indeed program, starting with the "Crystal Clear" episode on April 4, 2024, and set three, six and nine month financial goals with my husband. At the outset, we had \$96,000 in debt, including eight credit cards, a truck note, a personal loan, and our mortgage.

Using Miss Felicia's guidance, we focused on paying off the smallest credit card first. Although we missed our three month goal, we achieved it by month four, consolidating \$19,000 in credit card debt along with the truck note and personal loan. This reduced our interest rate from 26-29% to 6.9%.

Within eight months, we paid off \$11,000, reducing our debt to \$85,000. We're now working to pay off a four-year note in two years and plan to redirect those savings toward accelerating our mortgage payoff.

Why and how did you change your habits?

I transformed my spending habits by embracing accountability and taking control of my finances. Instead of wondering where my money went, I began intentionally directing every dollar with purpose. This shift helped me create a clear financial plan, align my spending with my goals, and prioritize my financial well-being. By budgeting and tracking expenses, I became more aware of my spending patterns, enabling me to make informed decisions and stay on track.

What advice would you give any other church members considering joining the program of free indeed?

I highly encourage church members to consider joining the Free Indeed program. From my experience, it has been truly transformative. The insights and tools provided have greatly benefited me, and as I progress through episode 30, I can confidently say that each step has brought me closer to my financial goals. Taking this leap could be a game changer for your financial well-being.

We both come from modest beginnings, so we felt it was important to ensure our children had everything they needed—and wanted. However, traveling across the country for travel sports, band performances, college expenses, and poor spending habits led to excessive debt. In hindsight, we struggled to say "no" when we should have.

How has the program helped you achieve your financial goals?


We're not quite there yet, but we've made significant progress! Free Indeed provides us with a clear focus and a target to aim for. By using the "Snowball" method, we found an effective system to accelerate our progress toward achieving our goal.

What advice would you give church members considering joining Free Indeed?

You should join as soon as possible! Don't let embarrassment or fear stop you from committing to this program. The truth is, most people could use some help with their finances—you're not alone. Why seek help elsewhere or pay for it when it's right here, offered by caring people, and completely free?

What valuable lesson have you learned since joining the program?

Staying financially aligned with your spouse is essential, and regular communication about all financial matters is a must. Most importantly, keep God at the center of your financial journey—you can't do it without Him!





What were some of the key accomplishments for you rministry this year?

As a grateful ministry leader, I am humbled by the incredible progress we've made in fulfilling all three of the church's core values. One of the most inspiring milestones has been the overwhelming growth in our team, expanding from just five dedicated volunteers to over 20 faithful individuals who serve with passion and commitment. Additionally, I am deeply thankful for the unwavering support of other ministries that join us every month, demonstrating a spirit of unity and willingness to serve. This collective effort has truly been a blessing and a testament to God's work through us.

Was there a particular project or event this year that stood out as a highlight? Why?

Father's Day was a memorable occasion as the men and several families enjoyed personalized haircuts from Ladi Barber. Pappy's food truck added a delicious touch to the celebration, and God blessed the sunny day with a special treat when an ice cream truck passing by provided free ice cream for everyone. On another occasion, we distributed bus passes, which were deeply appreciated. These passes provided those in need with the means to attend interviews, go to school, get to work, and handle everyday errands—opportunities many of us often take for granted.

What does receiving the Ministry of the Year recognition mean to you and your team?

For my team and me, it means that God can use even the least of us to achieve great things. I wasn't serving at all before, but now, together, we accomplish so much—from cooking and plating meals, distributing clothes, and using our personal vehicles for transport and setup, to those who pray for others. It's an honor to come together and love on people, living out Matthew 25:44-45: "Truly I tell you, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me."

How has your ministry positively impacted the church and the community? Can you share any specific stories or examples?

The ministry provides the church with a meaningful way to give back and serve those who are less fortunate, teaching us to serve with compassion. One memorable moment was when a family in need arrived looking for shoes. Without hesitation, the team purchased shoes on the spot from a local store to meet their needs. When we shared the need for shoes on ATV, the church family responded with overwhelming generosity, donating so many pairs that we didn't even have enough space to store them all.

What are some of the key accomplishments for your ministry this year?

As a youth pastor, I am incredibly proud of the accomplishments we've achieved in the youth ministry this year. We've increased the number of youth actively serving in ministry roles and successfully relaunched the Antioch Youth Council, empowering young leaders to guide their peers post-COVID. To enhance engagement, we introduced an 8 AM worship service and launched a Thursday night Bible study, "Live Out Loud (LOL) Crown", providing three weekly opportunities for age-appropriate Christian learning and fellowship.
