
## **Y5 BBC MICRO:BIT CODING**



Y6F have had a busy month, check out what we've been up to! We spent some time looking at short division. We used Numicon to set out sums, which allowed us to see the division sum in action practically. It was great to use some hands-on resources! This month's problem-solving focus was looking at digit card problems. We worked in pairs or groups to solve a variety of problems together. We had to arrange the cards in different ways, ensuring that each line added up to the same amount! Then, for our final challenge, we had to see how many solutions we could find for the 'Magic V' puzzle, where each leg of the v must add to the same amount. It was great to see the children working hard at these, and, as you can see, Hannah really enjoyed solving the puzzle! 🛠

Year 6 finished up our topic of 'The Human Body' this month by learning about muscles and tendons and how they work together to move our body. To investigate this, we each made a robotic hand. We acted as the muscle and pulled the 'tendons', causing the fingers to bend and the hand to close! We really enjoyed this task, and it got a thumbs-up from Ewan!
