Strategic Ministry

At the 2nd Annual Springfield Mayor's Breakfast, Urban Light Ministries' Board Treasurer Jay Weygandt remarked that when selecting a nonprofit to support, one should choose one that is strategic in its work. His statement reminded me why we do what we do and prompted me to remind you, dear reader. We set out years ago to improve the holistic well-being of children. That was and is our goal. Strategy is the overarching plan for achieving a goal, while tactics are the specific actions taken to execute that strategy.

After over a decade of children's evangelism work via the Sonshine Clubs, it became clear that the children we were ministering to continued to suffer because half were growing up in homes where their fathers did not live and/or were not coparenting well. Although many of them were receptive to the gospel of Christ and came to faith in Him, their lives did not improve because their home environment remained the same. Father absence was and is still a significant contributor to child poverty, academic failure, behavioral problems, emotional issues, juvenile crime, illegal drug use, premature sexual activity, and spiritual bankruptcy. Yet, no one in our region seriously attempted to target fathers.

Fathering Strong continues to grow as a means of connecting, engaging and empowering fathers to become better dads and improve the lives of their children. We now have over 325 subscribed members on the platform.

Within the past 6 months Eli Williams and Bruce Stapleton have participated in three national Fatherhood conferences presenting Fathering Strong. A pilot program supporting fathers with children in the Ohio HeadStart program will begin in January with possible partial grant funding from the Ohio Commission on Fatherhood.



Future releases within the platform include a church-based fatherhood curriculum, additional devotionals and moderator lead programs such as POPS101 and PointMan that are currently offered.

Our Strategy to Help Children

We wrestled with this for some time. Then, God moved us to add a fatherhood initiative to our work. In 2006, we adopted the vision of "Turning the Hearts of Fathers to their Children" (from Malachi 4:6) for Urban Light Ministries and started a fatherhood class. Our fatherhood focus has evolved from there. From the beginning, our strategy has been to achieve better outcomes for children by helping men be better dads and co-parents, whether they share the same home or not.

Turning Fathers' Hearts

The following is excerpted from an article by John Piper.

What does it mean for a father to turn his heart toward his child?
Well, what is the opposite of having a heart turned toward a child?
The opposite is to have the heart turned away. Three examples:
Fathers, you can have your heart turned away from your children simply by ignoring them.
By being so swallowed up in your work that all they get are the dregs of your life.
You can have your heart turned away from your children by being abusive.
It may be that without even hearing yourself, your communication with them is a litany of disapproval and put-downs. Why? Because your heart is not toward them.
You don't feel what they feel. Your heart is frozen in a posture of habitual unkindness.

Or you can have your heart turned away from your children through an embittered spirit of disappointment: that you are forgotten by them, or that they have let you down in the way they live, or that they have taken you for granted and never said thanks for all you did.

Where is the heart, then?

In the poisoned puddle of self-pity that threatens to grow into an ocean of resentment.

Often, fathers we encounter have committed to being the best dad they can be for their children but need instruction, encouragement, inspiration, or simply the camaraderie of other fathers.
