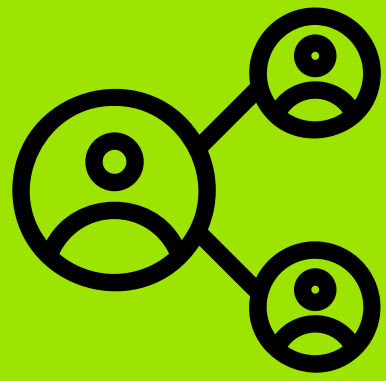
Who are we?

Our aim is to enhance each child's learning experience and overall happiness during their time at Boxgrove.

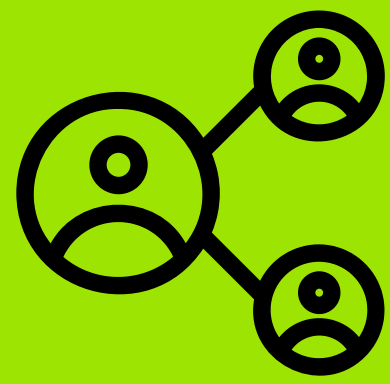

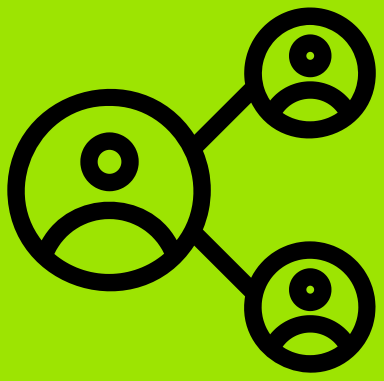

- Reading books, musical instruments, activities for our Young Carers, ICT equipment, art materials and resources, SEN books and writing support materials, and so much more...

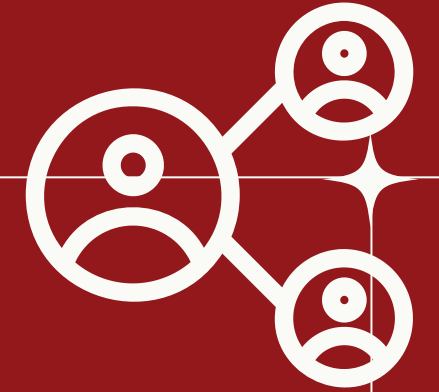
