OUR STORY

Cowley Pride is an annual event that strives to create a safe and visible environment for LGBTQ+ people and allies. We aim to inspire, educate, celebrate, and connect our diverse community.

The first Cowley County Pride event took place in 2019 and was organized by JJ Proctor and Roger Moon. The global pandemic in 2020 and the tragic passing of Roger Moon in 2022 halted a repeat event.

In 2023, a small group of community members volunteered to recapture the celebration and bring Pride back to Cowley County. Today, we collaborate with educators, local religious organizations, advocacy agencies, healthcare providers, non-profits, artists, and businesses who are committed to accepting all people. This event brings our community together through positive and inclusive activities that are welcoming to all ages.

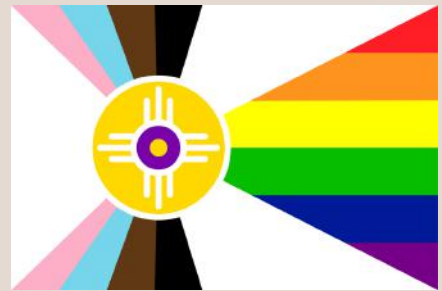

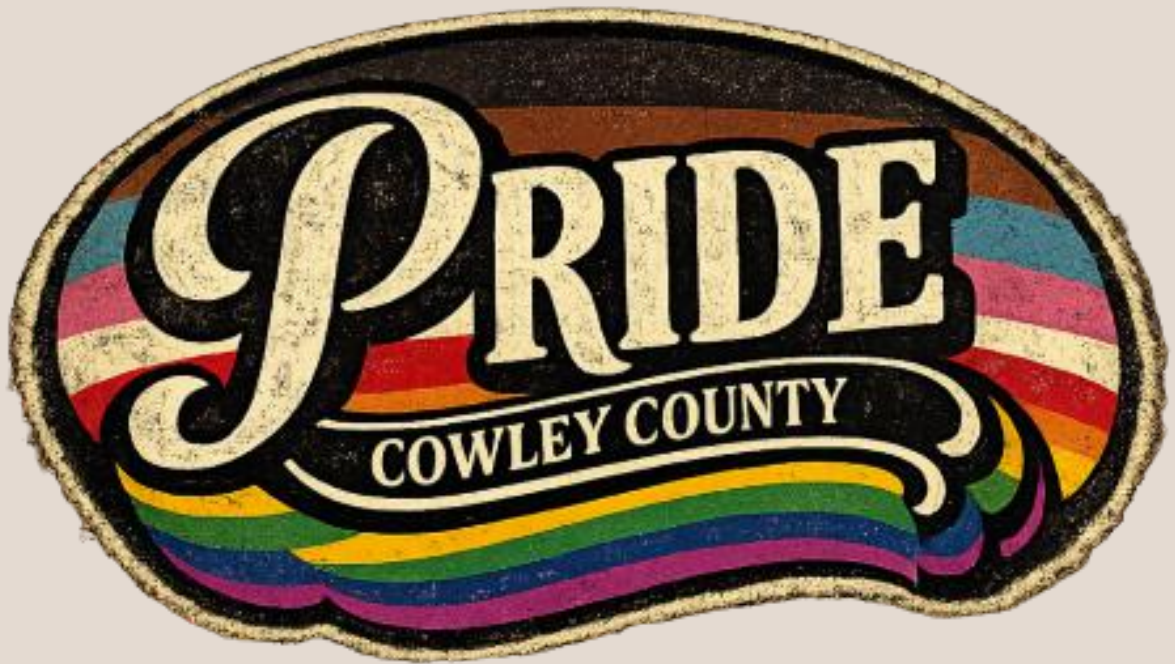
