DESIGNER PICK: Leaky Lamp I

Using the graphite-based biomaterial Pablo developed in 2024, this Leaky Lamp captures the unsettling image of an oil spill frozen in time. Pablo leans into the irony of this lighting critiquing unsustainable piece, practices while presenting sustainable material. "Through this piece, the Leaky Lamp challenges us to confront the urgent need for sustainable material alternatives. reflecting the harsh realities of environmental degradation."
