After School Programs

We offer after school programs where all children participate in activities and programs that are evidence-based to increase academic achievement, social skills, healthy lifestyles, and leadership skills.

- 24 years serving Douglas County kids
- We serve Kindergarten - 12th grade
- 2,496 kids participated in 2024
- 23% increase in participation in 2024
- 56% increase in just teen members in 2024
- 41,589 meals served in 2024
