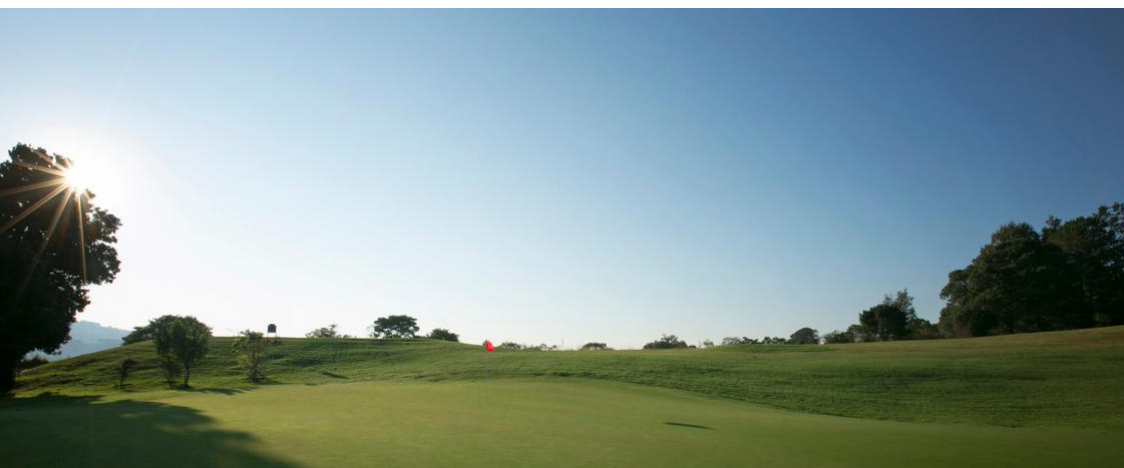

COURSE & GREENS

FAIRWAY Furrows

Are we under attack by Martians?

Fortunately not!

The course staff are hard at work making our fairways better as we continue with our Paspalum management programme.

This broad-leaved nuisance has clustered shoots arising from short rhizomes (4–8mm in diameter) and bears thick fibrous roots that can extend in excess of a metre. This means that treatment needs to be plant-specific — and patience is key — as multiple herbicide applications are required to penetrate the dense root system effectively.












So, if you notice a few dry or bare patches on the fairways, you now know what we are up to. It's all part of the long-term plan to improve turf quality and ensure our fairways remain in top condition.

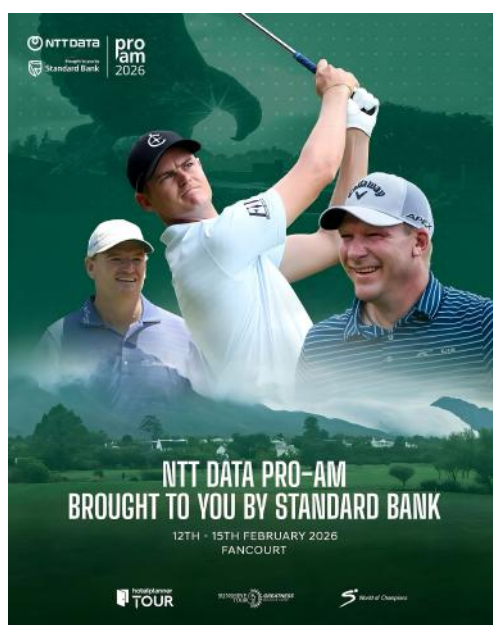
