Purina is investing \$550M to build a new 1.2 million-squarefoot manufacturing facility in Williamsburg Township, Clermont County Ohio. This new world-class plant will be Purina's first built from the ground up since 1975.

Welcome to Ohio!

Ohio Governor Mike DeWine... "Close collaboration between JobsOhio, its local partners and the Development Services Agency were essential to attracting Purina's newest facility and 300 jobs to Ohio. Talented workers in Clermont County will manufacture Purina's most recognizable brands from the plant, which will play a critical role in Purina's global growth strategy."

Purina, National Shoot to Retrieve's long-time sponsor recently announced construction of a new manufacturing facility, right in our own backyard! We asked Greg Blair, Purina Sr. Specialist Breeder Enthusiast to give us an update on this amazing facility.

The new Purina dry pet food facility in Clermont County has already taken shape – with much of the remaining construction project tasks focused on the building interiors.

Externally, the 1.5 million square foot property mostly resembles a finished product, but there's still work to be done. An extensive crew continues work on the site, which includes more than 1,000 skilled craftsmen and women who are contributing to the project.

Meanwhile, the local team is growing by the day. To-date, there are 42 local team members, and the team expects to conduct significant hiring waves in early 2024 as they inch closer to officially bringing the operation online.

The new dry pet food facility in Williamsburg Township is the first project Purina has constructed from the ground up since 1975, providing the opportunity to equip the facility with the best innovation and thinking to make the production and logistics process as streamlined and efficient as possible.

There may be no greater representation of that than the automated warehousing system being constructed on-site. The space can store more than 76,000 finished product unit loads at any given time.


There are also several digital and automation technologies incorporated into the production process to protect the safety of our people and our product.



The volume of materials used to-date is staggering:

- 23,000 yards (2,875 truck loads) of concrete
- Nearly 82,000 total feet of pipe (15 total miles)
- 351,000 tons of stone (equivalent to 14,000 semitruck loads)
- 3,700 geo piers installed
- 13,800 tons of structural steel (a little less than the structural steel in Cincinnati's tallest building, Great America Tower and the Paycor Stadium, home of the Bengals combined)

In 2023, we were heartbroken to say goodbye to a treasured friend and foundational member of the Ohio Region, Donnie Stir, 71 who passed away in August from prostrate cancer.



Donnie was born in Columbus, Ohio and attended Muskingum College where he played football all four years and earned a degree in Education. He retired after 30 years as a teacher with Teays Valley Schools in Pickaway County, Ohio. Along with teaching, Donnie was a lifelong farmer.

Donnie enjoyed his family, friends, hunting, and his beloved setters. He joined NSTRA in 1995 and started judging soon after. Donnie judged 100s of trials including at the National level. He also held various officer positions with the Ohio Region and Three Rivers Bird Dog Club. He was valued as a judge, fair but didn't hesitate to tell you what you did wrong.

Donnie's first NSTRA setter was Spuds Tekoa Joe, a 6X Champion. Donnie won the Ohio Region twice, back to back with two different dogs. One of his most successful setters and one he enjoyed, was Jake's Woody Mountain. Woody was Region champion and finished 2nd RU in the 2009 Trial of Champions.

Donnie loved to wild bird hunt and he frequently took trips out west. His final trip was to Kansas in December 2022 with his long-time friend Rod Howard.

Donnie set an example for all that knew him, he was humble, a fierce competitor, but a gracious loser. He exemplified what it meant to serve an organization and to help others. We will always remember his great sense of humor and his wonderful smile.

He leaves behind his beloved wife of 45 years, Nancy Stir; daughter, Allison (DJ) Walters and granddaughter, Olivia. Donnie was so proud of Olivia and never missed an opportunity to share a picture or story of her.

We will be honoring Donnie's memory with a fundraiser in September... Prostate Cancer Awareness Month, to remind men to receive an annual prostate cancer screening, which he did faithfully.

to Retrieve Vational Shoot

There are 66 dogs in National Shoot to Retrieve Hall of Fame. It is noteworthy that only a handful of owner/handlers achieve the distinction of having more than one dog inducted throughout their lifetime. The Ohio Region's Tom Rotundo has two... Ruck's Brockway Mad Dash (2022 HoF) and Last Dance Lily (2023 HoF). Both dogs had incredible careers, especially considering they were often competing against each other for placements.

Dash and Lily had their own impressive achievements but they also left an indelible mark by producing foundational offspring. These descendants have in turn, made significant contributions to the legacy of excellence in National Shoot to Retrieve. Some notable examples... 17X CH. Ragin Cajun Zeus, 8X CH. Ruck's Brockway Repeat, and 11X CH. Ruck's Brockway Twist. Oh, and Tom has a few other of their offspring making their mark on NSTRA... Sinsy and Berit.

Ruck's Brockway Mad Dash was whelped May of 2006; sire 6X CH. Brockway's Ruck Runner and dam 4X CH. Shooting Starr's Sassy Sammy, (owned by Todd Craven, Ohio Region.)

Dash launched his career with a placement in March of 2007, not yet one year old. He earned his first NSTRA Championship at 18 months and his third by just over age two. Dash went on to two Region Elimination wins and 4 placements.

His consistent excellence is reflected in the prestigious Purina Top Performance Award,

where he secured a spot in the Top 10 seven times, three of which he ranked in the top 4. In 2012, Dash was 5th Runner-up in the Dog of the Year, coming back to win the Dog of the Year trial in 2016. In that same year, Dash's partner, Lily, finished 3rd in Dog of the Year — a feat that, with a slight twist of fate, could have placed her in the final hour with Dash.

Dash's legacy is etched in NSTRA history as a 27X Champion, amassing an impressive total of 487 points, with 286 of those being 1st place points. Dash's records will be hard to replicate. Notably, he stands as the top overall points earner among NSTRA GSPs and the secondmost Championed NSTRA dog across all breeds.





Last Dance Lily was whelped in May, 2008, her sire Harrison's Sun Blue Tungsten, and dam Suiters Lady Bella. Lily's first open placement was in September of 2009 and by the time she was two years old, she was already a 2X NSTRA CH. Lily went on to a long and distinguished career.

Lily placed 3rd in the Purina Top Performance Award in 2010 and she placed 2nd or 3rd in four different Region Elimination trials. In 2014, Lily placed 2nd in the Trial of Champions and in the 2016 Dog of the Year Lily was 3rd (her partner Dash won it all that year.) ₁₉

Despite Lily's short and stocky stature, those unfamiliar with her often underestimated her presence in the field and the undeniable ferocity she brought to each brace.

Lily was a top-tier tracker and demonstrated an unparalleled ability to navigate the entire field from start to finish. Lily meticulously combed every inch of the field exploring edges and overlooked areas with a knack for uncovering an additional bird, all while maintaining a vigilant eye on her bracemate for a backing opportunity.

In addition to her remarkable tracking skills, Lily was renowned for her steadiness. Upon locating the bird, she was unwavering in holding a point until the bird took flight.

Tom was laughed at on more than one occasion; unable to locate the bird, and unable to coax Lily into relocating.

Lily had a long and productive career; over 11 years. Her last placement was in 2020 in the Ohio Region Elimination where she was pulled due to an injury.

Last Dance Lily was a 15X NSTRA Champion with a total of 278 points, 140 of which were 1st place points. The Ohio Region extends heartfelt congratulations to Dash and Lily, two truly exceptional Hall of Fame dogs with illustrious and enduring careers. Special commendation goes to their devoted owner and handler, Tom Rotundo, for guiding these extraordinary dogs.


The American Brittany

The NSTRA community suffered profound loss, as two cherished friends, Paul DaCosta and Aaron Humphrey were taken from us due to sudden cardiac arrest while in the field. Emergencies in field trial locations can be particularly daunting, with limited communication and emergency services often minutes away.

According to the American Heart Association, the chance of survival diminishes by 7% to 10% every minute a normal heartbeat is not restored. Immediate intervention through CPR and the utilization of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) can significantly enhance the odds of survival by doubling or even tripling the person's chances.



In response to this these tragedies, Wayne Fishburn, Indiana Region, channeled our loss into a positive by raising funds for the acquisition of AEDs, ensuring multiple regions will have access to these life-saving devices. Thanks to Wayne's efforts Indiana, Ohio, Kentucky, and the Arkansas/Louisiana regions

are now equipped with AEDs to be deployed during trials. Wayne is seeking funds to support others!
