Merchant Vessel Security

From every type of merchant vessel such as tugs, dry bulk, container ships, Ro Ro's, chemical carriers and oil tankers, we understand the distinctions and requirements associated with protecting each type of vessel.

Ports and Terminals

Neptune P2P Group specialises in port and terminal security. We are International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code experts in the assessment and development of security plans and implementation of subsequent port security operations, including aboard offshore installations and fixed platforms isolated from shoreside security. Our portfolio includes associated ISM and ISPS Code training and capacity building. Neptune is accredited by the UK Ministry, Department of Transport for the delivery of ISPS related training.



Our USP sees Neptune delivering beyond the ISPS Code security baseline, incorporating international best practice coupled with decades of 'on-ground' experience. Moreover, we are thought leaders in security convergence and the digital integration of security measures that modern ports require to counter contemporary threats.

Oil and Gas Industry

We provide theatre entry and mission enablement for the energy sector across the Middle East, Africa and into South Asia. In Mozambique, our recommendations made during a security audit in 2021 most definitely saved many lives at the LNG site on the Afungi Peninsula in the Cabo Delgado region during the terrorist attacks later that year. More recently and locally, we provide regular security and ISPS related training whilst also providing security risk assessments and management for the sector's expanding operations.



Back to Africa, we have been delivering a Security Escort Vessel (SEV) capability in complex offshore environments across West Africa since 2013 in Ghana, Togo, Nigeria, Cameroon, Equatorial Guinea, and Gabon including MOPU security services.



Marine Works and Cable Laying

Our services provide vital support to global development in the energy and telecommunications industries. Submarine cables transmit most of the world's data and communications. These sophisticated cable-laying vessels are vulnerable to security threats due to their slow operating speed and sea/land integration - sometimes adjacent to hostile locations. 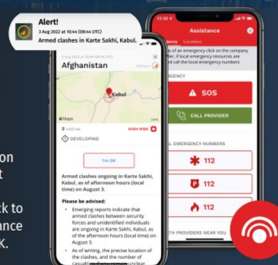

The app provides the platform to log travel bookings, provide travel security advice, monitor progress in semi-permissive or simply unfamiliar locations, and has a SOS alert feature that enables employees to reach out and notify their HQ, should it be necessary, that they are facing a security challenge and require assistance.

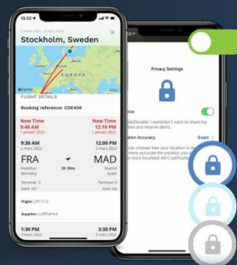
Alerts: Get notifications of incidents near you.

The Safeture Platform filters out alerts based on your location to present you with relevant risk information. Report back to your manager or assistance provider that you are OK.



Travel Bookings: All the latest information on your upcoming travels.

Get an overview of all your upcoming travel bookings and notifications of any flight disruption or gate changes. Avoid risk through alerts and information on changed risk levels at your destination.



Emergency Button: Help is just a click away.

Click the red SOS button to initiate emergency mode and notify both your organization and your assistance provider of your current location for prompt assistance.

Privacy Settings: Security and privacy should not be conflicting.

You can easily set your own privacy level in the app. Choose between exact location, city-level, or region/state level, or disable positioning capabilities altogether.

Air, Land and Sea Evacuations

These range from simple airspace closures (where normal medical evacuations cannot be guaranteed) to locations of rising tensions or unforeseen instability and hostilities.



Business Continuity and Resilience (BCR)

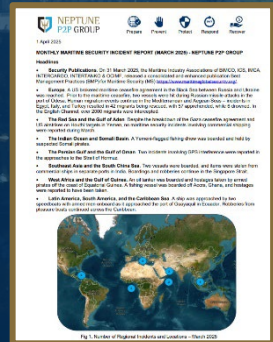
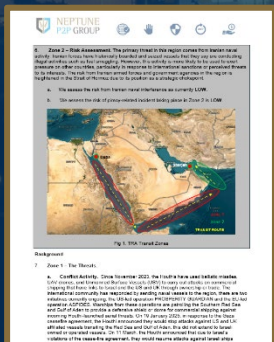
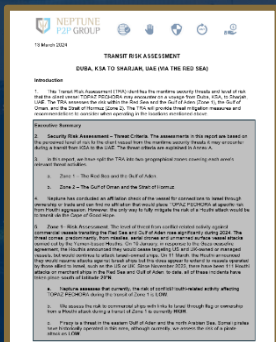
We work with organisations to confirm their critical assets, understand the likelihood and impact of a disruption to the asset's functionality, such as its supply chain, and develop contingency plans to mitigate the impact should a disruption occur, enabling business continuity assurance. This service can also include the testing of a company's security by providing an external validation of its security counter measures, policy and processes. The BCR advisory also encompasses Cyber Security Awareness.

Crisis Management and Emergency Response

Neptune provides procedures, training, and in-person or online virtual support for Crisis Management and Emergency Response, through its 24/7/365 Operations Centre, that complements Business Continuity and Resilience and Travel Risk Management, providing critical assistance at a time of need. Travel Risk Management (TRM) Related Courses

In an age of global mobility coupled with increasing insecurity, ensuring traveller safety and security has never been more crucial. Our Travel Risk Management courses are designed to equip individuals and organisations with the knowledge required to proactively identify, assess, and mitigate risk during travel. Whether you're a frequent business traveller, an adventurer, or a corporate manager responsible for employee safety, these courses provide essential tools for minimising potential threats, responding to emergencies, and safeguarding the well-being of those on the move.
