New Orleans Military and Maritime Academy

(NOMMA) is a Type 2 charter high school serving students in the entire New Orleans Metropolitan area. NOMMA is an “A “ rated, 8-12 grade open-enrollment public charter school, located in Federal City on the Westbank of Orleans Parish. NOMMA’s high quality academic program has 100 percent student body participation in Marine Corps Junior Reserve Officers’ Training Corps (MCJROTC).

Students at NOMMA study in a focused, college preparatory environment guided by a team of teachers and retired Marine instructors, who bring unparalleled experience to the classroom. NOMMA provides a rigorous curriculum, career and technical training, and character education in which cadets acquire the knowledge and skills of analysis, problem-solving, communication, and global responsibility.
