Embracing Inclusivity and Empowerment: A Navratri to Remember



Empowering Change Through Clean Habits: Sewa International's Mission for Health and Hygiene

In a heartfelt commitment to promote health and hygiene, Sewa International in Uttarakhand recently celebrated Global Handwashing Day on October 15th, dedicating this complete month to raising awareness about hand hygiene under its Adolescent Holistic Development Program. Aligned with Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 6.2, which emphasizes equitable sanitation and hygiene for all, this program aimed at over 1,200 adolescent girls across 200+ villages in Chamoli and Rudraprayag districts.

Under the Adolescent Holistic Development Program, Sewa organized engaging activities that combined awareness with hands-on learning. Through captivating video sessions and a specially designed pamphlet, "Clean Hands, Healthy Body," the girls explored the significance of hand hygiene and the vital role it plays in their health. This pamphlet, with clear steps and guidance, became a foundation for learning and sharing knowledge within their communities.

The girls embraced interactive activities, creating "MY REMINDER" charts to prompt regular handwashing and participating in an imaginative exercise, "I AM MY EVERYDAY HERO," where they envisioned themselves as advocates for hygiene in their neighborhoods. Their creativity shone as they took to social media with a "See and Repeat Reel," demonstrating handwashing techniques to broaden their reach and inspire others to adopt clean habits.

To deepen this learning, Sewa also held a webinar, "Clean Habits, Healthy Life: Small Changes, Big Impact," led by health experts, where the girls engaged in storytelling exercises and took a hygiene pledge, promising to spread their newfound awareness.

Through these efforts, Sewa International has fostered a culture of health consciousness, empowering young girls to become agents of change in their communities, embodying the essence of Global Handwashing Day by taking small, meaningful steps toward a healthier tomorrow.
