

WINTER VACCINATIONS: Get an extra layer of protection this winter



As the colder months approach, viruses such as flu and COVID-19 can spread more easily and cause serious illness, especially for older adults and those with underlying health conditions. The best way to stay protected is to make sure your winter vaccinations are up to date.

Primary Care Knowsley practices are now offering flu, shingles, pneumococcal, and COVID-19 booster vaccines (where eligible).

Why It Matters

Getting vaccinated doesn't just protect you - it helps protect your family, friends, and our wider community by reducing the spread of infection and easing pressure on local NHS services during the busy winter months.

Vaccines Available

Flu Vaccine

Available free for:

- Everyone aged 65 and over
- People (18-65) with certain long-term health conditions
- Pregnant women
- Carers and frontline health or social care workers
- Children aged 2 to 17 (offered as a nasal spray for most children)

Shingles Vaccine

Available free for:

- Adults aged 65 to 80
- People (18+) with certain health conditions (such as chronic heart, lung, or liver disease)

Pneumococcal (Pneumo) Vaccine

Available free for:

- Adults aged 65 and over
- People (18-65) with certain health conditions (such as chronic heart, lung, or liver disease)

COVID-19 Booster

Available free for:

- Adults aged 75 and over
- Those with weakened immune systems or certain long-term conditions
- Health and social care staff

How to Book

You can book your vaccination through your GP practice or local pharmacy.

- Contact your practice directly to book or check eligibility
- Visit the NHS website for more information about who can get each vaccine
