The Black Sheep Prayer Meeting

And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed. (Mk 1:35, ESV).

Prayer was an important part of Jesus's ministry here on earth. He often would separate himself from his disciples and spend time alone in prayer. Additionally, he would pray with his disciples and even include them in his special time. Remember the garden? Before his arrest and crucifixion, he had the disciples wait while he prayed. He then had Peter, James, and John go further with him to pray. (Mk 14:32-42). In Luke 11, we see Jesus's disciples asking him to teach them to pray. This is where we get the Lord's Prayer. If prayer was an important part of Jesus's ministry, shouldn't it be an important part of our ministry?.

As Black Sheep Chaplains, one of our primary responsibilities is to give prayer its proper place in chapter activities. We should also be giving it its proper place in our lives. At the International level of Black Sheep, we've made an effort to promote prayer by setting up a weekly prayer meeting on Zoom for any and all who are interested. This is a time to come together and pray for our ministry, our members, and any concerns that come in throughout the week. Praying in a corporate setting helps build the body. It strengthens the whole. In fact, couples that pray together daily tend to have a divorce rate of less than 1%. So much can be said about a church or ministry that prays together. It is difficult to be divisive if we pray together.

This does not mean that the only place Black Sheep should pray is at our weekly prayer meeting. 5pm on a Thursday may not work well for those on the west coast. That same 8pm on the east coast may be easier to schedule. The key is that we, as a group, are setting apart time to pray for this ministry. *Will you join us?* Our scheduled time is:

Thursdays at 5pm Pacific/8pm Eastern.

### THE 7TH INDIAN CHIEF OFF THE LINE IN 1942

#### MATCHING NUMBERS

Finding a 1942 Indian Chief is an extraordinarily rare happening. The seventh Chief off the line in 1942 and bearing styling cues more akin to a 1941 model, this '42 Chief is beautifully restored both cosmetically and mechanically. Painted in Seafoam Blue and black, it is a stunning machine with nickel-plated cylinders and the large-diameter wheels and leaf-spring forks of the prewar Chiefs, which gives them a lighter and more elegant silhouette. Furthermore, the engine of this bike was built by Mark Jacobs, a well-known Indian expert in Northern California. There's something very special about these early 1940s Chiefs with their sharp front fender, leaf-spring front fork (dropped postwar) and simple cast Indian badge on the tank.



#### It's one of the most elegant motorcycles ever built, and this one benefits from a stunning restoration.

While the Chief name is synonymous with Indian, the Springfield factory took 20 years to deliver its first model of that name in 1921. The Chief endures on Indian's Big Twins through the present day, and it has eclipsed the Scout and the Four as the first impression for the brand. The 1921 Chief was a fast and solid motorcycle using the side-valve Powerplus engine and 3-speed gearbox.

# **Biblical Biblical Tests** For Making Decisions In Your Ministry

In a world filled with choices, making decisions that honor God and reflect our faith can be challenging. These decisions can range from personal conduct to ministry initiatives. Here are eight biblical tests to help guide your decision-making process:

#### **1. Scriptural Test**

"Has God already spoken about it in His Word?" (2 Timothy 3:16)

The Bible is our ultimate guide. When faced with a decision, the first step is to check if Scripture has already addressed it. God's Word provides timeless wisdom and principles that can illuminate our path.

#### 2. Secrecy Test

"Would it bother me if everyone knew this was my choice?" (Proverbs 11:3)

Integrity is key in our walk with Christ. If a decision is something you wouldn't want others to know about, it's worth reconsidering. Transparency and honesty should be at the core of our choices.

#### **3. Survey Test**

"What if everyone followed my example?" (1 Timothy 4:12)

As leaders and members of a ministry, our actions set an example. Consider the impact of your decision on others. Would it lead them closer to Christ or away from Him? Strive to be a positive influence.

#### **4. Spiritual Test**

"Am I being people-pressured or Spirit-led?" (Galatians 1:10)

It's important to discern the source of your motivation. Are you making this decision to please others or because you feel led by the Holy Spirit? Seek God's guidance rather than yielding to external pressures.

#### **5. Stumbling Test**

"Could this cause another person to stumble?" (Romans 14:21)

Our actions can have unintended consequences on others' faith. Ensure that your decisions do not become a stumbling block for fellow believers. Consider how your choices might affect those around you.

#### **6. Serenity Test**

"Have I prayed and received peace about this decision?" (Philippians 4:6-7)

Prayer is essential in the decision-making process. Take time to pray and seek God's peace. If you feel unsettled, it may be a sign to pause and reconsider your options.

#### 7. Sanctification Test

"Will this keep me from growing in the character of Christ?" (2 Corinthians 3:18)

Evaluate whether the decision will contribute to your spiritual growth. Will it help you become more like Christ, or will it hinder your sanctification? Aim for choices that promote your spiritual development.

#### 8. Supreme Test

"Does this glorify God?" (1 Corinthians 10:31)

Ultimately, our decisions should glorify God. Reflect on whether your choice honors Him and aligns with His will. Our primary goal should be to bring glory to God in all we do.

"Walk as children of light.... and try to discern what is pleasing to the Lord." (Ephesians 5:8, 10)

By applying these eight tests, we can navigate decisions with wisdom and faith, ensuring our choices reflect our commitment to Christ and our witness to the world.

In the early 90's I hit a deer on my Yamaha. I had lots of road rash but no broken bones or serious injuries. With 3 small kids I felt the Lord might be telling me, "Now may not be the right time for this".


Fast forward, 2002 my wife Anna and I were married and we had 6 kids between us, a modern-day Brady Bunch as it were. I really wanted a new Harley and in 2004 I purchased a new Road King Classic.

I remember riding around the neighborhood and to Church, I felt like something was missing or even that I perhaps, was missing something. One Sunday I spotted John Sanders strolling across the courtyard at Church, in his Black Sheep cut. After a conversation with John, started researching Motorcycle Ministries and felt called to Black Sheep as it was the only ministry with a targeted heart for HOG. After much contemplation, in 2006, I paid my money, was issued my patch and I was a Black Sheep! No mentoring back then.

I remember being at a HOG event at our local dealership with Ken Brigham, who was the RD at that time. It was over 100 degrees that day and I scooted back home to take off my cut in search of the coolness of just a T shirt. When I arrived back at the dealership Ken got in my face and said, "Jesus died for your sins and you can't stand the heat with your cut on!" Talk about being convicted! I ran back home got my cut and have never left the garage without it again. With nearly 100K on the Road King, I sold it and purchased a new 2016 Road Glide Ultra. I have just over 75K on it. God has been gracious to me as I hit my second deer in 2021, the bike stayed up and again no serious injuries. With the bike in the shop for over a year I purchased a 2009 Road King Classic to fill in and rode it to Sturgis in 2022. Anna and I have also joined Black Sheep Classics with "Betsy" our 1957 Ford Country Sedan Wagon. My Dad purchased it new in Bakersfield, CA. It has over 300K miles on it.

I have been a P, VP and am currently RD over Oregon, Northern California, and Northern Nevada. I love serving HOG as a Black Sheep. I have an overwhelming sense of purpose every time I am on my bike.


