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Independence Day Contests (IDC) – 2026

Hosted by Sri Lankan Majlis Qatar (SLMQ) since 2002



Since the introduction of Independence Day Contests (IDC), IDC has evolved into an annual flagship initiative that celebrates Sri Lanka's Independence while nurturing creativity, confidence, and communication skills among the younger generation. The contests are open to all Sri Lankan school students residing in Qatar, regardless of their school.

This year, IDC will be held across five age categories, offering four events that encourage broad student participation and provide opportunities for participants to showcase their talents within their respective age groups.

Reflecting SLMQ's 25-year journey, IDC 2026 introduces an enhanced structure with online registration, recorded pre-qualifier rounds for selected events, and in-person finals on the event day. These enhancements strengthen accessibility, transparency, and fairness while reaffirming the importance of celebrating Independence through education and meaningful student participation.

A. General Rules:

1. Open to Sri Lankan students residing in Qatar with a valid QID.
2. Students may participate only in events within their eligible age group.
3. Registration must be completed through the link, available from the SLMQ website www.slmq.org, starting 03 Feb 2026 till 10 Feb 2026.
4. One entry per event per participant is permitted
5. All submissions must be the student's original work
6. Parents may assist only with the technical setup; coaching or prompting is not allowed
7. Late or incomplete submissions will not be considered
8. Judges are independent and impartial; their decisions are final and binding
9. SLMQ reserves the right to make necessary changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the contest

B. How to Register and Participate

1. Parents and Students Registration

Parents must register using the link [available on the SLMQ website](#) from 03 Feb 2026 to 10 Feb 2026. During registration, enter all required contact and child details, and select the event(s) for each child, registering **one child at a time**.

An acknowledgement email will be automatically sent upon successful registration.

2. Online Submissions

For online submissions (Prepared Speech – Round One and Essay Writing), **the system will send a secure upload link to registered parents**. The upload window will be open **from 06 Feb 2026 to 10 Feb 2026**. Detailed upload guidelines will be provided with the submission link.

Video Recording Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The speech must be recorded in one continuous, unedited recording. No background music, sound effects, filters, or visual enhancements are permitted. Reading from notes, paper, or screens is not allowed. The speaker should look directly at the camera while speaking. Position the camera at eye level and frame the speaker from the waist up, ensuring the face and expressions are clearly visible. Record in a quiet environment with minimal background noise. Ensure good lighting so the speaker's face is clearly visible and not in shadow. The video must be of high quality and have clear audio throughout; mobile phone recordings are acceptable.

Disqualification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ No disqualification for time overruns. ✓ Parents may help only with the technical setup (camera, lighting, uploading). Coaching, scripting, prompting, or assisting during recording is not allowed. ✓ Only one video file is allowed during the submission window. Parents may delete and re-upload the video until the window closes. The judges will evaluate the final file available at the closing time. ✓ All videos will be reviewed for editing, continuity, and Rule compliance. Any violation will result in disqualification.

The contestants shall be provided with an A4 sheet duly attested by the SLMQ and marked with a reference number. The contestant shall bring their own color pencils, crayons, and other stationery. Please note that only color pencils or crayons shall be used. Both cannot be used together. They are prohibited from writing their names or the name of the school they represent. No printed materials, electronic gadgets, or storage devices shall be utilized. The artwork must be original and not previously published or exhibited. The result of the contest shall be announced in the award-giving ceremony. The first three winners will be awarded. The judges' decision is final.
