Fee information

Fees

- Fees are payable on a termly basis at the start of each term. Fees usually increase annually in August.
- A 3% administrative fee is added to all payments except for online bank transfers and interbank transfers. The school's preferred method of payment is direct bank transfer. The school does not accept payment in cash.
- Effective from 1st January 2026, all Secondary students' registration, admittance and tuition fees will be subject to a 6% Sales & Service Tax (SST), as mandated by the Royal Malaysian Customs Department.

Deposit

- The deposit is refunded with one term's notice of withdrawal from KTJ. Failure to provide a full term's notice will result in the refundable deposit being forfeited. Notice of withdrawal must be sent to Dr Glenn Moodie, via: principal@ktj.edu.my.

Discounts

- A 5% sibling discount is provided on net tuition fees for a third child enrolled in the school. Thereafter, a discount of 10% will be applied to the fourth, fifth and sixth child. The largest discount is applied to the youngest child.
