Advocate Pierre Rossouw SC is a senior member of Maisels Chambers in Sandton. He was admitted to the Johannesburg Bar in 1988. Rossouw was appointed as Senior Counsel on 5 December 2006.

Prior to his admission as an advocate, Rossouw practised as an attorney, notary and conveyancer.

His court appearances include the various divisions of the High Court, the Supreme Court of Appeal, the Constitutional Court of South Africa as well as the High Court and Supreme Court of Namibia. The judgments in 32 of his litigious matters have been reported in the South African Law Reports, the All South African Law Reports, the Butterworths Constitutional Law Reports and the Commercial Law Reports.

He has held appointments as an acting Judge of the Gauteng Local Division of the High Court in 2007, 2009, 2011 and 2015.

Rossouw is a Fellow (FAarb) of the Association of Arbitrators (Southern Africa) NPC. He was elected to the Association's Board on 10 May 2018. He was Chairman of the Association from 30 May 2019 to 14 August 2025.

He is an Associate of the South African Institution of Civil Engineering and is on the SAICE President's List of Alternative Dispute Resolution Professionals. He serves on the General Commercial Panel of the Arbitration Foundation of South Africa (AFSA).

On 1 December 2017 Rossouw was awarded the Advanced Certificate in International Arbitration by the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators.

Rossouw's arbitration and litigation practice includes general commercial law with a particular interest in construction law and the law of contract. From 2008 to date, Rossouw has held several appointments as arbitrator and adjudicator, primarily in disputes arising from the construction industry.
