The first day was around Honey sensory with techniques, physiology, guided tasting. On the second day honey was investigated as a food ingredient. Next day the partnership took a visit at local rural producers Podere101, Apicoltura Finelli, as well as the CONAPI producer consortium. The LTTA has provided a good basis for the development of the content and structure of the curricula to be implemented. Fantastic ideas, producers, flavors and opportunities were explored by the partnership.
