What to expect: These trips feature long touring days with travel via motor coach, ship, zodiac, all-terrain vehicle, or train. Travelers are required to board transportation without assistance as well as stand and walk over uneven terrain for extended periods of time. Some tours may include optional higher-intensity activities and travel at higher altitudes with steep ascents and descents. Outings last four to six hours most days.

**Suitable for:** Travelers who are able to comfortably walk <u>four to six</u> miles, or 6,900–9,200 steps, each day.

# Aegean Sea Odyssey | Itinerary and Highlights (subject to change)

Day 1: EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

- Day 2: ARRIVE IN ATHENS, GREECE I PIRAEUS EMBARKATION Upon arriving an Orbridge representative will be waiting to assist with your transfer to Piraeus. As embarkation begins, take time to unpack and become familiar with your accommodations. This evening gather with fellow travel companions for a welcome reception to celebrate the exciting journey ahead. Overnight: Le Dumont-d'Urville (R,D)
- Day 3: DELOS I MYKONOS Disembark for a guided archaeological tour of Delos, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Observe the Terrace of Lions, the majestic Temple of Apollo and the Theatre District. Later enjoy leisure time to discover Mykonos, a charming island known for its role in Greek mythology and as a key trading port. Overnight: Le Dumont-d'Urville (B,L,D)
- Day 4: SANTORINI Located on the southern coast of Santorini rests Akrotiri, considered one of the most well-planned and advanced cities of its time. Buried in lava stone after the catastrophic volcanic eruption that occurred around 1627 BC, the site was discovered in 1967 by archaeologist Spyridon Marinatos. Excavations have revealed a wealth of artifacts including tools and other objects that indicate a sophisticated level of craftsmanship. This afternoon, enjoy free time on the island or choose to join a winery tour and tasting excursion. Overnight: Le Dumont-d'Urville (B,L,D)

- Day 5: RHODES This morning join a guided walking tour through the medieval city of Rhodes. Later choose to join the optional excursion to the Acropolis of Lindos. View the Temple of Athena Lindia which dates back to the 4th century BC. Overnight: Le Dumont-d'Urville (B,L,D)
- Day 6: KUŞADASI, TÜRKIYE This morning arrive at Kuşadasi, the gateway to the ancient city of Ephesus. At the ancient agora, explore the ruins of temples and public areas that once buzzed with activity. Later visit a carpet weaving center followed by a traditional Turkish lunch.

Overnight: Le Dumont-d'Urville (B,L,D)

- Day 7: TURKISH COAST CRUISING Savor a full day of leisure on board as you cruise north along the coast. Take advantage of the ship's plentiful amenities. Overnight: Le Dumont-d'Urville (B,L,D)
- Day 8: ÇANAKKALE Tour the archaeological site of Troy, a UNESCO World Heritage site and location of the legendary Trojan War, as described in Homer's *Iliad*. Then visit the Archaeological Museum. After lunch join an optional excursion to see the ancient city of Assos and the Temple of Athena. Tonight gather for a farewell reception followed by a convivial gala dinner to commemorate this epic odyssey cruising the Aegean Sea. Overnight: *Le Dumont-d'Urville* (B,L,R,D)
- Day 9: ISTANBUL DISEMBARKATION I DEPART FOR U.S. After breakfast take the complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home. (B)



#### Deluxe (Deck 3) approx. 204 sq. ft.

One king or two single beds, private bathroom with shower, glazed panoramic swing door and rectangular window, private balcony with two armchairs.

#### Prestige (Decks 4, 5, 6) approx. 204 sq. ft.

One king or two single beds, one chaise lounge chair, private bathroom with shower, panoramic sliding bay window or panoramic swing door, panoramic sliding bay window, private balcony with two armchairs.

#### Deluxe Suite (Decks 3, 4, 5, 6) approx. 290 sq. ft.

One king or two single beds, an armchair and sofa, private bathroom with shower, glazed panoramic swing door and panoramic window (Deck 3), panoramic sliding bay window (Decks 4, 5, 6), private balcony with two armchairs.

Priority boarding, champagne and fruit basket upon arrival and an assortment of sweet or savory canapés and fruit basket daily, one king or two single beds, lounge with chaise lounge and armchair, private bathroom with shower, panoramic sliding bay window, private balcony with two armchairs, butler service.





#### Grand Deluxe Suite (Deck 6) approx. 484 sq. ft.

Enjoy additional time in the ancient city of Athens, where history and modernity entwine.

#### Day +1: EN ROUTE FROM U.S.

#### Day +2: ARRIVE IN ATHENS, GREECE Upon arrival to Athens International Airport transfer to the hotel to enjoy the evening at leisure. Overnight: King George, a Luxury Collection Hotel

- Day +3: ATHENS Following breakfast join your local guide for a tour of Acropolis, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Acropolis has a history dating back to the Mycenaean period and has been continuously inhabited and developed over the centuries. The area has undergone extensive restoration and conservation efforts over the years to ensure its continued preservation. Before returning to the hotel stop at a local taverna for lunch. The remainder of the afternoon and evening are at leisure. Overnight: King George, a Luxury Collection Hotel (B,L)
- Day +4: ATHENS I MAIN PROGRAM BEGINS Join your guide for a combination bus and walking tour to explore Athens' vibrant tapestry. Visit a variety of local shops and cafés to sample an array of traditional coffees, pastries and finger foods, savoring each sip, bite and flavor along the way. Afterward transfer to the Port of Piraeus to join guests arriving for the main program and embarkation. (B)

After lunch proceed to the Hagia Sophia, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Descend into the Basilica Cistern, an ancient underground reservoir built in the 6th century. Conclude the day with a visit to the Grand Bazaar, one of the world's oldest and largest covered markets. The remainder of the evening is at leisure. Overnight: Çırağan Palace Kempinski (L)

Day 10: ISTANBUL Set out for Topkapi Palace to explore the sprawling grounds, magnificent courtyards and lavish chambers. Afterward take a leisurely stroll through Pera district—Istanbul's bustling pedestrian street lined with shops, cafés and historic landmarks. Following lunch visit Taksim Square. This evening enjoy the hotel's plentiful amenities. Overnight: Çırağan Palace Kempinski (B,L)

Day 11: ISTANBUL I DEPART FOR U.S. After breakfast take the complimentary transfer to the airport for flights home. (B)
