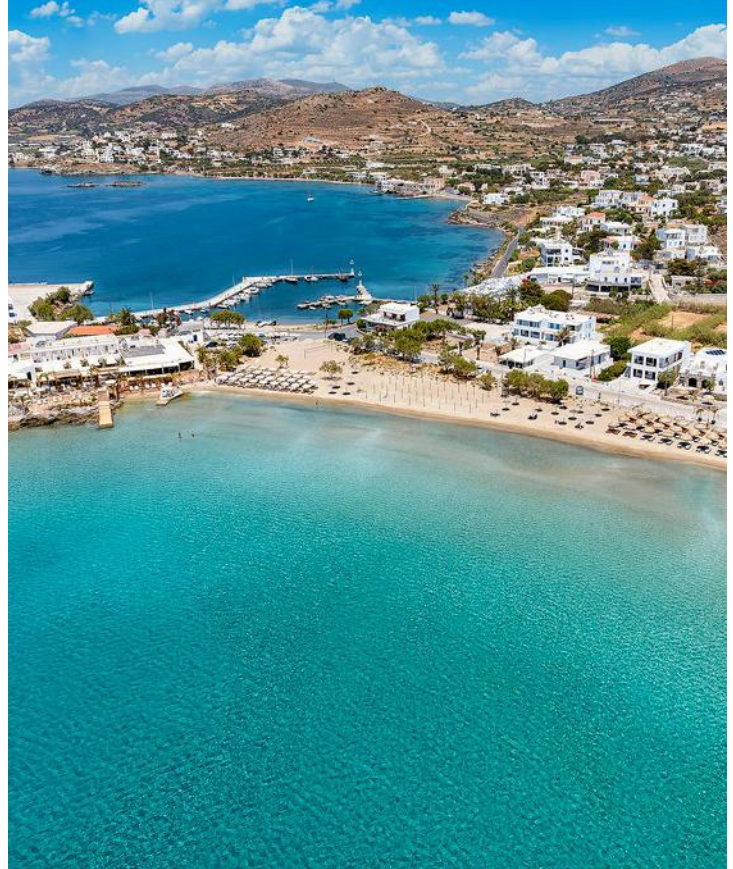

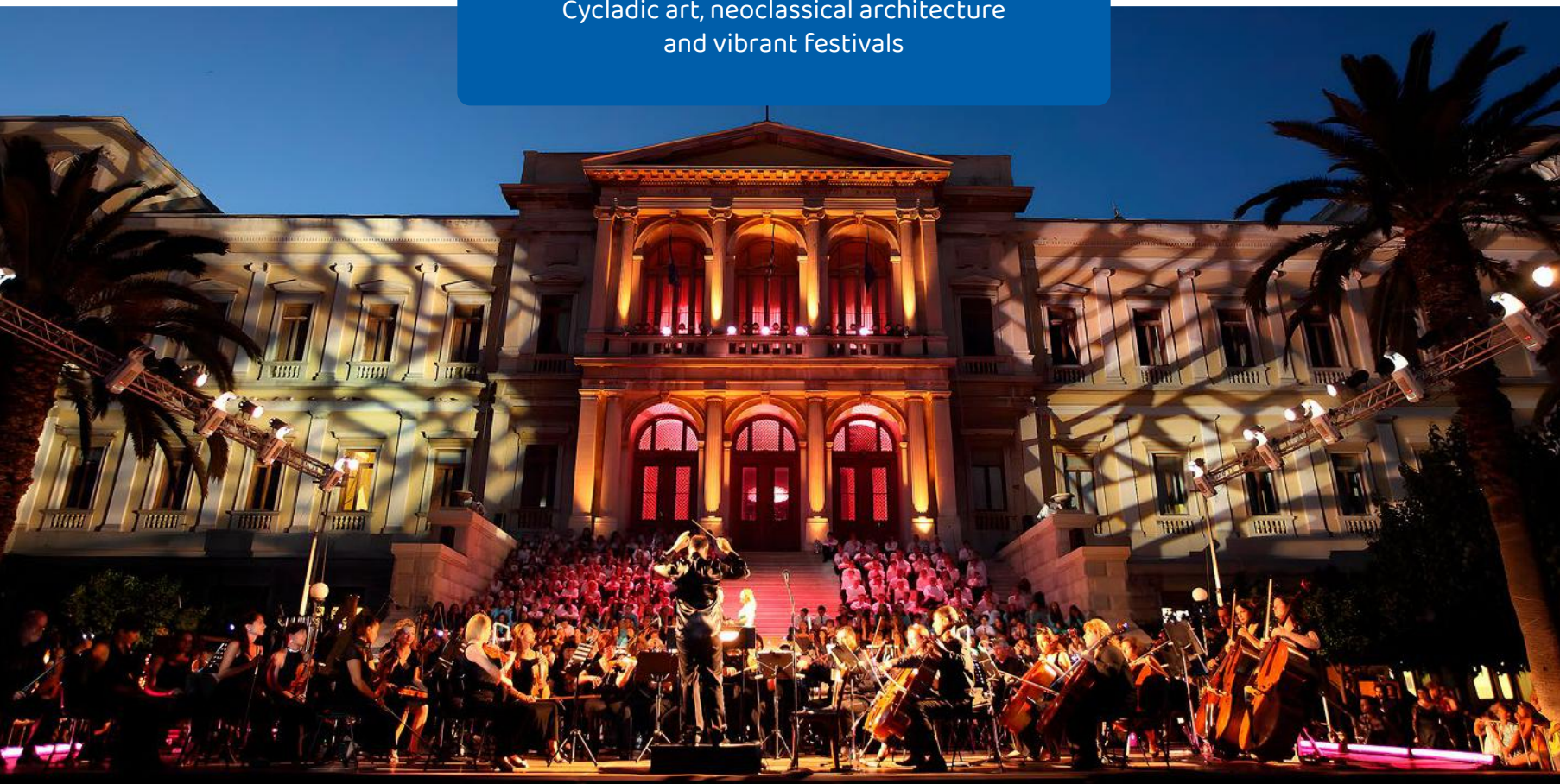
THINGS TO DO

Medieval architecture, stunning views, narrow alleys, and historic landmarks



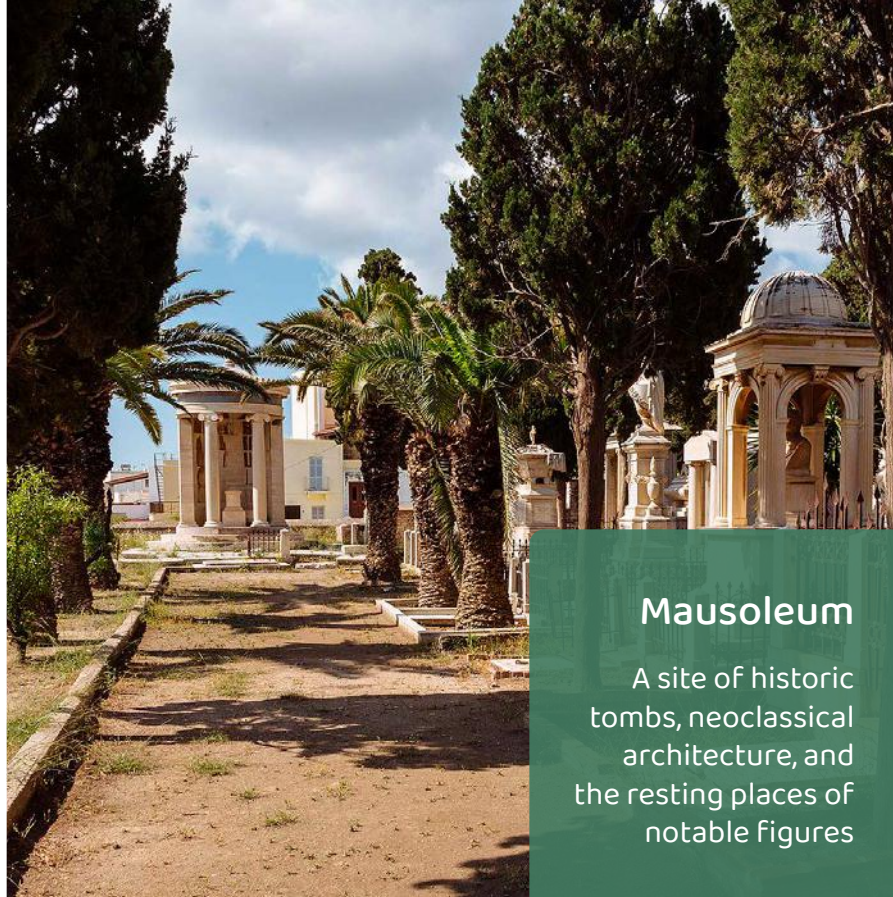
Miaouli Square

An architectural treasure, designed by Ernst Ziller, in 1876



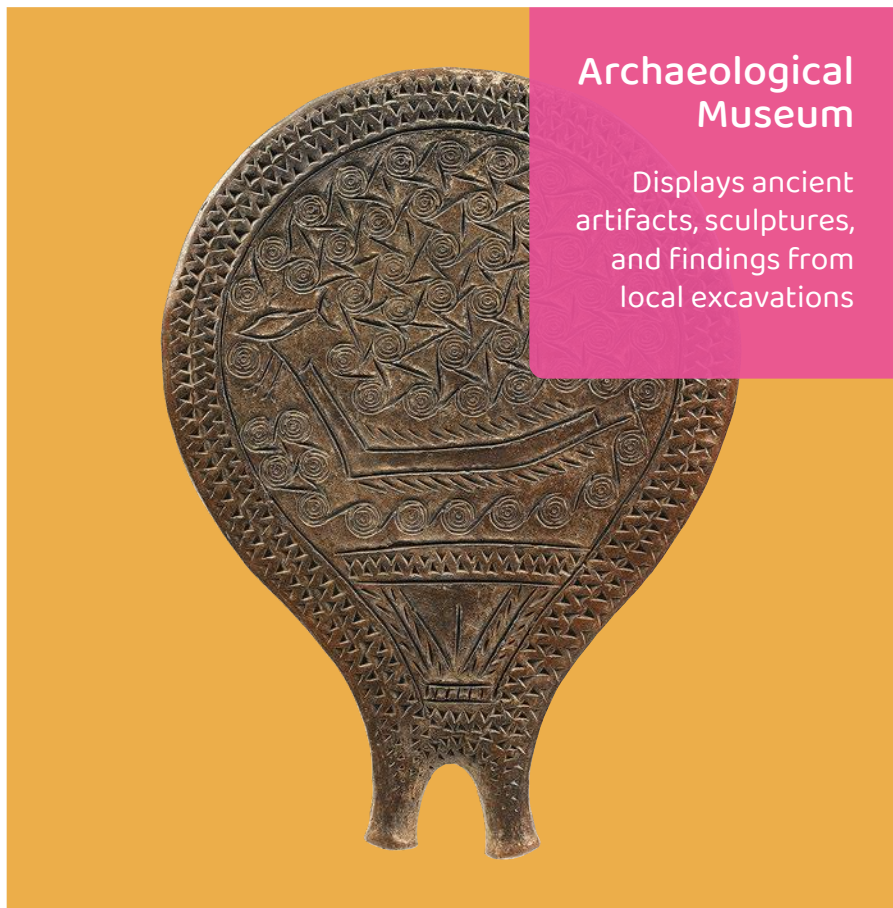
Mausoleum

Displays ancient artifacts, sculptures, and findings from local excavations

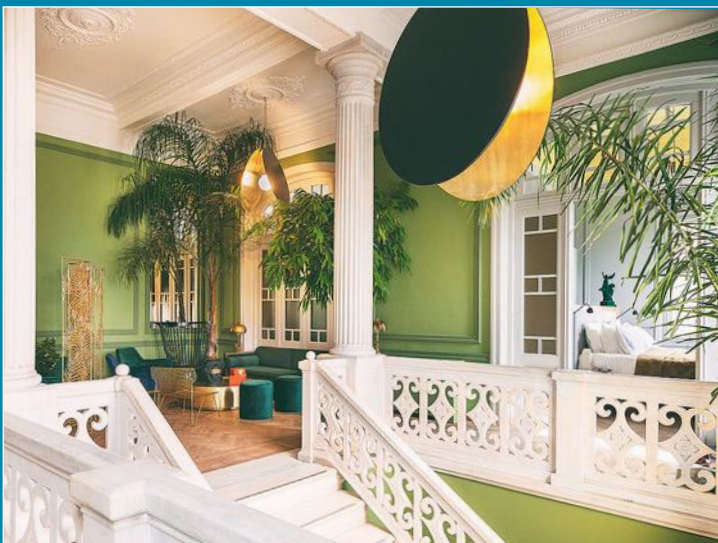


Industrial Museum

Syros, often referred to as the "Island of Festivals", boasts a rich cultural calendar throughout the year.

HERMOUPOLIS CHOIR FESTIVAL

May 30 – June 1. A gathering of choirs from various regions, showcasing choral music in the historic setting of Hermoupolis.

HERMOUPOLIS GUITAR FESTIVAL

July 4–8. A festival celebrating guitar music, with performances by renowned guitarists in various styles.

INTERNATIONAL DANCE AND PERFORMING ARTS FESTIVAL "AKROPODITI DANCEFEST"

July 10–20. A festival featuring dance and performing arts, with workshops and performances by international artists.

FESTIVAL OF THE AEGEAN

July 18–27. An international festival presenting opera, classical music, and other performances, attracting artists and audiences worldwide.

EYE'S WALK DIGITAL FESTIVAL

August 2–17. A festival showcasing classical music performances by renowned musicians in various venues across Syros.

August 18–24. A festival celebrating organ music, with concerts held in the historic churches of Ano Syros.

REBETIKO FESTIVAL

August 27–30. A festival dedicated to Rebetiko, a genre of Greek urban folk music, featuring performances and workshops.

SYROS JAZZ FESTIVAL

September 12–14. A festival featuring jazz performances by local and international artists in various venues.

STRAY ART FESTIVAL

September 19–21. A festival celebrating street art, with live mural paintings, exhibitions, and workshops.

INTERNATIONAL ANIMATION FESTIVAL "ANIMASYROS"

September 22–28. An international festival dedicated to animation, featuring screenings, workshops, and discussions.
