friends, Gary and Gayle Byers. They go


to amazing places and find important artifacts from the past. That is fun, but not nearly as much fun as travelling back in time to those places like we do.

DAY On this trip we are meeting a man called Abram. He is 75 years old, but God is about to call him to go on an exciting adventure! Read Genesis 12:1-9

It was hard leaving my country and people to go to a new land. But God's call was exciting, and his promises were amazing. Although I didn't know where he would take me, I believed that God is always faithful and obeyed.

DAY 2 Read Genesis 12:1-3

Leaving everything behind sounds a bit scary, but God gave Abram some amazing promises. He would have a big family that would be a blessing to the whole world!

DAY 3 Read Genesis 12:4-5

Abram obeyed God and left his home to travel to Canaan along with his household including his animals. That was a lot to move when they didn't have boxes and a truck.

It is time to go back home and think about what we discovered.

DAY 5 Read Genesis 12:8-9

As Abram travelled on, he remembered God's promises and that God was with him. Each step of the way he built an altar to worship and show his total dependence on God.

DAY Read Genesis 12:6-7

The people in Canaan were powerful. God appeared to Abram to reassure him of his promise. Abram built an altar to worship God and to remind himself of this.

DAYS 6&7

Abram obeyed God and journeyed to Canaan. On the next trip, we will find out more about God's promises and how they worked out.

An ALTAR was a special place, often a raised platform or table, where people worshipped God, made offerings to him, and prayed. The first thing Noah did when he and his family came out of the ark was to build an altar. Every time Abram came to a new place, he built an altar to the Lord. It was their way of showing God that they were totally dependent on him.

DAY 3 Read Genesis 15:5-7


Have you ever tried to count the stars? God promised Abram even more descendants than that. Abram couldn't see how it would happen, but he trusted him, and God was pleased.

SARAI'S 3OLUTION

Sarai was fed up waiting for God's promise to come true and began to think about what she might do to make it happen. Her lack of faith will have serious consequences.

PRAY: Are there times when you find it hard to trust God? Talk to him about this and ask him to help you.

DAY 1 Abram and Sarai have now been waiting ten years for the child God promised. Sarai starts to doubt it will ever happen and comes up with her own solution.

DAY 2 Read Genesis 16:1-4

Servants had to do what their masters told them to do. Sarai thought God's promise to Abram could come true if he had a child with her servant. Not a great idea!




Telling Abram to have a baby with my servant Hagar seemed a good idea at the time, but it only

caused trouble. I should have kept waiting and trusting God.

DAY 3 Read Genesis 16:5-6

Hagar became pregnant, but rather than making things better, this led to tension between Sarai and her, and between Sarai and Abram. It got so bad that Hagar ran away!



Hagar must have felt very sad and lonely out in the wilderness with nowhere to go. But God sent an angel to speak to her and comfort her.

It is time to go back home and think about what we discovered.

DAY 5 Read Genesis 16:9-10

The angel told Hagar to return home and promised that she too would be blessed with many descendants. Hagar knew that God saw her and cared for her.



Sarai's plan to provide Abram with an heir went wrong, but would they ever have a child of their own? We'll find out on our next trip!



Sarah knew that normally it would have been impossible for her to have a baby at her age, but she discovered that nothing is impossible with God!

DAYS 6&7

Now that Abraham and Sarah have their own baby, Hagar and Ishmael are sent away, so Isaac is the only heir. What will happen next?





God provided a ram to take Isaac's place. An angel then told Abraham that God would keep blessing him, his descendants, and all the nations of the earth because he obeyed God!

It looked like the end for Isaac, but fortunately he was saved! One day God's son would be sacrificed for the whole world.
