

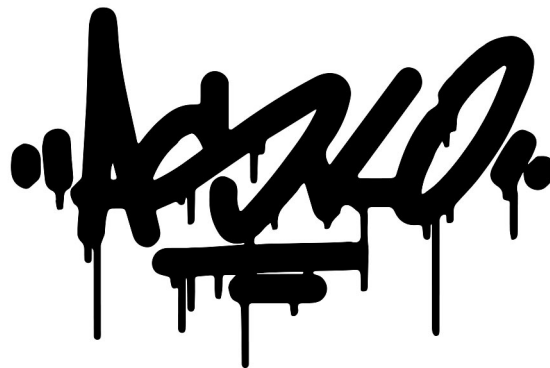
This book is a curated visual presentation of my graffiti murals, created for businesses and individuals seeking to bring life to their environment with a powerful artwork.

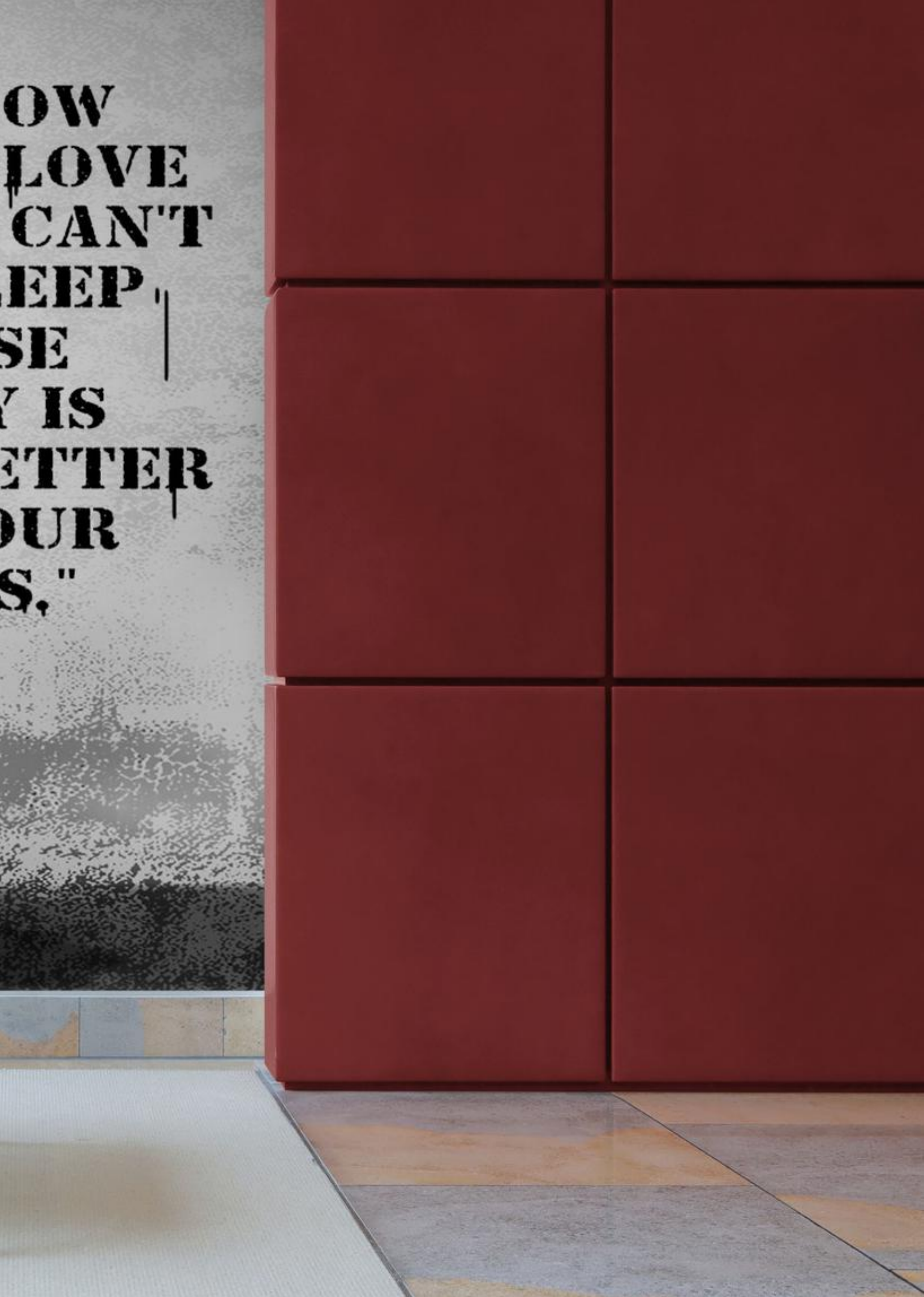

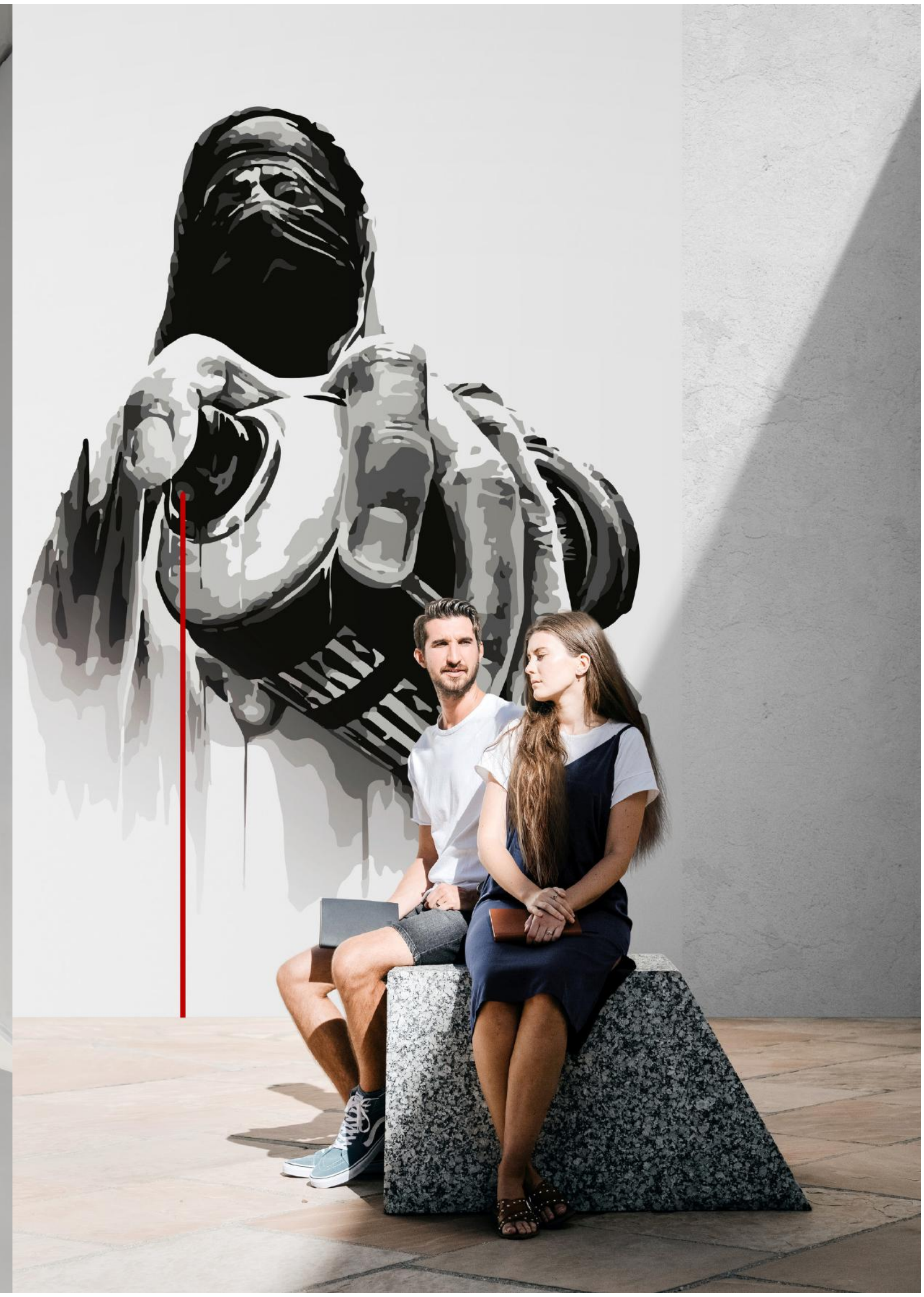

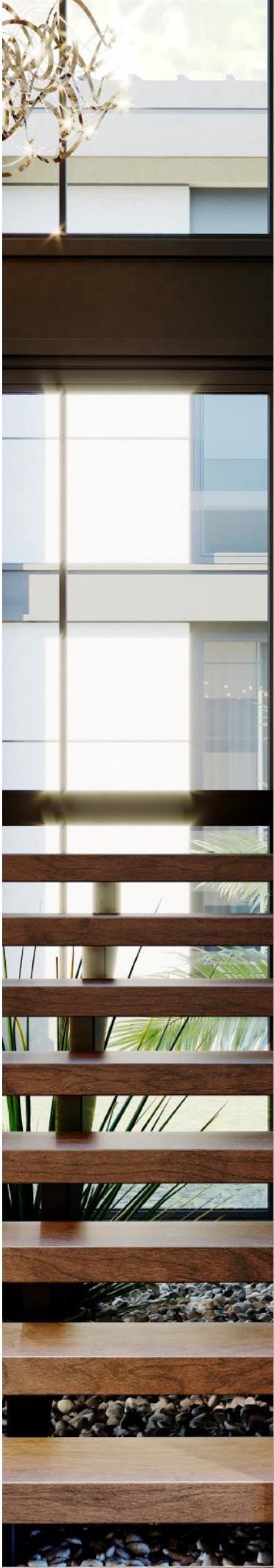

The power behind my materials

Before I even sketch a line, I reach for the tools that translate my vision into vibration. Each piece of art holds its own energy. Together, they turn empty surfaces, whether its a canvas or a wall, into living stories.

Spray paint is my first love. A few strokes, and the artwork comes alive, in explosion of color and energy. Nothing else gives me that rush. I've been hooked since I was a kid.

Acrylic paint moves with me. It's vibrant, flexible, and quick, perfect for layering, allowing me to form my idea.

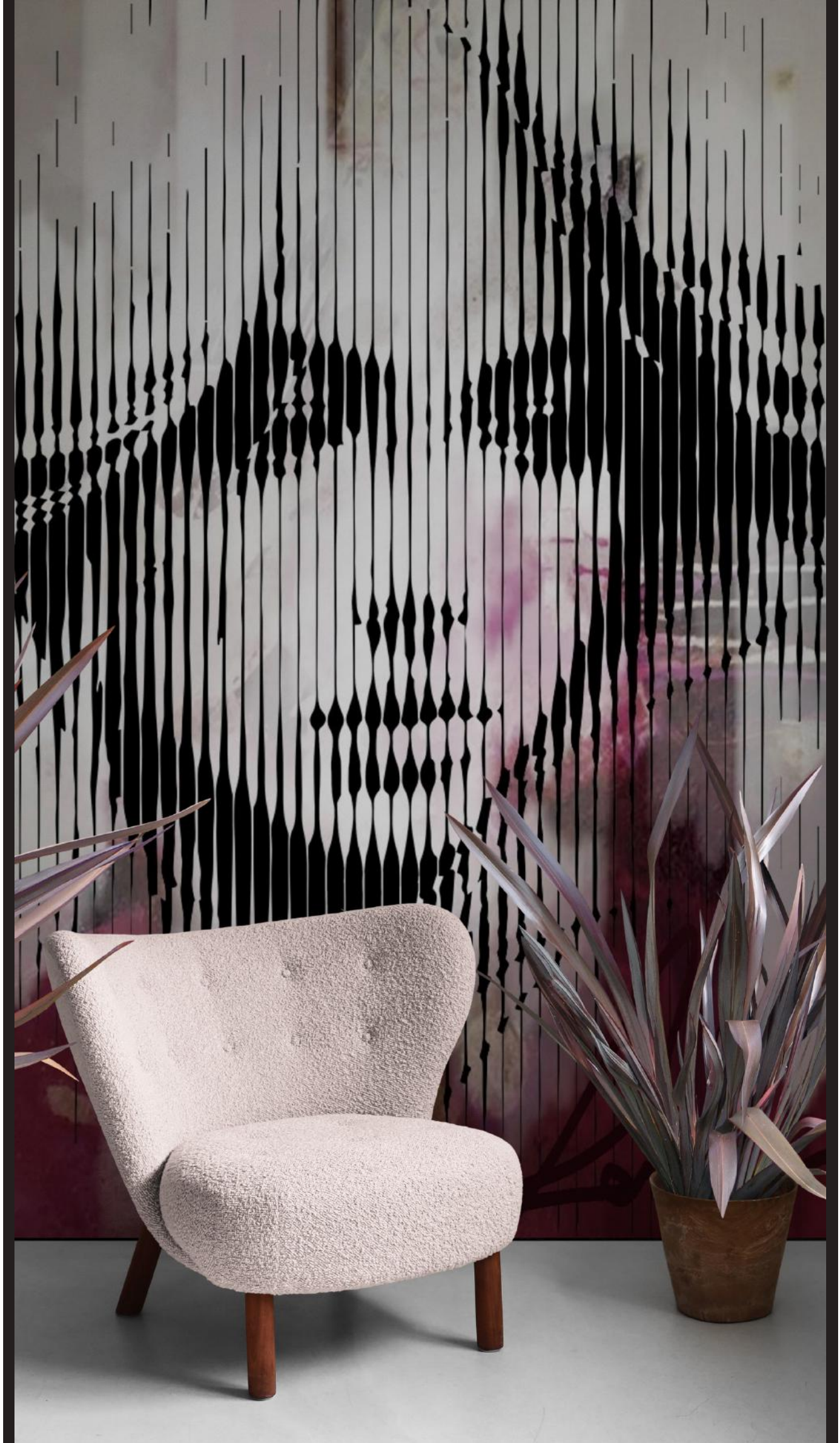
Brushes are my quiet, precise allies. Each one has its own character, one is soft, perfect for details and fine lines, and the other firm and wide, made for motion with large, flowing strokes. With each stroke I bring my work to life, in a language of color and rhythm.

Paint rollers are my base builders. They lay down the foundation for vibrant backgrounds with texture, depth, movement. They create calm in the chaos.

Markers are my precision tools. They carve the details sharp and powerful. They give me control when I need it, perfect for applying details.

My art lives in this mix. A fusion of tools, colors, energy. It's how I stretch the boundaries between graffiti and gallery, between the street and the soul. This is how I bring my dream to life.

Taking street art beyond the wall and into the heartbeat of homes, spaces, and lives.

The Studio

My studio is where it all begins, a blank canvas, the pulse of an idea, a color combination. This is where I paint on canvas, but also where I shape mural concepts for spaces that need more than just decoration, they need identity.

Each project pulls something different from me. It's that variation that keeps my work alive. When I create murals for businesses or public spaces, it's never just about beauty. It's about energy and meaning. I work closely with my clients to translate their vision into something visual, a statement that can live on their walls, speak to their audience, and move the space.

But this studio is more than just a workspace. It's also where I pause. Where I breathe. Being an artist means constantly feeling, thinking, producing. But I'm learning to slow down. To protect the stillness that lets inspiration return.

A Day In The Studio.

My studio is my second home. The moment I step inside, something shifts. The outside world fades, and suddenly, anything feels possible.

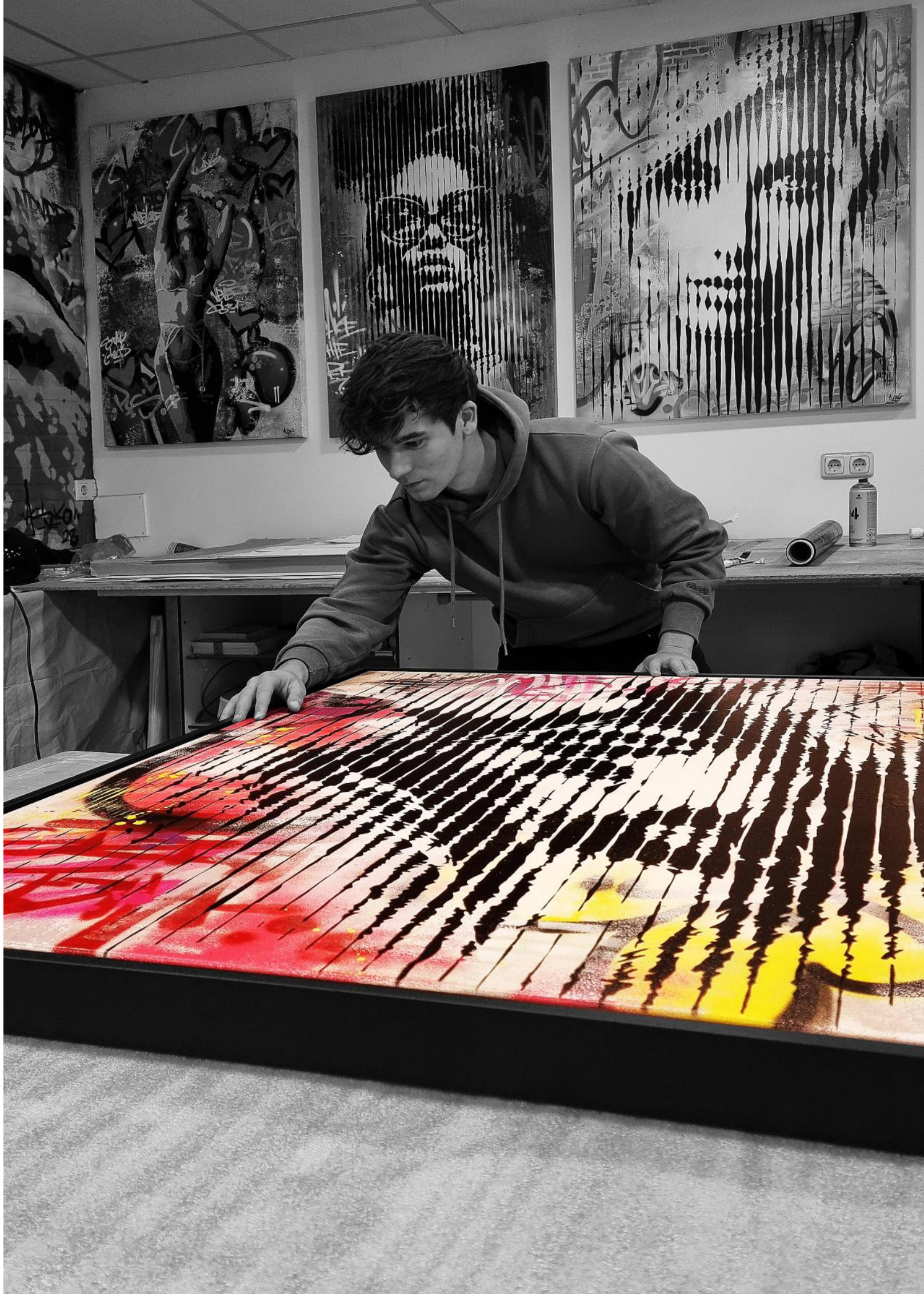
Some days start slow. I throw the doors open if the weather allows and let the light settle in. Some days are pure chaos, canvases, spray cans everywhere, paint- stained hands and a mind that won't sit still. Other days, it's laser focus. Silent. Just me and the piece.

I begin with music, always. What I play depends on the mood. Sometimes soft and low, to fall into flow. Sometimes loud and fast, to push the energy. Some days, I work in silence, balancing color, chasing the texture until it feels right. Other days, I'm in movement. Canvases on the floor. Spray in hand. Time disappears when it flows like that.

In the afternoon, I often step away. I go home, recharge, reset. Distance is part of the process too, it helps me return to the canvas with new breath. Creating isn't just doing. It's feeling. Pausing. Listening.

At the end of the day, I photograph what I made. Not for social media, but for myself. A kind of visual diary. A way to remember what the work felt like before it dries.

Then the music fades. The door closes. And I carry the energy with me, into every wall, every canvas, every piece that leaves my hands. Because every day in the studio is different, each one let me grow. And that growth shows up in my art.
