

On the opposite end, the 400-pound heart of a blue whale has an incredibly slow heart rate, at 10 to 30 beats per minute.

First Multi-Camera TV Sitcom



Everyone's favorite redhead wasn't the ditz that she appeared to be on the "I Love Lucy" sitcom. Lucile Ball and Desi Arnaz (her husband on both the TV show and in real life) were savvy negotiators. They wanted to live in sunny California, but most TV shows at the time were shot in New York. In order to produce "I Love Lucy" at home and keep East Coast advertisers happy, they had to upgrade

the technology used on set. They hired cinematographer Karl Freund to help them figure out how to shoot the comedy as if it were a stage play, using three cameras to capture every angle. Setting up the cinematography this way allowed fast editing and high-quality airings on the East Coast. This multi-cam setup in front of a live studio audience (Desi knew that Lucy shined in front of a crowd) became a tradition replicated on shows such as "The Mary Tyler Moore Show," "Full House," "Friends," "Frasier," and "The Big Bang Theory."
