Liburnia Group Shipped a 33-Tonne Grinding Machine with Full In-House Coordination Across Rijeka and Koper

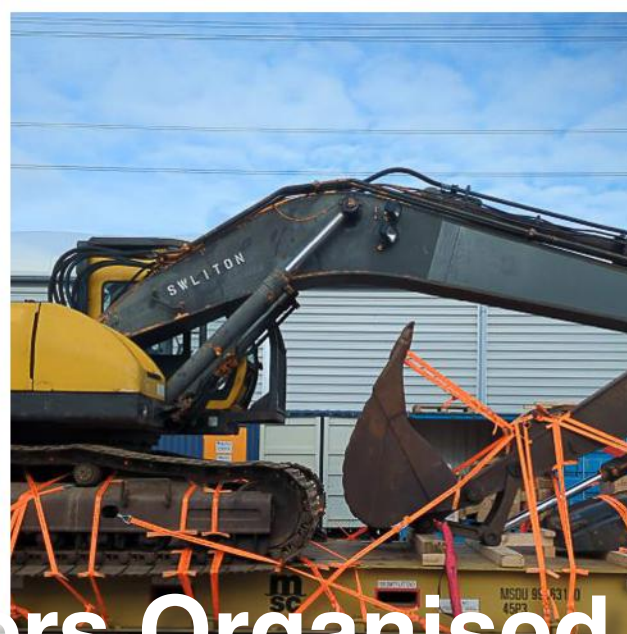

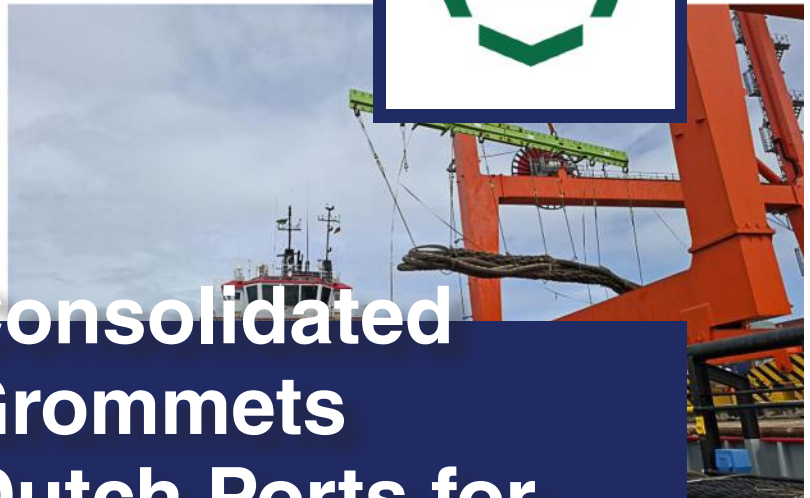
