## SEAFOOD SHOWCASE



The Seafood Showcase is a longtime member favorite and a special way to welcome everyone back to the camaraderie and friendships that define the Club. The tradition began in the early 1990s as a welcome back after the winter closure. While we are now a year round club, with paddle shaping the winter season, the event remains a cherished tradition and a meaningful link between our history and our future. This year's event on Saturday March 14th also marked the first of many celebrations in our centennial year.



A look back...

### 1926: THE BEGINNING

Inverness Golf Club began as a retreat for the Cudahy Packing Company. The natural rolling land and a winding stream created the foundation for a beautiful nine-hole golf course. Local farmers helped build the course using horse-drawn equipment, preserving the natural landscape.

### 1926 – MEADOW GROVE COUNTRY CLUB

The original nine-hole course opened as Meadow Grove Country Club, designed to work with the natural terrain and minimal earth movement.

### 1938 – INVERNESS GOLF CLUB IS BORN

Arthur T. McIntosh purchased Meadow Grove and additional land south of the course. The club was renamed Inverness Golf Club and the course expanded to 18 holes.

Dear Members,

As we move into April, there is a great deal of positive momentum across Inverness Golf Club, and I am pleased to share a few updates.

Our Annual Finance Meeting is scheduled for April 30 at 6:00 pm. I strongly encourage all members to attend. It is an important opportunity to stay informed, hear directly about the Club's financial position, and engage in conversation about our path forward.

From an operating standpoint, February results came in ahead of plan. The Club reported a \$33,000 operating deficit for the month, compared to a budgeted deficit of \$38,000. While there is still a seasonal deficit, the continued improvement reflects disciplined expense management and steady member participation.

Planning for our Centennial Weekend is really starting to come together, and the schedule is taking shape. Friday night will be a family-focused evening with activities for all ages, culminating in fireworks. Saturday night will feature an adult celebration. It is shaping up to be a truly special weekend and a chance for our entire membership to come together and celebrate the Club's history and future. This will be a weekend to remember.

Work on the pool locker room renovation continues on schedule. This project is another major step in the ongoing revitalization of the pool area and will further enhance the member experience as we head into the summer season.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support and engagement. The golf season is right around the corner, and there is a lot to look forward to.

## 2026 SENIOR GOLF LEAGUES

Inverness participates in two competitive golf leagues: Midwest Senior and Interstate Senior Leagues. The two leagues are match play competitions against other clubs in the area. There is a simultaneous team match play (better ball of 2 Inverness players against 2 opposing players) as well as individual match play matches against the same players. All players must have an established USGA handicap.

All participants must be at least 50 years of age at some time during 2026. To play in a match, the fee is \$95 for the Midwest League and \$110 for the Interstate Senior Golf League. The fee for both leagues includes greens fees, cart fee, a buffet breakfast and lunch. If a course requires forecaddies, there is an additional \$20 charge per player plus an optional tip in cash paid to the caddie. Fees will be billed on your monthly Club statement.

There is a shotgun start of either 8:15am or 8:30 am. If you can't commit to specific dates, just submit your personal contact data and indicate you may be available as a sub.

## GROUNDS Brian Mores, Golf Course Superintendent



Throughout last fall's bunker project, the old bunker sand was removed and relocated to the prairie area behind 12 pond. At the conclusion of the project in late November, the material was carefully graded and then dormant seeded with an improved fescue blend to provide a thin, wispy look to the natural area. To further protect the area through the winter months, straw matting was installed to stabilize the soil and prevent erosion.

As temperatures warm this spring, we'll begin actively managing the grow-in process as germination gets underway. While you start to see progress this season, please note that it may take a few seasons for the area to fully mature. The black silt fence currently in place along the pond edge will remain until sufficient root development has occurred to stabilize the soil, at which point it will be removed. The shoreline will then be restored with fescue sod to complete the area.

Spring is coming and we look forward to seeing players out on the course again real soon! To get the latest updates on course conditions, be sure to follow the IGC Grounds Department on Instagram at @igcgrounds. As always, please feel free to contact me with any additional questions you may have.
