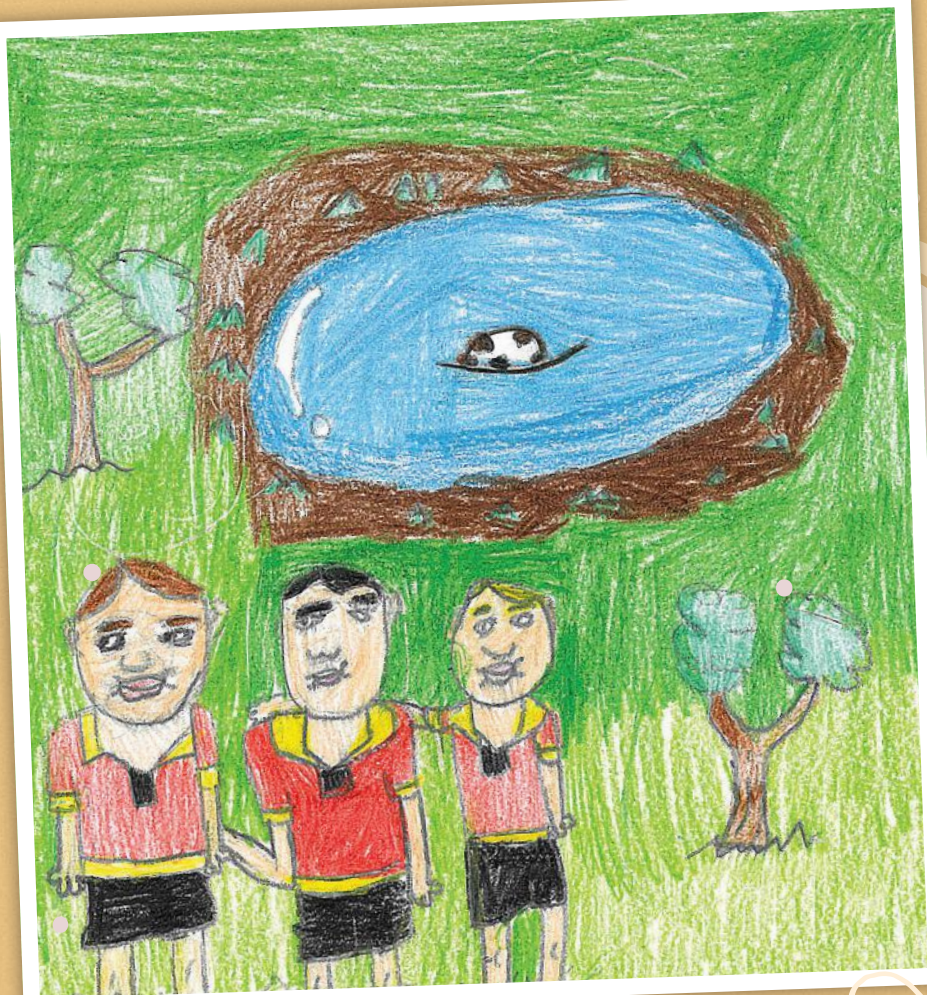


Family – **Mudjin**

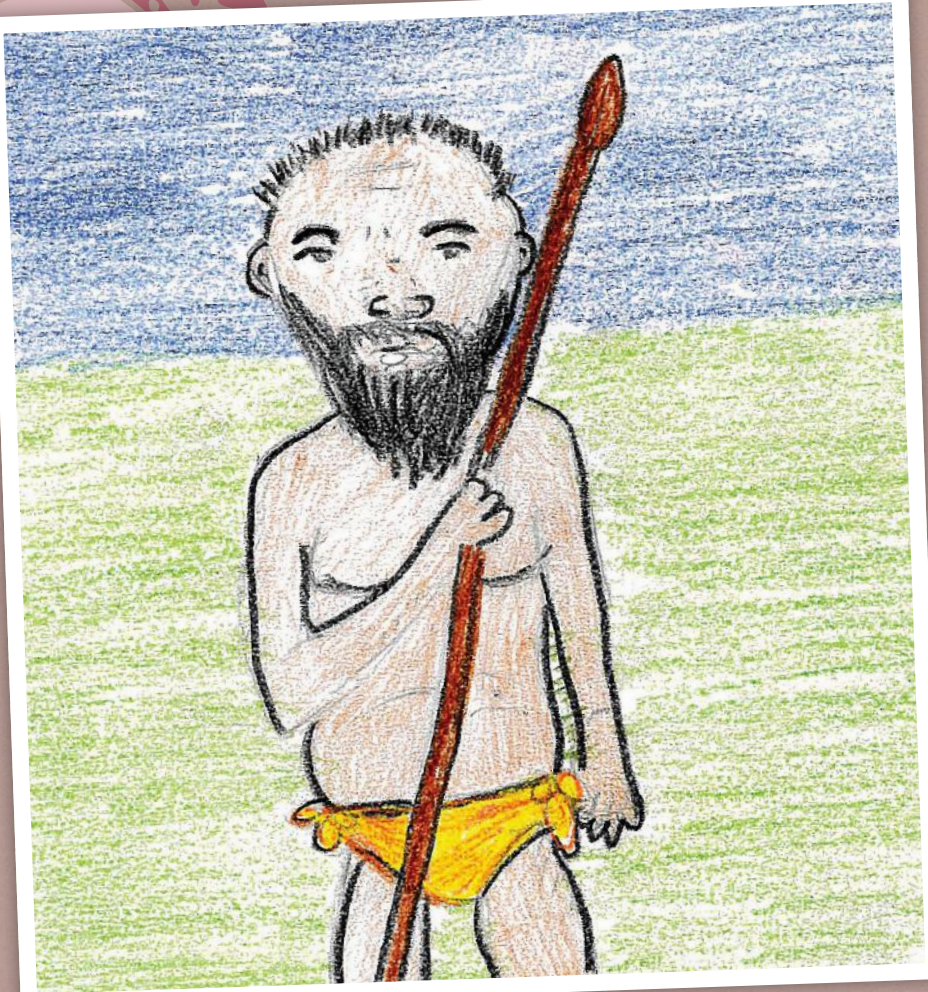




Man – **Dhulay**

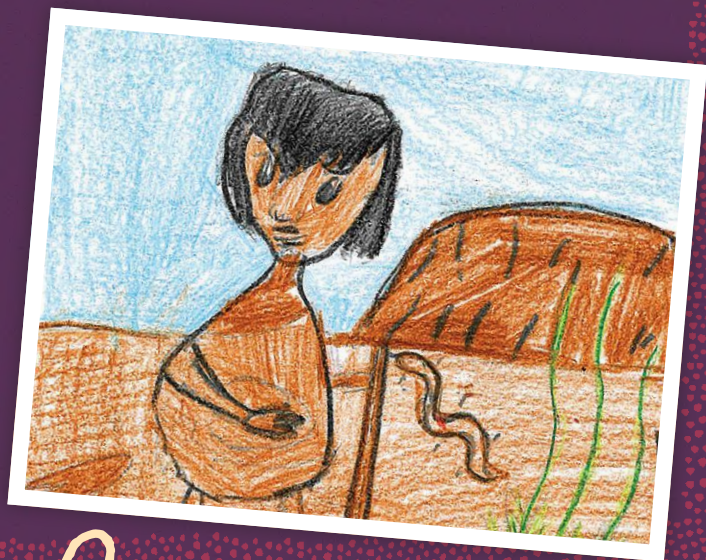


Elder – **Yellamundie**

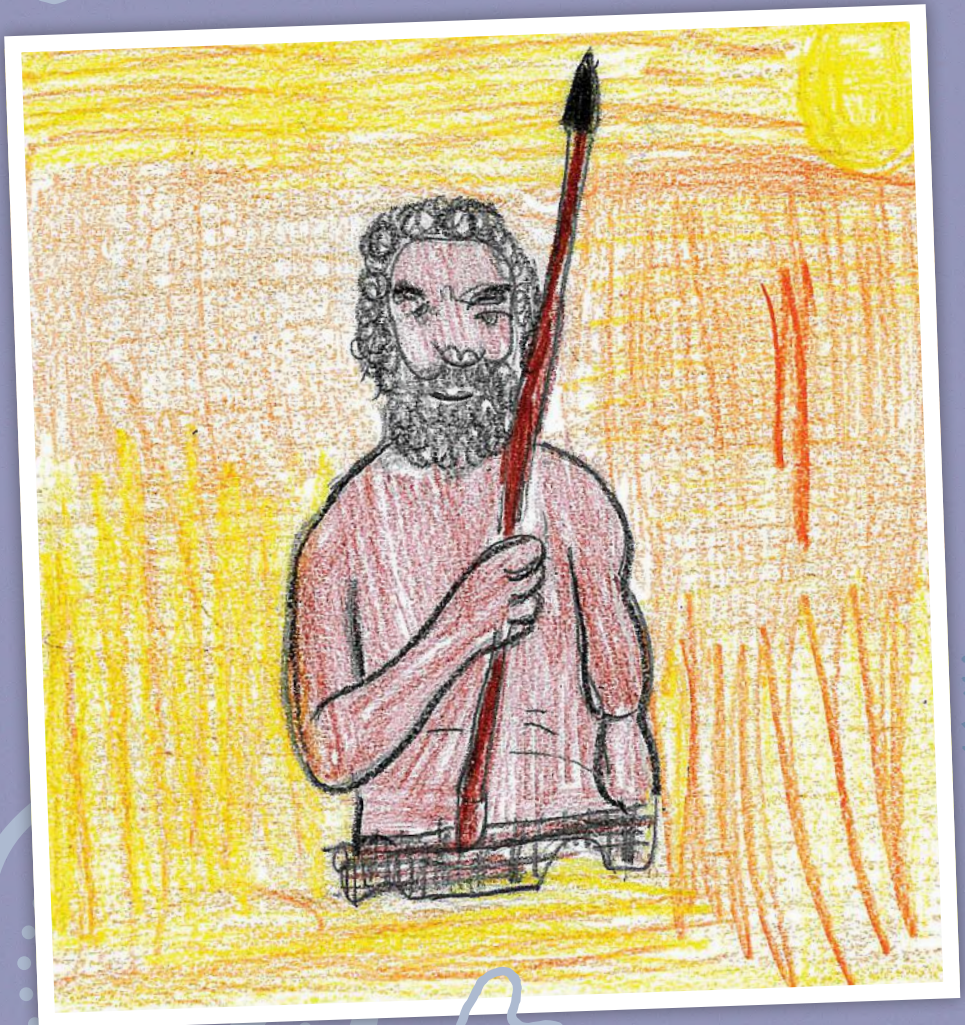
