

# Nilnert Scholarship Terms & Conditions

The Nilnert Scholarship will be offered for the first time in 2025 with the intention of supporting residency fees for a resident demonstrating financial hardship. The donation to The Women's College is an initiative of Elizabeth Gilchrist AM.

This scholarship is established to provide financial assistance to a student in need, ensuring that talented young women have equal access to tertiary education. The scholarship will contribute \$10,000 towards residency fees for one academic year.

The Terms and Conditions of the scholarship are as follows:

## 1. Name and Awarding Body

The scholarship shall be named the "Nilnert Scholarship" and will be awarded by The Women's College based on the recommendation of the Head of College & CEO.

### 2. Eligibility

The scholarship shall be awarded to a resident of The Women's College who is enrolled full-time at The University of Queensland.

The scholarship is awarded to a resident who will make a valuable contribution to the life of the College. This scholarship is awarded on a combination of achievements and proven excellence in the areas of academic merit, sport and/or cultural pursuits, community service, and leadership.

# 3. Financial Need

The scholarship is intended for a resident demonstrating financial need, who might not otherwise have access to The Women's College experience.

#### 4. Residency Requirement

The scholarship shall be awarded to a student whose permanent residence is in a regional or rural area.

# 5. Duration

The scholarship shall be awarded for one academic year. It will lapse if the recipient ceases to be a resident of The Women's College during that year.

### 6. Termination

The scholarship will be terminated if the recipient:

- a) is no longer enrolled full-time at The University of Queensland;
- b) does not maintain satisfactory academic progress;
- c) is no longer a resident of The Women's College.
