



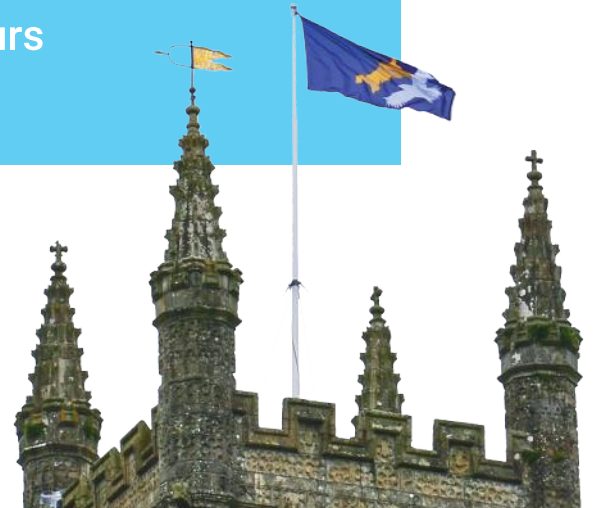

## GOALS

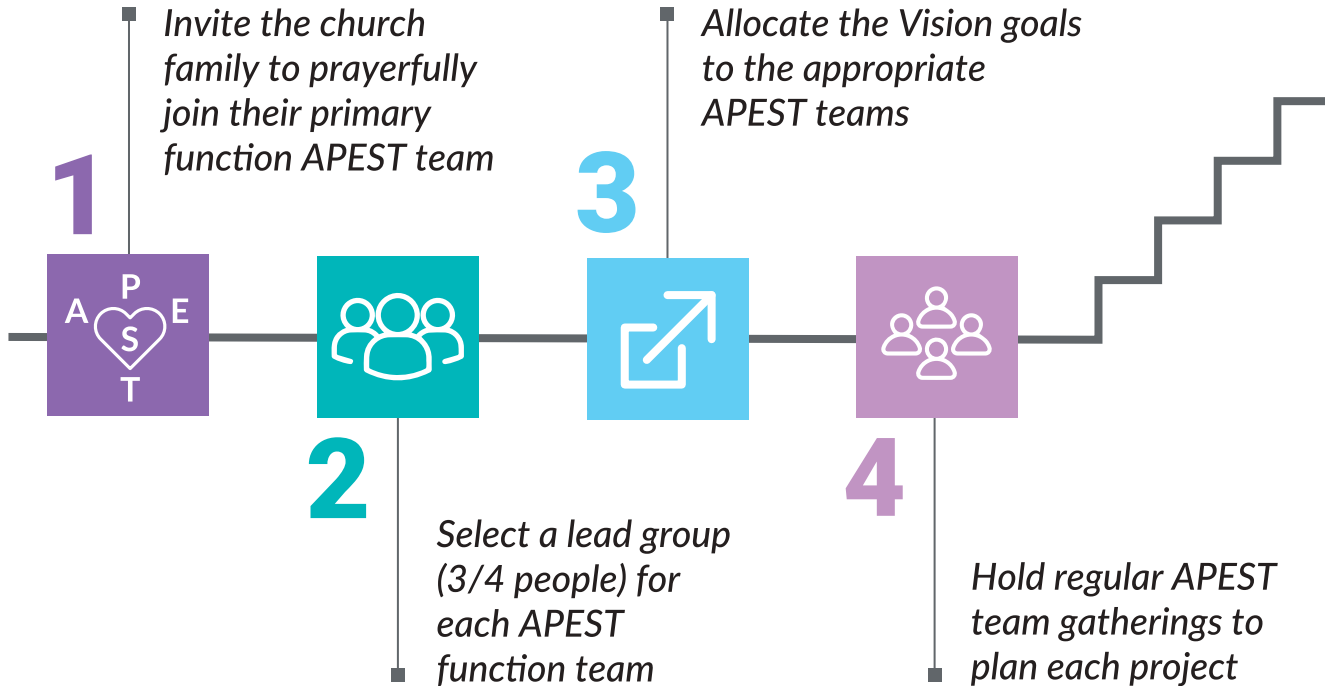
By allocating the goals and
