## Welcome from NMAA Executive Director

While watching the 2019 Women's U.S. Open earlier this school year, I witnessed an outstanding display of sportsmanship by 21-year-old Naomi Osaka, who hugged and consoled her 15-year-old opponent, Cori Gauff, after defeating her in the third round of the event. She hugged her and then went one step further by inviting her to do the post-match interview with her. I turned the channel after witnessing this emotional exchange between the two competitors only to watch story after story about countless individuals preparing to come to the aid of communities caught in the path of Hurricane Dorian.

In our own home state of New Mexico, I have seen signs in yards across our communities that read, "El Paso Strong" and have witnessed young kids throughout the state raising money for those struck by the tragedy that befell our neighbor to the South. It warms my heart to know that so many members of the New Mexico baseball community supported El Paso by volunteering their time and resources to facilitate a baseball clinic in the area. I have seen Boy Scouts and Girls Scouts of New Mexico performing various acts of community service. I recently pulled up to a stop light and saw a young adult handing a homeless person a bag full of toiletries and food. I saw a teenager mowing an elderly person's yard just because

it is the right thing to do. All of these beautiful acts of kindness occurred within a two-day period and those were only the ones I personally saw.

Every day, we witness humanity at its finest. Even though there are times when the negative headlines seem overwhelming, we still see displays of compassion and kindness all around us. We know there is so much goodness in our schools and our communities and we feel our faith restored when these acts hit close to home.

So, it makes me wonder - why do we allow "winning and losing" to become the focal point in athletics? Why does a "win at all costs" attitude seem so prevalent? Why do acts of poor sportsmanship sometimes overshadow all of the good that we know exists in interscholastic athletics? For every one bad event, we know there are hundreds, or even thousands, of great things going on with our student-athletes. Why can't we look past the scoreboard to see and remember the true meaning of sports?

Don't get me wrong. I am the most competitive person there is. Even at my "old" age, I refuse to lose. But, as we get older, we see that there are such bigger and more important things that we gain from competition and that we gain through participation in interscholastic activities. We realize that truly "winning" is not about the score. For educators, it is about teaching our students that they are playing a game and that, at the end of the day, the end result of learning the traits of responsibility, integrity, respect, teamwork, dedication, perseverance and commitment are far more important than a blue trophy.

The importance of interscholastic athletics is really about winning in the game of life. It is about producing citizens who are capable of being compassionate to those in need, who understand that life is bigger than a game and who truly know that true winners are those who care about others and who live a life of being trustworthy, honest and respectful.

There are so many daily lessons that are learned through participating in sports and activities and we see these lessons being lived out around us every day. It goes back to role models in professional sports. It goes back to volunteerism and kindness to communities suffering tragedies and disasters. It goes back to being service-oriented within our communities. It goes back to doing the right thing, even when no one is looking. In the words of football coach, Lou Holtz, "I follow three rules: Do the right thing, do the best you can, and always show people you care." This is the true recipe for being winners in the game of life.

## Legend of the Pool Gordy Westerberg, Clovis High School



The New Mexico Activities Association proudly recognizes Gordy Westerberg as the 2020 U.S. Bank State Swimming & Diving Championships “Legend of the Pool.”

A 1982 graduate of Burnsville High School in Minnesota, Westerberg was an accomplished swimmer. He was a Top-3 Finalist at the Minnesota High School State Championships in the 200 IM and 500 freestyle, holding state records in the 200 IM, the 400 IM and the 1,650 Freestyle. He also holds records at Burnsville High School in the 200 IM and 500 Freestyle. Westerberg was a four-time Minnesota Sullivan Award winner for the top distance swimmer in the state of Minnesota and a three-time Junior National finalist in the 400 IM.

Following high school, Westerberg attended the University of New Mexico on a swimming scholarship and was a four-time Western Athletic Conference Champion in the 400 IM (1983-84-85) and 200 IM (1984). During that time, he was also a four-time NCAA qualifier in the 400 IM for the National Championships while swimming for the Lobos. In 1985, Westerberg was ranked in the Top-100 in the World in the 400 IM and in 1986, he helped UNM win the Western Athletic Conference Team Championship.

After graduation, Westerberg wasted no time jumping into his coaching career. He started coaching in August of 1986 as a fifth year graduate assistant with UNM, under Head Coach Bill Spahn. In 1987, he began coaching in the club world with Lobo Aquatic Club, CASA Swim Team, DUKE, Vipers of Albuquerque Swim Team, and Clovis Swim Club, an organization he still coaches with today. Westerberg’s high school coaching career started at Manzano High School in 1993. Since then, Westerberg has had stints at Rio Grande High School (1994 – 98), during which time the only boy in the school’s history won an individual medal at the NMAA State Championships. He has also coached at West Mesa High School (2006-16) and Clovis High School (2019 to present). In 2018, Westerberg received the NFHS New Mexico Swimming & Diving Coach of the Year Award and in 2019, he received the Co-Coach of the Year Award for District 3, alongside Amanda Byers of Hobbs High School.

Westerberg has been in the classroom as a math teacher since 1992. He started his teaching career at Jefferson Middle School in Albuquerque (1992) before moving to La Cueva High School in 1993. Westerberg spent the next five years at

Rio Grande High School (1994-98), then two years at Albuquerque High School (1999-00). From 2001 to 2005, Westerberg taught at Southwest Secondary Charter School before moving to West Mesa High School, where he spent 13 years (2006-18). In 2018, he received the "Teacher of the Year" Award from the WMHS teaching staff. In 2019, Westerberg moved to Clovis High School, where he currently teaches math and coaches the Wildcats' Swimming and Diving teams.

## **UP CLOSE AND PERSONAL WITH GORDY WESTERBERG**

### ***What has been your greatest moment as a swimming coach?***

"45" - the number of swimmers I have worked with who have gone on and swum collegiately. Swimming in college was an incredible experience for me and the impact that it has on my former athletes is something that I will always cherish! Every time I have a swimmer who moves on to swim collegiately is the "Greatest" moment for me as a coach. EVERY SINGLE ATHLETE who is swimming an individual event at the NMAA State Championships has the ability to move on and swim at the collegiate level. There is a team for EVERYONE at the various collegiate levels."

### ***What accomplishment in life are you most proud of?***

"My family! I have a GORGEOUS wife who loves me unconditionally and I have two kids I am incredibly proud of: Michael (La Cueva '16) is graduating from William Jewell College (Liberty, MO) this May and swam all four years while he was there; and Amber (Clovis '20) who is off to Morningside College (Sioux City, IA), where she will continue her swimming career."



### ***What is your definition of a winner?***

"This is the EASIEST question on this list! A winner is someone who relentlessly pursues their goals...they don't quit when they fall short of it either."

### ***What do you most want to say to high school student-athletes?***

"People who are successful are the ones who strive for EXCELLENCE in all areas of their life...just showing up isn't pursuing excellence, it's just the starting line. The term is 'Student-Athlete' means they are both...many kids separate the two as Student OR Athlete. Swimmers at the collegiate level are both. Most programs across the nation take an extreme amount of pride in their team GPAs. That is one thing that I would LOVE to see NMAA take on, an award for T10 highest team GPAs in the State!"

### ***If you could do it all over again, what would you do differently?***

"I would have started my teaching career five years earlier than I did. I think that teaching and coaching are very complementary jobs and they benefit each other tremendously."

### ***What advice would you have for young swimming coaches just starting their career?***

"First, you have to STUDY every aspect of this sport. This sport is completely different than land sports! You have to go to clinics...I am shocked at how few coaches in NM actually attend coaching clinics. Every year athletes are changing; their parents are changing...clinics are a way to ask questions of other coaches, from around the country, who might be going through the same issues as you are, and they can give you ideas on how best to deal with it. Second, always look for ways to improve the sport on the statewide level. Think of ways that can make meets better, whether it is a regular meet, District Meet, Metro Championship, or even the NMAA State Championship. Share your ideas with coaches who have been around...always ask, 'How could this be improved?'"

### ***All successful people have been inspired to do what they do. What and/or whom have been the inspirational forces behind your success?***

"Without question, it would be my HS/Club Coach – Dennis Dale. After I graduated from HS, he went on to become the Head Coach at the University of Minnesota for over 20 years and then went to his rival, Indiana University, and revived their Sprint program to National Prominence. After all of these years, I still keep in contact with him."

# 2019 State Championship Recap

## LA CUEVA WINS FIRST SWIMMING TITLE IN 24 YEARS



*La Cueva Boys, 2019 State Champions*

The 2019 U.S. Bank State Swimming Championships were not decided until the very last race of the day. The La Cueva boys clinched the blue trophy with 280 points, following their performance in the 400-yard freestyle relay. The Bears posted the second-best time in the event at 3:12.18, just behind Cibola (3:11.85). Los Alamos finished second with 276 points and Albuquerque Academy took third with 272.5. This was La Cueva's first swimming championship since 1996. Santa Fe Prep claimed the boys' team A-3A title.

One state record was broken and another swimmer tied a state mark in the finals. La Cueva senior Jack Hoagland set a new record in the 200-yard individual medley. The Notre Dame-bound standout swam the event in a time of 1:48.01, a mere 0.03 seconds off the mark set by Cibola's Josh Harlan the season before. Hoagland also helped his team total by winning the 500-yard freestyle race in a time of 4:37.92.

Cibola's Keelan Hart tied the state record in the 100-yard Freestyle event. Hart touched the wall in a time of 44.72 seconds, matching Cibola's John Holler from 2015. Hart also won the 50-yard Freestyle event in a time of 20.68. The Cibola senior was also a part of the Cougars' winning team in the 200-yard Freestyle Relay. Aidan Gallegos, Ryan Cor-dray and Keelan's younger brother, Jamin, clocked a winning time of 1:27.81.

The day started with the Cleveland boys winning the 200-yard Medley Relay. The team of Eli Meyer, Kendall Southwell, Cam-ron Pazand and Brady Peters posted a time of 1:35.58, just edging out the La Cueva boys.

Sandia senior Josph Cecco won the 200-yard freestyle event in a time of 1:42.39. His teammate Max Hawton took first in the 100-yard backstroke in a time of 49.57. First place in the boys' 100-yard Butterfly went to Eldorado sophomore Darien O'Donnell, with a time of 49.42. Albuquerque High's Pierce Holler won the 100-yard breaststroke with a time of 56.56.

The boys 1-meter diving title went to Eldorado's Isaac Newman. The junior scored 567.60 points, coming up a little short on his attempt at the state record. Newman did, however, break his own pool record from the previous season by more than 10 points.

# 2019 State Championship Recap

## CHARGERS HOIST BLUE TROPHY FOR THE THIRD STRAIGHT YEAR

For the third year in a row, the Albuquerque Academy girls' swim team captured the U.S. Bank State Swimming Championships. Depth was the name of the game once again for the Chargers. Academy finished with 383 points. La Cueva was second with 314 and Clovis third with 225. Santa Fe Prep claimed the small school's blue trophy.

Academy's young roster was led by Allison Bernier. The super sophomore claimed her first victory of the day in the 200-yard individual medley, winning the event in a time of 2:05.61. Bernier also claimed another individual title in the 500-yard freestyle, touching the wall in a time of 4:59.30. Bernier was also a part of Academy's first place finish in the 200-yard freestyle relay, along with Sofia Taylor, Sowang Kundeling and Kaci Jarry (1:38.93).

Despite their second-place team finish, a couple of La Cueva seniors produced some winning moments. Chrysten Pacheco won the 200-yard freestyle (1:52.09) and the 100-yard butterfly (56.11). Her teammate Natalie Jones won individual titles in both the 50-yard freestyle (23.71) and 100-yard freestyle (52.46). The La Cueva team of Emma Long, Jones, Pacheco and Hannah Meek won the girls' 200-yard medley relay in a time of 1:47.79. Long, Pacheco and Jones also joined Hannah Grenemyer on La Cueva's winning 400-yard freestyle relay team (3:31.78).

Sandia's Fiona Trotz-Chavez won the 100-yard backstroke in a time of 57.90. The 100-yard breaststroke title went to Grace Gehlert of Eldorado (1:05.07).

The girls' 1-meter diving title went to Albuquerque High's Jessica Albanna, with a score of 469.05, edging out her teammate Nadine Coulie by less than 17 points.
