PROOF 101

Getting caught up in the excitement of creating your art and craft website is easy, but if you do not take the time to protect your work, you could lose it all.

Here are some steps you can take to ensure that your site and its contents are protected:

1. Use an AI writing tool to Copywrite your website. The Ai writing tool will store your work in a database archive of other AI writing software databases. Therefore, if someone else tries to Copywrite your creations as their own, they will not be able to because you have already copywritten them. You can then use an online plagiarism checker to scan billions of websites and find your work. Check out our Ai writing tool category. 365 Has a Built-in Plagerizer Checker that will store your written content with date, time, and website URL.
2. Screenshot all your work and send it to yourself via email for safe keeping until it is ready for public release on the internet.
3. Send the screenshots of your website images to all major search engines so they can tag them with the keywords associated with your brand name. This will help people find you more quickly when looking for something similar on Google or Bing (or however else they search).
4. If you are an artist or craftsperson, you might have created a digital copy of your work. Protecting your art from theft and plagiarism is essential by registering it with the Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DCMA), which supplies legal protection for your creative content.

You will Need Proof

Make sure you have Proof by taking screenshots of Your plagiarized content and the URL location; you will need this when you file a complaint with [www. copyright .gov](http://www.copyright.gov) office Claims Board. First, you must send a take-down notice to Your Plagerizers (This is where DMCA take-down service comes in handy). What if they refuse to comply with the request? You may qualify for a 30.000 Reward.
