


Life at Barmoor

In addition to your annual site fees, we advise owners to budget approximately £1,000 for gas, electricity and insurance.

Things to do In & Around the Area



Ford and Etal




FAQs

Where is Barmoor Castle located?

Barmoor Castle is situated in the beautiful Northumberland countryside, providing easy access to local attractions and natural beauty. You can find us on your sat nav or maps using the postcode TD15 2TR.

What types of holiday homes are available for ownership?

We offer a variety of holiday home styles and sizes to suit different preferences and budgets. From comfortable 35 x 12 foot options - around the size of a studio apartment - up to our grandest 50 x 22 foot holiday homes. Contact us and we can recommend something that fits best for you and your family.

What does holiday home ownership include?

Ownership includes the holiday home itself, access to the Barmoor Castle estate grounds and a long-term lease for the plot on which the holiday home is situated.

How long is the pitch licence for?

Our pitch license runs 20 years for caravans and 30 years for twin-unit lodges: giving you safety and security to enjoy your holiday home for decades to come.

How much is the pitch fee and what does it cover?

Our site fees start from just £4310 for the 11-month holiday season. The fees include water, non-domestic rates, refuse collection, ground maintenance and access to some amazing owner-exclusive events.

Is the first year's fee included in the sale price?

We always strive to make your ownership journey as easy as possible, therefore we always include the site fees for the remainder of the season, pro-rata.

Are electricity and water included and how are they billed?

Your water is included in your site fees. Electricity is charged once every year, in October.

Are there any other fees or charges? If so, what are they for and when do they have to be paid?

Based on normal usage, running costs for your holiday home will be in the region of £1,000 per year. This includes gas, electricity and insurance. On top of this, you may also choose to take-up optional services, such as the superfast Wi-Fi available on-park or regular window cleaning.

When can you use the holiday caravan?

Our holiday season runs from 9th February until 9th January every year.

Can I permanently live in my holiday caravan/holiday home?

No, as the holiday caravan/holiday home is for holiday and recreational use only. You must provide us with a permanent residential address where you live when not using your holiday caravan/holiday home for a holiday or recreational break.



How much does it cost to run the holiday caravan per-year?

We advise owners to budget the approximate amount below:

- Pitch fees: from £4310 per year
- Water: included in site fees
- Insurance, electricity and gas (LPG): £1,000 per year

Do you have to pay council tax?

No, as this is a holiday caravan - not a permanent place of residence. Your pitch fee or rates will cover all “domestic” costs.

Can I sell my holiday home in the future?

Yes, holiday home owners have the option to sell their holiday homes. The on-site management team can assist with resale processes.

Can I rent out my holiday home when I'm not using it?

We do not permit holiday home rental at Barmoor Castle. This is to ensure our park stays the tranquil community that people adore.

Are there any community rules or regulations?

To ensure a peaceful and enjoyable environment, all owners must adhere to community guidelines, which include noise restrictions and pet policies.

Are pets allowed?

Yes! We are not just pet-tolerable, we are very much pet-friendly. For example, we have built a dog walk all the way around the park for our estate owners.

Is Barmoor Castle a family-friendly environment?

Absolutely, Barmoor Castle welcomes families and offers a safe, engaging environment with activities for all ages.

Can I tour the holiday homes before purchasing?

Yes, we offer guided tours of available holiday homes and the estate to help you make an informed decision.

Are there open house events?

We host open house events periodically, where potential buyers can explore the holiday homes and meet current owners.

How can I arrange a visit or request more information?


