BACKGROUND

CHURCH OF GOD OF PROPHECY

The Church of God of Prophecy (COGOP) in Western Canada is part of a global Pentecostal movement rooted in the Holiness tradition. Its origins trace back to 1886 in Tennessee, where Richard Spurling and his son, R.G. Spurling, established the Christian Union to restore New Testament Christianity, emphasizing the Bible as the sole authority for faith and practice. This movement evolved through the Holiness Church at Camp Creek in 1902 and was formally organized as the Church of God in 1903 under the leadership of A.J. Tomlinson. In 1952, following legal proceedings, the name "of Prophecy" was added to distinguish it from other groups with similar names.

COGOP Western Canada upholds the denomination's commitment to the Bible as God's inspired, inerrant Word and bases its beliefs on "the whole Bible rightly divided." The church affirms core Christian doctrines, including the Trinity, the deity and virgin birth of Christ, His atoning death and resurrection, and the essential work of the Holy Spirit in salvation and sanctification.





BACKGROUND

It emphasizes the present, active ministry of the Holy Spirit, guiding the Church and empowering believers to live godly lives and serve others effectively. The church is also committed to the sanctity of marriage and the importance of strong, loving Christian families.

The leadership of COGOP Western Canada endorses five core values that guide its mission: prayer, harvest, leadership development, biblical stewardship, and service. These values reflect the church's dedication to glorifying God by equipping pastors, ministers, and members through leadership development and actively participating in God's mission to bring redemption to His creation.

Today, the Church of God of Prophecy is a vibrant, worldwide body of believers, united in worship and working together to share God's love and a message of hope to the brokenhearted. With over one-and-a-half million members worshiping in more than 10,000 churches or missions across 135 nations, nearly 90% of its global membership is outside of North America.

COGOP Western Canada continues to embody this global mission, fostering spiritual growth and community engagement across the region.

EMBLEMS OF THE CHURCH *of* GOD *of* PROPHECY

THE CHURCH FLAG



The Church of God of Prophecy flag, introduced in 1933, symbolizes Christ and the church's mission. Its colors—red (His blood – Hebrews 9:22), white (holiness – Isaiah 1:18), blue (truth – John 17:17), and purple (royalty – Revelation 19:16)—reflect key aspects of Jesus' character. The central symbols—a scepter (Hebrews 1:8), star (Matthew 2:2), and crown (James 1:12)—represent His authority, guidance, and kingship. The open design reflects the church's call to be the “pillar and ground of the truth” (1 Timothy 3:15).

THE CHURCH LOGO



The Church of God of Prophecy logo serves as the church's modern visual identity, used across digital, print, and promotional materials to reflect its global mission and core beliefs. Featuring a globe and cross at the center, it symbolizes the centrality of Christ and the church's commitment to reaching the world. Surrounding it are a scepter (representing God's authority – Hebrews 1:8), a star (guidance to Christ – Matthew 2:2), and a crown (Christ's kingship – James 1:12), all encircled by flames representing the Holy Spirit. While the logo is widely used for branding and communication, it does not replace the official church flag, which remains significant for ceremonial and doctrinal representation.

FLAG PROTOCOL

The Church of God of Prophecy flag is a sacred symbol of the church's doctrine and mission and should be treated with reverence. It is typically displayed to the right of the pulpit or speaker during services and official events. If displayed with two flags, it should be at the center and highest point. When displayed with more than two flags, it should be placed in the position of prominence, often to the far right (from the audience's perspective). The flag should never touch the ground, be used as decoration, or left unattended. When not in use, it must be respectfully removed and stored in a clean, secure place.

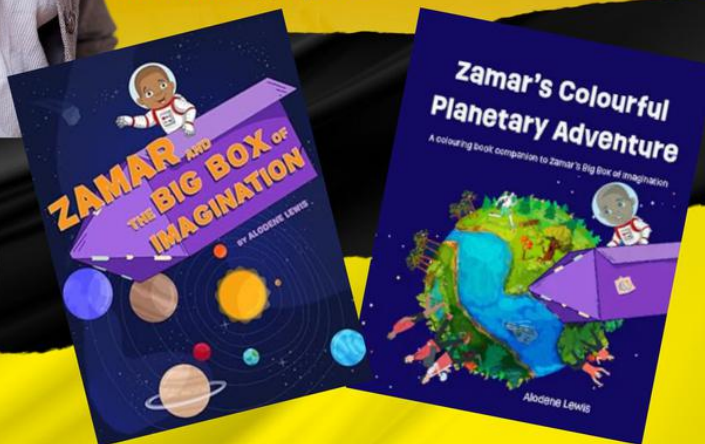
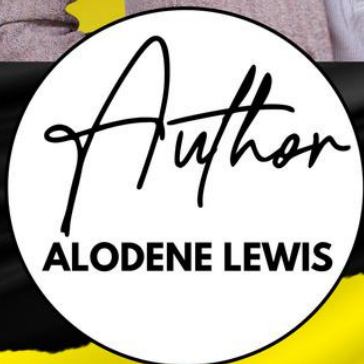
