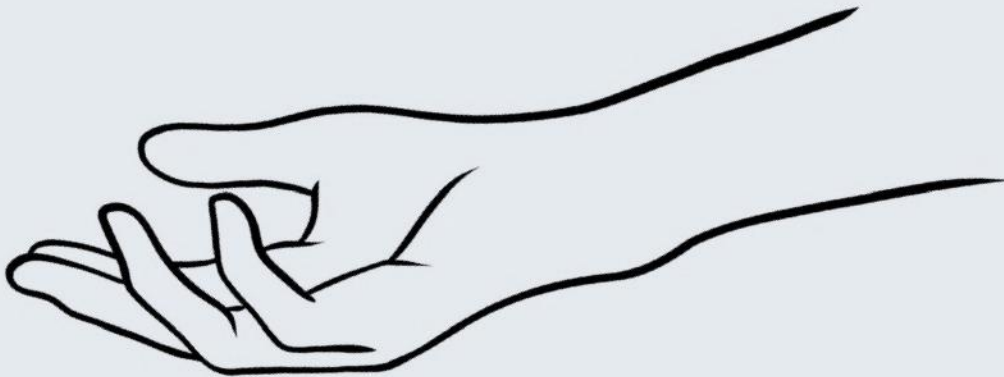
COME TO ME

in Prayer. Moved to Action

GLOBAL YOUTH DAY & YOUTH WEEK OF PRAYER

March 2026 was a spiritually uplifting time for the youth of the Maritime Conference, beginning with *Global Youth Day (GYD)* and continuing into *Youth Week of Prayer*.

This year's GYD theme, "*Communion in Action*," was centered on Acts 4:31, reminding us that when we come together in prayer and truly seek God, He fills us with His Spirit and gives us boldness to live out our faith in real and practical ways.

At the *Halifax SDA Church*, we (the youth) took over the church service. Three youth shared sermonettes, and the *Halifax AY Choir* had their first performance. Building on the example of the early church, we held an extended Sabbath School, which saw a fantastic turnout, especially in the youth class, where over 28 young people, ages 13–35, came together to discuss the lesson. That afternoon, we prepared and delivered care packages to the local *Salvation Army* men's shelter. Along with notes of encouragement, the packages included socks, underwear, and other essentials. It was a simple, meaningful way to be the hands and feet of Jesus and serve our community.

Global Youth Day was a strong kickoff to *Youth Week of Prayer (WOP)*. For the first time, it was held Conference-wide, bringing

together youth across the Maritimes through virtual meetings. Though we were physically apart, there was a shared sense of purpose as we gathered together.

Each evening included music, testimonies, and messages that spoke to real-life experiences of young people today. These were followed by small group discussions that provided a space for conversation, support, and prayer. Throughout the week, we explored what it looks like to put our faith into action in everyday life, whether that meant navigating social media in a Christ-centered way, staying grounded among the challenges of school, work, and relationships, or letting our lives reflect the example Paul calls us to in 1 Timothy 4:12.



Two of the *Youth WOP* evenings were held in person and virtually: one at the *Moncton SDA Church*, and the final evening at the *Halifax SDA Church*, where youth from surrounding churches joined with those online. During the discussion part of the program, the words



of wisdom shared from both youth and those young at heart created a meaningful opportunity for intergenerational connection and encouragement. After the program, hot drinks were served as we continued to talk, connect, and commune together. It was a great end to an amazing week.



The abundance of talents on display throughout the week was really inspiring, highlighting the gifts God has blessed the young people of our Conference with and the willingness to step up and serve. It was a reminder that God is already moving in mighty ways among our youth, and that as we continue to step forward in faith, He will keep growing and strengthening our impact beyond what we can imagine.

PASTOR BRAD THORP ANNOUNCES RETIREMENT FROM BRITISH COLUMBIA CONFERENCE PRESIDENCY

The *British Columbia Conference of the Seventh-day Adventist Church* announces that Pastor Brad Thorp will retire from his role as President, effective April 30, due to health-related reasons. After a courageous twelve-year journey with cancer, recent developments in his condition now require his full attention toward treatment.

During his tenure as President, Pastor Thorp has emphasized mission, collaboration, and equipping members to share hope within their communities. His leadership has helped guide the Conference

through significant seasons of growth and transition, including the successful development and relocation from the former conference office into a newly established headquarters, creating a modern, mission-focused space to support ministry across British Columbia and the Yukon.

Pastor Thorp also played a key role in advancing province-wide evangelistic initiatives, including the *Pentecost 2025* movement in British Columbia, which has encouraged churches and members to engage in intentional outreach and renewed focus on sharing the message of hope in their local communities.

The *British Columbia Conference* expresses deep appreciation for his dedicated leadership and lasting impact in British Columbia.

Pastor Thorp has also shared his gratitude for the support of members, colleagues, and ministry partners. He and his wife, Kandus, have especially valued time spent visiting churches and connecting with members across the province.

While stepping away from conference leadership after fifty-four years of service, Pastor Thorp plans to remain active in ministry and is preparing to serve as a speaker for *Discover Hope*, a nationwide evangelistic initiative in partnership with *Hope Channel Canada*, scheduled for November 6–14.

Pastor Thorp requests continued prayer as he focuses on his health and expresses confidence in God's leading for the future of the British Columbia Conference.

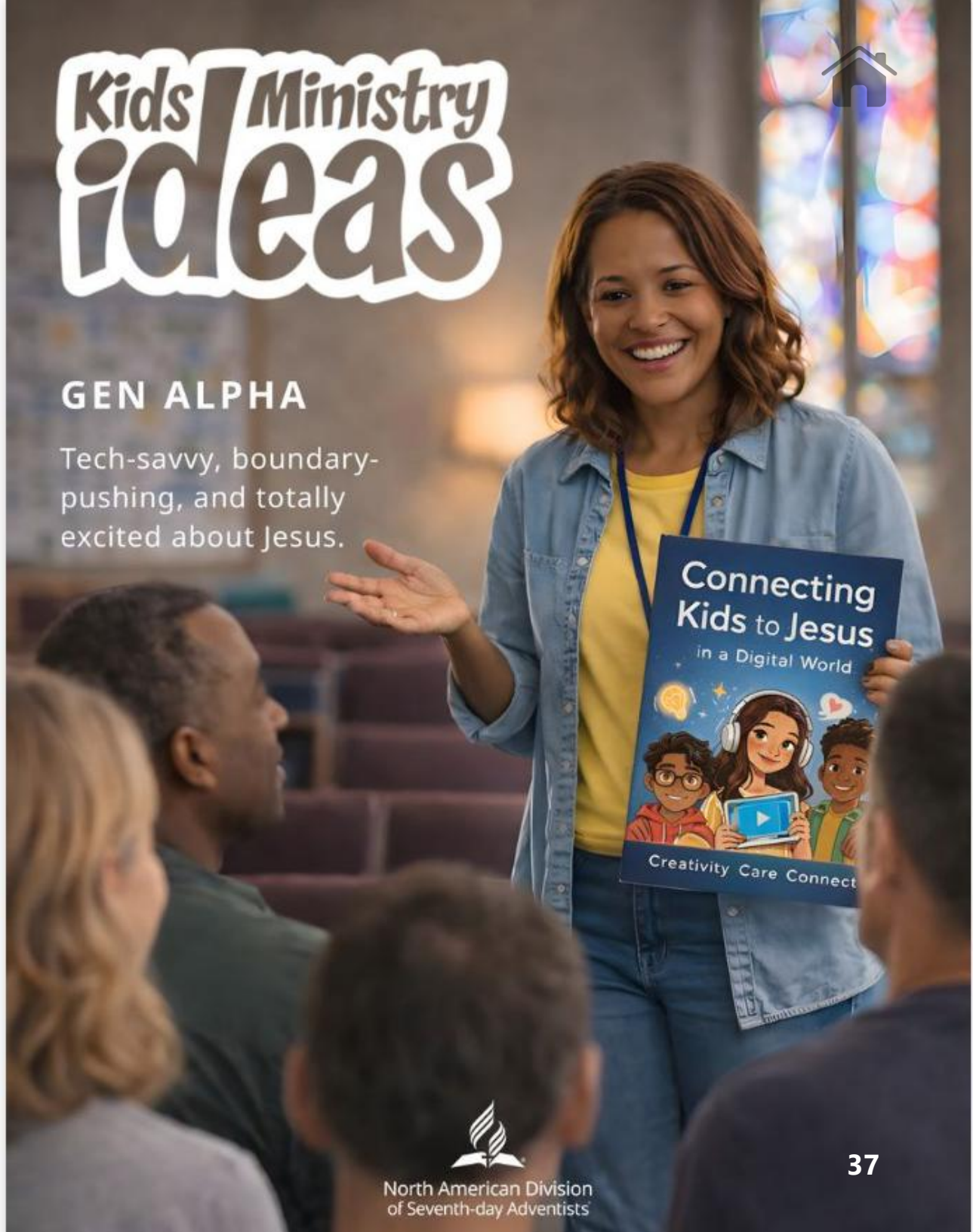

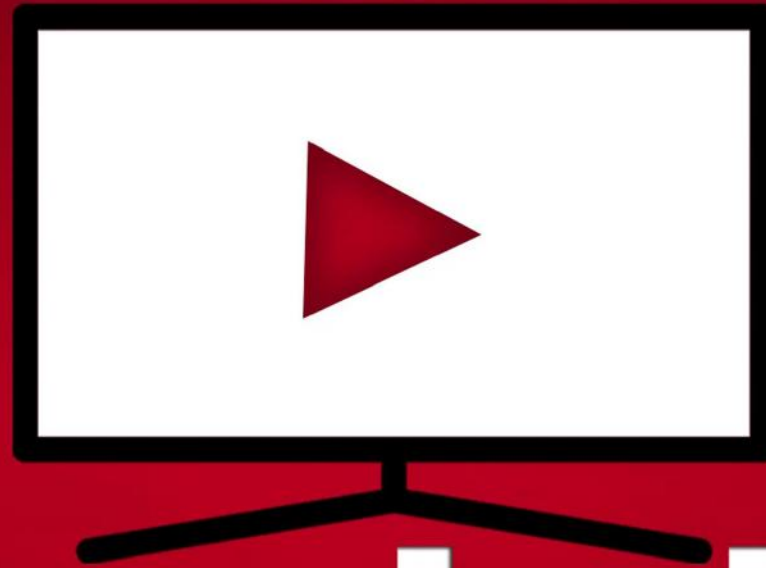

GOD'S CARETAKERS

IT'S MORE THAN JUST MONEY

We hear the word *stewardship* so often in church that it can start to sound like a familiar song we remember from our childhood. Simply put, a *steward* is a *manager*. Scripture repeatedly reminds us that everything belongs to God, and therefore, we are not *owners* but *managers* of what He has placed in our hands. That includes our money, our time, our talents, and even our children. (Psalms 24, 1 Corinthians 4:2)

Now, I know money is usually the first thing that comes to mind when *stewardship* is mentioned. We are encouraged to “dig deep” and “bless the work of the Lord,” often drizzled with the reminder that “God loves a cheerful giver.” I do not argue with that one bit! I’m simply saying *stewardship* is bigger, wider, and richer than the offering plate. After all, church bills do not get paid with ‘amens’ and ‘hallelujahs’. They require money. And yes, it is better to give than to receive. But *stewardship* cannot stop at the offering plate.



Many churches have been strengthened not only by financial giving, but by those who gave their time, skill, and energy. You may not have much money, but you do have time. Manage it well and give some of it to the Lord's work. Visit the sick. Volunteer at a shelter. Lead out in your community. Help the church connect with people so they can connect with our Lord and King. Sometimes you hear all that one person accomplishes in a day and wonder, *how do they do so much in 24 hours?* It's not that they have more time; it's that they are better *stewards* of it. And the same is true financially, someone with a small income may save faithfully, while someone else with a six-figure salary barely stretches their dollar to the next pay cycle. Maybe it's not the amount, but the *stewardship*.

Some things do not require a cheque; they require a *willing heart* and *two available hands*. And maybe then, the church might not have to spend as much trying to cover all of its needs. And let me add this: being on the church payroll does not automatically make someone a *steward* of time. Doing your job is important, but *stewardship* goes beyond one's paid responsibility. It means intentionally giving your time to God's work beyond what is required.

The same is true for talent. Talent is not limited to singing, though I would gladly borrow a musically gifted voice if it were possible. Talent can be painting, teaching, mentoring, cleaning, organizing, or simply showing up consistently. Whatever gift God has given, it can be managed for His glory. Even children are part of our *stewardship*. We are entrusted to guide them toward Christ and teach them to be good *stewards* of their possessions, time, and abilities.

Stewardship is not a church budget issue; it is a discipleship issue. It is the faithful management of everything God has entrusted to us, for His purpose and His glory. When we steward well, we do more than support the church; we strengthen the body, bless the community, and reflect the character of the God who entrusted us with the gift in the first place.

A Steward's Prayer

Jesus, all I possess is Yours. Guide me to manage it with wisdom, generosity, and integrity. Train me to be faithful with the little and the much. Make me a cheerful giver, a diligent planner, and a servant leader in all that You entrust to me. May my stewardship reflect Your glory, not my gain. Amen.

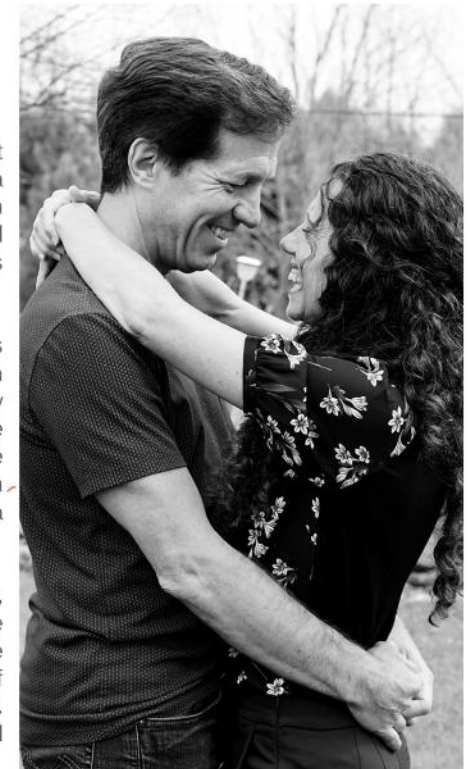
