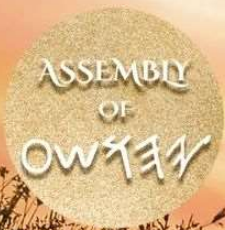
THE 10 COMMANDMENTS

Deuteronomy 6:4 (NKJV)*

⁴ "Hear, O Israel: **יהוה** our God, **יהוה** is one!

Exodus 20:1-3 (NIV)*

¹ And God spoke all these words: ² "I am **יהוה** your **God**, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. ³ "**You shall have no other gods before me.**

Psalm 95:6-7 (TEV)*

⁶ Come, let us **bow down** and worship him; let us **kneel before אֱלֹהֵינוּ**, our **Maker!** ⁷ He is our God; we are the people he cares for, the flock for which he provides. **Listen today** to what he says:

Isaiah 64:8 (NIV)

⁸ Yet, O אֱלֹהֵינוּ, you are our
**Father. We are the clay, you are
the potter; we are all the work
of your hand.**

Proverbs 3:5-7 (NLT2)

⁵ Trust in **אֱלֹהִים** with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. ⁶ **Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.** ⁷ Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, **fear אֱלֹהִים and turn away from evil.**

Matthew 6:31-33 (NKJV)

³¹ Therefore **do not worry**, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' ³² For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your **heavenly Father** knows that you need all these things. ³³ But **seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.**

Romans 3:10-18 (NIV)

¹⁰ As it is written: "There is **no one righteous, not even one;**
¹¹ there is no one who understands, **no one who seeks God.**
¹² All have turned away, they have together become worthless;
there is **no one who does good, not even one.**" ¹³ "Their
throats are open graves; their tongues **practice deceit.**" "The
poison of vipers is on their lips." ¹⁴ "**Their mouths are full of**
cursing and bitterness." ¹⁵ "Their feet are swift to **shed**
blood; ¹⁶ ruin and misery mark their ways, ¹⁷ and **the way of**
peace they do not know." ¹⁸ "**There is no fear of God** before
their eyes."

Psalm 111:10 (NLT2)

¹⁰ Fear of $\aleph\aleph\aleph\aleph$ is the foundation of true wisdom. All who obey his **commandments will **grow in wisdom**. Praise him forever!**

Psalm 33:6-9 (NLT2)

⁶ **אָמַר** merely spoke, and the heavens were created. He breathed the word, and all the stars were born. ⁷ He assigned the sea its boundaries and locked the oceans in vast reservoirs. ⁸ Let the whole world fear **אָמַר**, and let everyone stand in awe of him. ⁹ For when he spoke, the world began! It appeared at his command.

1 John 4:9-10, 18 (NLT2)

⁹ God showed **how much he loved us** by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. ¹⁰ This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and **sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.**¹⁸ Such love has no fear, because perfect love expels all fear. **If we are afraid**, it is for fear of punishment, and this shows that **we have not fully experienced his perfect love.**

Psalm 147:10-11 (NLT2)

¹⁰ He takes no pleasure in the strength of a horse or in **human might**. ¹¹ No, **אֱלֹהִים**'s **delight** is in those **who fear him**, those who **put their hope in his unfailing love**.

Psalm 73:23-26 (TEV)

²³ Yet I always stay close to you, and you hold me by the hand. ²⁴ You guide me with your instruction and at the end you will receive me with honor. ²⁵ What else do I have in heaven but you? Since I have you, what else could I want on earth? ²⁶ My mind and my body may grow weak, but God is my strength; he is all I ever need.
