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Head Tumble Coach

Position may include both daytime and evening classes based on program needs.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Plan, organize, and instruct tumbling classes.
- Serve as head instructor, responsible for quality and consistency across all levels.
- Supervise, mentor, and guide coaches and assistant coaches.
- Develop and maintain a structured yet playful environment that encourages participation and skill progression.
- Assist with class scheduling, curriculum development, and program planning for all age groups.
- Set up and maintain equipment.
- Communicate with parents about class expectations and progress.
- Monitor behavior and enforce safety rules.
- Report accidents or issues promptly.

HOW TO APPLY?

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Tumble Coach

The Tumble Coach leads recreational tumbling classes within the Fon du Lac Park District Tumble Program. This position creates a safe, structured, and engaging environment for school-age participants while supporting program goals and supervising assistant instructors. Position may include both daytime and evening classes based on program needs.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Plan and instruct tumbling classes while working collaboratively with the Head Tumble Instructor.
- Serve as lead coach and ensure quality instruction and participant safety.
- Supervise and mentor assistant and substitute instructors.
- Provide spotting, demonstrations, and individualized feedback.
- Communicate with parents regarding participant progress and expectations.
- Assist with equipment setup and teardown.
- Enforce safety and facility rules.

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Assistant Tumble Coach

The Assistant Tumble Coach supports the Head Tumble Instructor and Tumble Coach in teaching classes, assisting with instruction, and helping maintain a safe and engaging environment. Provides support to lead coaches by reinforcing class structure and supervising participants. Position may include both daytime and evening classes based on program needs.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Assist and support lead coaches in leading tumbling classes.
- Help ensure all classes are structured, safe, and engaging.
- Provide small group or individual instruction as needed.
- Encourage a positive and supportive atmosphere.
- Set up and tear down equipment.
- Monitor participant safety.
- Serve as a positive role model, demonstrating enthusiasm, patience, and professionalism.
- Communicate with parents under the direction of lead coaches.
- Report accidents or issues promptly.
