


Crafted in Jalisco, Mexico at 7,200 feet above sea level, this cristalino is well balanced with citric notes, spices like clove, frutal with a vanilla-butter finish. Silky, smooth and of long permanence in the palate with fresh notes in the aftertaste combined with the tertiary notes of wood.



Elegant, balanced and harmonious. Definitely the best expression of Casa Tierra Noble. Very pleasant and soft on the nose. Notes of cooked agave honeys, vanilla, prune, chocolate, toasted almonds, apricot and tobacco in a perfect balance with woody notes. Soft on the palate, balanced and complex. Dark chocolate flavors, nuts, red fruits, and light hints of tobacco and spice.









TEQUILA BLANCO

Multigrain agave | Double fermentation

Very well defined, strong presence of cooked agave, herbal notes, mint and citrus, with a light gleam of anise. Smooth and fresh with a building intensity; notes of raw agave give a long, rich and balnaced finish.

TEQUILA REPOSADO 'CRISTALINO'

Master distiller's blend | Distilled after the cask

An impressive and distinguished product with harmony and balance; a great permanence and smooth sensation in palate; citrus notes, grapefruit and peach. Fresh and light notes of wood, characteristics that distinguish it.



TEQUILA REPOSADO

American oak | Still selection

Rich and complex, pleasant wooden notes, dried fruit, vanilla and a slight touch of chocolate. Notes of prune, toasted almond, vanilla and a light presence of caramel. Rich and balanced.



TEQUILA BLANCO 'TINAJAS IOO'

Fermented in Tinajas de Barro

The Tinaja de Barro is a hand-formed clay vessel, traditionally used for offerings, spiritual storage, and holding sacred waters, herbs, or ashes.



TEQUILA AÑEJO

2-3 years cask | Wood ensemble

Rich and complex; pleasant notes of wood, dried fruit, vanilla and a slight touch of chocolate. Magnificently structured; creamy balance, silky, sweet with subtle touches of dried fruit.

THE DISTILLERY

La Destilería La Estacada is where the agaves end their journey from Altos de Jalisco and Valles to begin a new journey of transformation. Located at 7,200 feet above sea level, the cool forests, clean air and the unique pureness of its wellsprings are bound up in the small batch, craft spirit of Tierra Noble.



CASAMATA BLANCO

Unity, Liberty, and Equality

New from Tierra Noble; based on the belief in the freedom to create, in the sovereignty of their craftmanship, and in the pride of being from Jalisco.

Fermented and distilled at 7,200 feet above sea level. Rested in glass demijohns. Crafted from an ensemble of agaves from valle de Tequila and Los Altos de Jalisco. Gracefully smooth and refreshing on the entry, harmonizing with sweet and fruity layers that mirror the nose. It unfolds with a surprising hint of spice, adding balance, depth, and a refined texture.



PLATINUM EXTRA AÑEJO TEQUILA

QUI Tequila is the world's first platinum extra añejo tequila, made using 100% Blue Agave grown in the highest region of the Los Altos highlands of Jalisco; the spiritual home of tequila.

The heads and tails of each distillation are discarded, using only the heart. It gave rise to "QUI" from the heart of the word te-QUI-la.

Qui Platinum is aged for more than three and a half years in American Whiskey and French Bordeaux barrels. It undergoes a filtration and distillation unlike any other, using a proprietary method, invented by Cellar Master Miguel Cedeño Cruz, to filter, refine, and create award-winning Extra Añejo tequilas with the smoothest finish in the world.



TASTING NOTES

Qui Platinum embodies the beautifully rich flavor, aroma, and character of extra aged tequila, but with an incredibly smooth finish. Notes of vanilla, butterscotch and a hint of oak.















NOBU 2008 RESERVE EXTRA AÑEJO TEQUILA

Nobu Rare is a one-of-a-kind extra añejo tequila created with a blend of Agave harvested in 2007 and 2008 which are aged in traditional American Whiskey Oak Barrels before maturing in steel tanks.

Selected by Chef Nobu for its unparalleled taste and quality, with a sharp focus on aged sipping tequila, QUI is a brand that complements the philosophy and brand of the Nobu collection.

TASTING NOTES

Notes of sweet oak, toasted almond, and maple, which play beautifully on the nose with aromas of wood, tobacco, caramel, and vanilla.

DISTILLERY

The Isle of Harris Distillery began with a simple idea. Over the decades, our island has suffered from a long-term decline in population, our community's numbers having halved over the last fifty years. We believed that a distillery, built for not just years but for generation, can help residents find work, set down roots and build a life in the place they called home.

In 2015, the distillery started life with just 10 people. Today, we're proud to say we employ over 50 permanent staff, a significant number on an island of fewer than 2000 inhabitants.

Isle of Harris Distillers began with their award-winning Isle of Harris Gin, followed by The Hearach, single malt scotch whisky, the second expression of The Hearach: 100% First-Fill Oloroso Cask Matured, and a third, highly limited, expression: The Hearach of Château Biac.



As a catalyst for positive change within our community, we continue to work with purpose, bringing new life to our island and supporting its aspirations to survive and thrive as we move forward together.



A distinctive expression of The Hearach from the Isle of Harris, Oloroso sherry's influence on the wood imparts an unmistakable richness and boldness to this spirit after a full maturation in the Isle of Harris warehouse.

MATURED IN BARRELS OF SECRET DE CHÂTEAU BIAC

In 2017 Isle of Harris staff were introduced to Tony and Youmna Asseilly of Château Biac. They discovered that Tony was a real lover of Scotland and its whisky and that he would love to fill some of his French oak casks with The Hearach. Isle of Harris Distillery agreed to collaborate, and the result has been not just a true friendship, but a rare expression of The Hearach whisky.

TASTING NOTES:

"Initially, there's a gentle mix of peat smoke with liquorice and sweet wine. Then comes summer notes of green leaves and ripe sweet tomatoes which dissolve into ripe pears with hints of dark plums and cherries. The fruit flavors become lighter, tropical with sweet lemon and a trace of lime. There are the florals of spring flowers with touches of jasmine and underlying it all a mixed spice and vanilla. There's a lovely finish of ripe fruit, new leather, and lingering peat smoke."



BALLYKEEFE is the first Irish Single Estate Family Farm Distillery in over 200 years, where all barley is sown, grown, harvested and distilled on the Ging family farm. Great care is taken to produce their crops, with an emphasis on quality over quantity, because only the finest barley will create whiskey of superior flavor.


Located in the lush green countryside near Ireland's medieval capital, Kilkenny, Ballykeefe has the distinction of being the area from which the first written account of distilling in Ireland is recorded in 1324 in the Red Book of Ossory.

Super Premium is the standard at Ballykeefe Distillery. It is a hearts-only distiller's cut, which means all heads and tails are discarded. They produce their spirits in small batches in bespoke, handcrafted Italian copper stills built by the renowned Barison Family. Designed with the goal to maximize the spirit's contact with copper and create Ballykeefe's incredible, smooth flavor.

PIONEERS OF ON-FARM DISTILLING

Ballykeefe is "The Real Deal" field-to-glass operation where all of the barley, oats, and rye are sown, grown, harvested, and milled on their family farm. Every step of the whiskey distilling, aging, and bottling are also handcrafted in their distillery. The Ging family, with an unbroken farming lineage through the centuries, has pioneered the revival of lost traditions from 300 years ago: on-farm distilling.


Ballykeefe whiskey is exclusive and rare, with each bottle taken from a single cask in its natural color with no chill filtering. Our award-winning care for the environment is central to our recycling of all by-products to achieve zero off-farm waste. Dynamic temperature changes in the cask aging warehouse means a richer abundance of flavors for a high 'angels share'.

SINGLE POT STILL TASTING NOTES

NOSE: Warm inviting nose with Caramel Toffee notes, Soft Oak Vanilla, Malt Cereal and a hint of Coconut.

TASTE: A surge of rich Earthy Malt with sweet and spicy notes of Liquorice, Cloves, Dried Fruit and Green Cardamom.

FINISH: Long Malty finish yields to Cloved Oranges and Aniseed.

TASTING NOTES

- Rich amber-honey hue with pale gold highlights that linger in the glass.
- Vibrant on the nose with toasted oak, maple, candied pecan, dried apple, sweet pipe tobacco and baking spice.
- Round and full on the palate, you are presented with medium toast sweet oak, baked cinnamon apples, caramel, dried stone fruit and a long, warm, full-bodied finish.





RBRINGE TEXAS MESQUITE SOUTHWEST BOURBON

Distilled & Bottled by Sepse Creek Distillery

MASHBILL 75% Toasted Corn, 25% Malted Rye

DISTILLERIE DU SI LAURENT

Canadian Spirits Inspired by the Sea Distilled by Quebec craft spirits pioneers

DISTILLERIE DU ST. LAURENT began with some "tests" in a basement in Rimouski, Quebec, where two pigheaded friends disregarded conventions and were inspired by their own terroir to create whimsical and distinctive spirits.

The distillery produces Whisky using only local grains and Acerum — a brand new breed of distilled maple sap spirits.

St. Laurent is **proud** to be amongst Quebec's micro-distillation pioneers. **Stubborn** to produce spirits in a traditional way with our region's raw resources while remaining **Independent**; facing large corporations that are flooding the shelves with cheap generic products.





ST LAURENT RYE

Mash Bill: 80% Rye, 20% Malted Barley

Distilled twice in a copper still before maturing 3 years by the sea in american virgin oak (2/3) and ex-whisky (1/3) casks. An elegant, accessible yet wholesome spirit. Slightly spicy with fruity, sweet and wooden notes.

TASTING NOTES

Apple, leather and sweet wine on the nose. In mouth, soft spices supported by hints of nuts, pepper, oak and brown sugar. Quite oily and round on the tongue - St. Laurent's signature.



CALIFORNIA STATES OF THE STATE

ST LAURENT 3 GRAINS

75% Corn, 15% Rye, 10% Malted Barley

After two distillations in our Scottishtype copper still, the result is a rich and full-bodied distillate. The spirit is then aged for 3 years in new charred oak casks. St. Laurent 3 Grains Whisky is made with corn from Quebec as well as rye and malted barley from Bas-Saint-Laurent.

TASTING NOTES

A grain & vanilla approach characteristic of American Bourbon, aromas of brown sugar and dried fruit, notes of orange peel, a spicy hint of rye. The slow pot still distillation delivers a long, mellow and smooth finish.

ST LAURENT ACERUM

Ingredients: maple syrup, water, yeasts

This eau-de-vie that reveals the delicate and refined aromas of distilled maple sap. The sole ingredients are Quebec maple syrup, water and yeasts. The maple wine is then distilled twice in a copper pot still and then aged in both new and used oak barrels for more than 3 years.

TASTING NOTES

Light and fruity. Aromas of apple and candied pear, notes of coconut bark, toffee and butterscotch. Slightly spicy and tannic wood notes, long and creamy finish of maple butter.





WHISKY OF THE PROHIBITION ERA

Mexico ventured into distilling malt whiskey due to the constant demand for alcohol in the USA during the age of prohibition (1920-1933). With prohibition in place, the Whisky business in Mexico was secure with fabulous benefits given the price that thousands of thirsty consumers just across the border were willing to pay.

Today, this Whisky recipe has returned to be shared with the entire world. Discover how it became one of the most in-demand whiskies during prohibition due to its unique characteristics and distinct flavor.

PRODUCTION

- Mexican grain whisky made from 100% malted barley from the Bajío region of Mexico.
- Aged for 3 years in American white oak barrels with a light toasting.
- Ideal to enjoy on its own or even to prepare a wide variety of whisky-based cocktails.
- ABV 40%

TASTING NOTES

APPEARANCE: Straw yellow with golden tones and copper highlights. Medium to full-bodied with a bright hue.

THE NOSE: Barley, fruits, nuts, yellow apple, vanilla, oak.

PALATE: Spiced malt, Barley, yellow apple, vanilla, oak, pineapple, walnut, almond, hops, vanilla, chocolate, banana, wood, orange blossoms, cherry, honey and a smokey finish.

PAIRING: Red meats, lamb and cold meats, grilled meat, and slightly ripened cheeses. Fruits and vegetables. Desserts with chocolate, vanilla, nuts.





Rampur Distillery is a leading Indian distillery with operations spread over 100 lush acres; entirely self-sufficient, utilizing effluents to generate bio-gas for steam and power. Exporting to over 80 countries, it's achieved milestones like ISO certifications and nearly 100% capacity utilization in the alcohol plant. Rampur is distilled in traditional copper pot stills in the oldest distillery in India, dating back to 1943 with 80 years of distillation expertise. The Himalayas provide cooling climate conditions throughout the year with the flavor of the famous Indian Summer giving Rampur an added dimension and depth.



DOUBLE CASK

This exquisite whisky is crafted from a marriage of American Bourbon barrels and European Oak Sherry casks that infuse it with delicate balsamic vanilla notes mixed with rich caramel, dried dark fruits and spicy tonalities for an incomparable depth of flavor. NOSE: Tropical fruits, smooth malty tones and oaky notes from double oak-wood barrels TASTE: Lustful elegance of sweet fruits; riding on rich sherry for a blissful nirvana. FINISH: Tantalizingly long, lingering and generous.



ASAVA

Matured in American Bourbon barrels and meticulously finished in Indian Cabernet Sauvignon casks for the first time in History resulting in a unique expression with an impeccable balance.

NOSE: tropical fruity notes with added notes of apricot, blackberry & plum followed with a faint hint of tobacco & spices.

TASTE: Velvety, manuka honey sweetness highlighted by spicy oak, vanilla and balanced with dryness from Indian red wine.



BARREL BLUSH

Barrel Blush is an extraordinary single malt with intricate flavors. Matured in the heart of American Bourbon Barrels and graced with a final touch in Australian Shiraz Wine Casks.

NOSE: Tropical fruits, floral, smooth, malty tones, and oaky notes. Delicate vanilla notes from American white oak complemented by rich caramel, toffee, dried dark fruits and spicy tonality from Australian wine barrels.

TASTE: Vanilla up front with almonds and a youthful spice.







SHERRY CASK

Aged in a combination of bourbon, sherry, and virgin American oak casks, our Signature Expression offers a velvety, full-bodied flavor.

- NOSE: Complex, rich oak
- TASTE: Classic earthy peat notes are balanced with a touch of Goan ocean breeze. Undertones of oak, vanilla, and dried fruits like raisin and figs are prominent. A warm blend of cinnamon and nutmeg notes complement the profile. Hints of sherry trifle or a sweet, malted barley-like taste. The finish is spicy, satisfying, and distinct, with a lingering mouthfeel.

WORLD CASK

Classic, earthy peat notes are balanced with a touch of salty Goan ocean breeze. A smooth, warm blend that allows all of the flavors to dance.


- NOSE: Light and gentle aromas rise up from the glass. There's a rich complexity, a medley of delicate flavors at play. Dry grass, hay, barley sugars. A nice little creamy note too. Ocean breeze and scents of black tea and malt.
- TASTE: Medley of light flavors; a little sweet, fruity, and malty. It's all about the malt, in fact. The oak starts to show, with a light flavor and a good amount of spice.

SMOKE BARREL







BALLYKEEFE IS THE FIRST Irish Single Estate Family Farm Distillery in over 200 years, where all barley is sown, grown, harvested & distilled on the Ging family farm.

The Ging Family trace their unbroken farming lineage back to the golden age when family farm distilleries were dotted across the Irish countryside. Located in the lush green countryside close to Ireland's medieval capital Kilkenny city, Ballykeefe has the distinction of being the area from which the first written account of distilling in Ireland is recorded in 1324 in the Red Book of Ossory.







BALLYKEEFE IRISH GIN

Produced with carefully selected botanicals, ingeniously and uniquely crafted for Ballykeefe by one of the world's most highly awarded Gin Distillers. The 12 botanicals are vapour infused in an Italian copper pot still, to create an extra dry Gin of exceptional quality which was recognised when it was awarded Gold on its first attempt in the premier "London Dry" category at the 2019 World Gin Awards.

NOSE: Fresh citrus notes with a hint of spice and a lingering floral bouquet.

TASTE: Immediate hit of juniper and citrus, giving way to palate warming spices.

FINISH: Very dry, making the next sip a must.

IRISH VODKA

Kilkenny, Ireland

Ballykeefe is an authentic, artisan, handcrafted operation, using a hearts only distiller's cutwhich means all heads and tails are discarded. With the emphasis on quality and not quantity, they distill this potato vodka six times through their custom-made copper pot and column stills.

A super premium Vodka, so smooth and sophisticated, it achieved Best Irish Vodka at the Irish Whiskey Awards in 2018.









TASTING NOTES:

Nose: Light white pepper and a hint of freshly sliced potato.

Palate: Creamy turning clear. Black pepper and macadamia nuts.

Finish: Clean and rounded with mineral notes.

Produced exclusively according to traditional methods, this Absinthe Grand Or 65° is obtained from the maceration and distillation of the Petite and Great Absinthes. This product is pure, without the addition of sugar and its coloring is natural.

Absinthe des Poètes is produced in limited quantities and each bottle receives a unique serial number.

SERVING & PAIRING

Drink with 5 - 6 times its volume of fresh water. Let ice-cold water mix with the Absinthe and discover the green fairy.

Pair with goat cheese, dark chocolate, or rare steak.

LAPOUGE PASTIS

Distillerie du Périgord makes some of the world's most well-known liqueurs in their cellars, located at the heart of the Black Perigord region.

Émile Lapouge founded the Distillerie du Périgord in 1860. By using his own infusion of liquorice and star anise extract, Lapouge Pastis was created and with it, a revival of the past.

SERVING & PAIRING

To be served as an aperitif, with five times its volume of water, on the rocks.

Pastis is traditionally served with olive tapenade, anchovies, and capers.



ARAK

Domaine des Tourelles



Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

Arak Brun has been in production since the inception of the winery in 1868. It is made from the alcohol of estate grown Obeidi and Cinsault grapes, harvested at optimum ripeness, and blended with fresh anise. Domaine des Tourelles grows its own anise in Deir el Ahmar, a village in the district of Baalbek.

This arak is produced inside a hundred year old cellar, processed traditionally using a three-stage distillation in traditional alembics, and aged in clay jars.

TASTING NOTES

Arak Brun is a smooth and wonderful spirit that will perfectly match any Mediterranean dish and much more. Pour it neat and then to add ice-cold water to taste.







KSARAK

ARAK Ksara, Lebanon

Château Ksara is Lebanon's oldest, largest, and most visited winery. It was here, in 1857, that Jesuit brothers produced Lebanon's first non-sweet red wine.

DISTILLATION & MATURATION


The first distillation releases the alcohol from the wine in a column still, eliminating the methanol and heavy oils that spoil the taste.

The liquid is distilled with aniseed a second time in a specially designed alembic to extract the "heart" cut, the highest quality portion of the distillate.

Finally, the spirit is refined a third time to achieve the purest and healthiest arak.

The arak is then aged for 28 months in traditional hand-made clay jars from the Lebanese mountain village of Beit Chebab.









DULCE DE LECHE

TAMBO was born from a century-old recipe from the DELLEPIANE family and arises from the idea of expanding to the world an Argentinian flavor as it is the Dulce de Leche. It is a specialty of unique taste which is part of the gastronomic and cultural heritage of Argentina. Dulce de Leche is pre-eminently one of the most incredible delicacies in existence.

TASTING NOTES: Sweetness and smoothness in the mouth are at the forefront. Gradually, the presence of vanilla, toffee, and the Dulce de Leche notes unfold, and finally, a round creaminess completes the flavor.

Tambo can be enjoyed alone, with ice, or incorporated into desserts.
