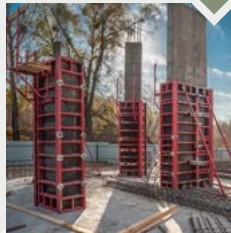

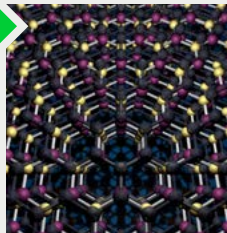

The UK Concrete Show returns for its next edition on **23–24 March 2027** at the **NEC Birmingham**, reinforcing its position as *the* annual meeting place for the UK concrete industry. Visitor quality also continued to improve, with 73% of attendees holding purchasing authority (up from 69% in 2025), and over 50% coming from C-suite and senior decision maker roles (up from 45% in 2025), ensuring high value conversations and genuine commercial outcomes for exhibitors.

The event is proudly supported by leading industry bodies including the Concrete Society, the Mineral Products Association (MPA), and the Structural Concrete Alliance, reinforcing its role as the central meeting point for the sector. This year The Flowing Screeds Association joined this exclusive list of supporters, helping to drive engagement and awareness of the event with hard-to-reach surface prep businesses.

A key driver of visitor engagement is the show's dynamic feature programme. The **New Product Hub** provides a dedicated platform for innovation, giving exhibitors the opportunity to launch and showcase cutting-edge solutions to an audience actively seeking new ideas. This year 30+ new products were successfully launched, with hundreds of votes cast by trade visitors across both show days. The **Live Demo Zone** offers live, practical demonstrations, bringing equipment and techniques to life in real time. Meanwhile, the **Concrete Connect Seminar Theatre** hosts **two days of free-to-attend content**, delivering expert insights on the industry's most pressing topics and trends. The **Emerging Talent Awards** continued to turn heads, shining a light on the latest talent entering the industry, with over 40 nominations and entrants from the likes of Kier Group, Balfour Beatty, Brett Concrete, Ramboll and Leiths (Scotland) Ltd.

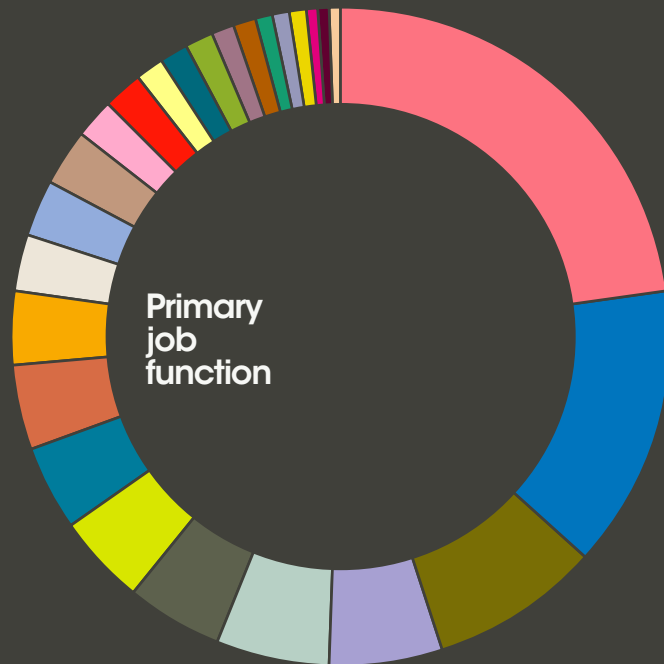

## Concrete Connect Seminar Theatre

The **Concrete Connect Seminar Theatre**, located at the heart of the exhibition floor, delivers two days of expert insight, discussion and debate. 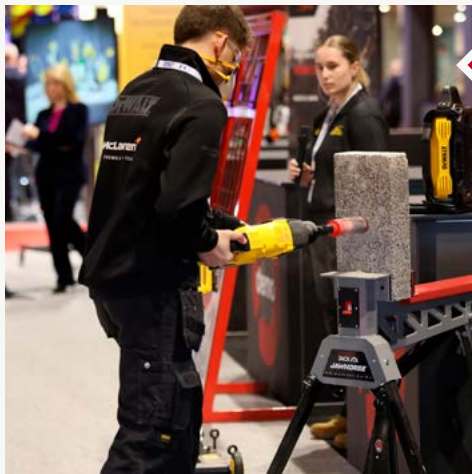
