





The time frame for registering and settingup the Department winning Buddy Poppy displays for the national judging at convention will be the same asust Department winning entries will be accepted for registration and may be set up beginning at Acceptance. Saturday, Aug. A. until noon, Monday, Aug. M. T. T. D. Winning displays will be identified with the appropriate ribbons on Tuesday morning, August M. and announced later, on the convention floor. Displays must be removed prior to Mercal m. on Tuesday. Any displays left after this time will be removed for disposal by convention center personnel during the disassembly of the exhibit hall. "BUDDY" POPPY CAMPAIGN. Although we emphasize Buddy Poppies on Veterans Day and Memorial Day, it is important to realize that the distribution of Buddy Poppies should be a year-round exercise. Eatime a Post participates in an activity where the public will be present. Buddy Poppies should be present fundraising tool and simply to recognize our fallen comrades.

- r) All orders for the traditional Buddy Poppy. Anniversary Poppies or tin tab poppies must be placed through your Department Headquarters . Auxiliaries must go through their Post to order all popp
- E) The tin tabs do count towards the Buddy Poppy requirement for the All-American program.
- If you do not receive your order within four weeks of placing it with your department, please contac your Department Headquarters to report you have not received your order.
- T) All poppies are shipped within 1. days of ordering except orders placed in June and July adue to preparation for National Convention aplease allow an additional five business days.

Posts are further reminded that Section viv of the Manual of Procedure provides that non-profit organizations, exempt from taxes under Section (a) of the Internal Revenue Code, may assist with the distribution of Buddy Poppies, provided there shall be no division of proceeds. A donation to these groumay be made from the Post general fund.

The only authority to use the name, emblem, or any marks of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States would be by issuance of express written consent by the Veterans of Fore Wars of the United States National Headquarters. Please see the references below. Pursuant to Title my U.S. Code Sections money, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States has
- the exclusive right to the use of its name and the sole exclusive right to the use of the emblem and badges adopted by the corporation . Additionally, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States is the owner of U.S. Trademark Registration Nos. ١،٧٠٨٠٠٧٠٠ ١،٦٨٦،٨٨١٠ ١،٩٨٢،٤١١٠ ١،٨٢٧،٢٦٩ for the mark 'VFW' as well as eight additional registrations including the term VFW. Finally, it is a federal offense to use the name or emblems of a federally chartered veterans' organization. See Title \(\lambda\) U.S. Code Section \(\nu\).
